Excerpt from Military Criminal Code

(April 10th 1908, Law No. 49)

Chapter I.

General Provisions

- Article 8. Army personnel includes the persons enumerated in the following:
- 1. Persons on the active list of the Army. However those who have not yet entered barracks or those on leave are to be excluded.
 - 2. Reservists who have received orders for calling out.
- 3. Reservists who are taking up the duties of army personnel in various units without being called out.
- 4. In addition to the persons enumerated in the preceding two clauses, reservists who are wearing army uniforms or who are actually fulfiling their duties of service.
- 5. Persons who have voluntarily enlisted themselves in the National Army Conscript and are actually in service.
- Article 9. Persons enumerated in the following shall be included

correspondingly as Army Personnel:

1 Armyrestudents.
2 Civilian employees of the Army.
3. Naval personnel taking up outles in the Army.
