



# Why a single color mark?

- Works on photos & across patterned backgrounds
- Easy to see (high contrast)
- Does not clash with other colors, images, etc.
- Community is already doing it (e.g Wikimania badges)
- The tricolor mark will still be used as emblem of Wikimedia movement & community groups



Google made this change, you can change the link color the way you change any text color. Feel free to change it to the darker blue. Learn more.


