Subject: Sanitary Team Activities and Budgets

2. Individual cities, towns and villages which employ sanitary teams should provide the following information:

- a. Number of sanitary teams.
- b. Number of sanitary team members.
- c. Number of sanitary team members hired for full year.
- d. Number of sanitary team members hired for summer program during summer season.
- e. Amount of supplies\* on hand at beginning of summer control program.
- f. Amount of supplies bought during summer control program.
- g. Amount of supplies actually on hand on 1 September 1950.
- h. Number of inhabitants in area served by teams.
- i. Evaluation of the work of the sanitary teams in each city, town, or village district. This is to be done by prefecture insect and rodent control officer on basis of adequate supplies, actual control methods, completeness of program, cooperation of householders and general control program.

\*Supplies to include 5% DDT in kerosene, 10% DDT, dust, pyrethrum, any other insecticide used, anti or other rodenticide, number of dust guns, sprayers by type (A) knapsack (B) hand sprayers, also distribution of any material sold to householders.

c. Prefectural health budget available for personnel, supplies and sanitary educational materials for 1950 fiscal year.

(1) Budget for personnel.

(2) Budget for materials.

(3) Budget for additional material.

(4) Budget for any other function of sanitary team personnel or supplies.
