



SAILING DIRECTIONS
 Approaching from the Southward, bring Thatcher's I.N. Lt. to bear W. by N. and
 Straitsmouth Lt. Ho. N.W. by N. this clears the Ledge; when steer N.N.W. & W.
 passing about two cables length to the Northward, and Eastward of Straitsmouth Lt.;
 continue on this course until the Little Salves SW by S. when steer W. by S. until the large
 granite factory in Rockport bears E.S.W. run for it passing midway between the points
 of the Harbor, when anchor in 11 feet water or pass between the Buoy to the pier heads.
