Cabinet Order No. 117

The Special Account Order for Special Measures on Unjustly Possessed Materials, etc.

In accordance with the provisions of Article 15 of the Law concorning the Special Account for Special Measures on Unjustly Possessd Materials, etc. (Law No. 36 of 1948), the Cabinet hereby establishes the Special Account Order for Special Measures on Unjustly Possessed Materials, etc.

Article 1. Annual revenue and expenditure schedules of the Special Account for Special Measures on Unjustly Possessed Materials, etc. shall be classified into title, item and sub-item by sources of revenue and purposes of expenditure and furthermore, if necessary, amount of each sub-item shall be divided into detail, and reasons of estimates of revenue and reasons of necessity of expenditure and the basis of their respective calculation shall be shown.

2. Annual revenue and expenditure schedules of this Account shall be sent to the Minister of Finance by October 31 in the preceding fiscal year.

3. To annual revenue and expenditure schedules shall be attached documents prescribed by items 2 to 4 inclusive of Paragraph 2 of Article 9 of the Law concerning the Special Account for Special Measures on Unjustly Possessed Materials, etc. (Hereinafter referred to as the Law)

Article 2. As regards sub-item and detail in annual revenue and expenditure schedules the Minister of Commerce and Industry shall prescribe them by consultation with the Minister of Finance.

Article 3. To annual revenue and expenditure schedules shall be attached the explanation concerning whole annual revenue and expenditure schedules of this Account and the explanation of each title

and item.

Article 4. In this Account, collected revenue and temporary borrowing under Article 12 of the Law shall be fund for disbursements, and disbursement of expenditure shall not exceed the said fund.

Article 5. In case the Minister of Commerce and Industry intends to divert cash belonging to the accumulated reserve fund, to the fund for disbursements referred to in the preceding Article, unber Article 12 yf the Law, it shall be done with the approval of the Minister of Finance.

Article 6. In case there arises a surplus by deducting the amount of disbursed expenditure (in case there is a sum to be transferred to the General Account in the following fiscal year under the provisions of proviso to Article 7 of the Law, the amount of the sum plus the amount of disbursed expenditure) from the amount of collected revenue each fiscal year, the surplus shall be turned into reserve fund for accumulations.

Article 7. The final statement of revenue and expenditure of this Account shall be sent to the Minister of Finance by July 31 in the following fiscal year.

2. The final statement of revenue and expenditure shall be accompanied by the documents shown in Items 2 and 3 of Paragraph 2 of Article 10 of the Law.

Article 8. The Ministry of Commerce and Industry shall prepare a journal, a ledger and a subsidiary book and record therein all the calculation belonging to this Account.

Article 9. The disbursing officer shall prepare an accounting book of fund for disbursement besides an expenditure book and record therein amounts of fund for disbursements, disbursed amount and balances.

Artilce 10. The Ministry of Commerce and Industry shall prepare an accounting book of fund for disbursements and record therein amounts of fund for disbursements, disbursed expenditures and balances.

Article 11. Forms and entry methods of books prescribed in preceding three Articles shall be specified by the Minister of Finance. Supplementary Provision:

This Cabinet Order shell come into force as from the day of its promulgetion and apply as from the enforcement day of the Law concerning Special Account for Special Measures on Unjustly Possessed Materials, etc.
