1. Headline: Scarlet fever is prevailing in Hachioji City.

Hiroji, (1), Haruko (15) and Nobukuni (12) children of a railway worker Masao Ogino at 12 Koyasu-machi 1-chome, Hachioji City, were diagnosed as suffering from scarlet fever, on Jan. 21, and Motoko (28) at 26 Minami-cho, Hachioji City was diagnosed as being ill with the same disease on Jan. 24. Thus, there has been so far reported 6 cases of scarlet fever in Hachioji City.

2. Headline: The Hachioji-Minamitamama district was urged to complete the rice quota delivery by the end of the month.

The Hachioji-Minamitamama district where as of Jan 24, 85% of rice quota was delivered, was urged to complete the rice quota delivery by the end of January by the Metropolitan Economic Bureau on Jan. 24.

3. Headline: 1,000 food tickets stolen at the Nanao Village Branch Office of the Food Distribution Corporation.

The Takebata Branch Office of the Food Distribution Corporation at Nanao Village, Minamitamama County found 40 bread tickets and 994 Japanese macaroni tickets, equivalent to food for 1,000 persons, stolen on Jan. 23.

- (1) Headline: The Pref. authorities are going to exterminate cases of local diseases and roundworms completely with the support of GHQ, in view of the fact that about 60,000 people are the victims in 60 city and town and villages in the prefecture.
- (2) Headline: An assistant Mayor of Kofu, Kato, being found guilty of the violation of the Election Law, expressed to the Mayor his desire of leaving office on Jan. 15.
- (3) Headline: A fire broke out at 1:50 a.m. 16 Jan. at the office of the Agricultural Cooperative Association located in front of the Otsuki-machi Station, it destroying completely the warehouses of the Kitadome branch office of the Pref. Credit Federation, warehouse of the Fugaku Transportation Co., the 2nd rationing centre of the Foodstuff Distribution Corporation together with other 3 houses and 4 warehouses. The damage is estimated approximately at ¥10,000,000.
