Overdue Accounts

1. MCUIP-1 - In July 1960, Headquarters advised Station Bagota that Subject with two sides would be travaling to PEPAINE to assume the post of Kavy Chief in the Fall Directorate and visa assistance was requested. Routine difficulties followed including no funding by the FRL until finally in August 1560 the Station had to advance funds for Subject and one companion including \$150 each required by the commutate as evidence of solvency. There is no indication in the files as to whether this 1300 was to be absorbed as a NUBARI expense or whether it was to be repayed. However, since that time, ALGUIP-1 has become a socurity risk. He is considered an opportunist and associates with people with whom KUBARK wishes no contact. One of these individuals is described as needing only the slightest excuse to make public statements embarrassing and harmful to MUBAR interests. Accordingly, it is recommended that this advance be written off without attempting to secure repayment.

2. ANCALL-1 - Funds were passed to ANCALL-1 by the principal agent for use in the MCALL project. However, as conventional political action on the labor front became more and more difficult, these funds made their way increasingly into the MiP war chest since ARCALL-1 was national co-ordinator for this erganisation. Pinelly, the taking over of the labor nevenent by the commists left no road open to opposition elements except that of mebotage and clandestine activity. In April 1961, Gordon BIKARIAS, principal agent with whom AVEALL-1 was in contact was arrested and altimately deported. There was no further contact with Abill-1 following the arrest of HILARIAS. The funds that had been passed to him ware presumably used by the REP underground and must have been gone long before the time of ARCHI-1's arrest the end of September 1961. Accordingly, white/PA-PRCP is requesting that the sum of \$840.81 charged against the agent be written off both because the funds were undoubtedly expended by the MIP underground in furtherance of anti-castro objectives and because ANCALL-1 himself is either dead or in prison and accountings can therefore not be recured.

3. Pedro DIAZ Lanz - The sum of \$400 was passed to Subject on 19 James as expense somey for a prop tour he was to take along with

Inis COSTE Aguero and other Cubams. The plan called for the use of DIAL'Lann's plans piloted by him. This was changed when it was found to be too difficult to get the necessary permits for the plans. Best, DIAL and COSTE ware going commercially, but neither wanted to be spensored estembly by the PRO. Finally, COSTE want alone when DIAL belied at simply being COSTE's shadow. Reantime, DIAL Lans had begun to dabble extensively in exile politics in kinni, appeared before a congressional committee and succeeded in making himself useless as a propaganda asset. KAVE was not in contact and Equationally considered it preferable not to request contact with him to try to collect the advance. In view of the subsequent time lapse, it is recommended that the advance be written off.

At the time of the interview of AMCALL/1, the names mentioned by him were checked out in VH/4/RE cards and in VH/4/RE cards and in VH/4/RE Supp cards. In nearly all instances there was no identification of the individuals; in a relatively few instances, there was a possible identification, but nothing conclusive. It was felt that Subject had talked a lot but said little.
