SUMMARY JURISDICTION**Petty Sessions Districts and Times**

ORDER, DATED 19TH AUGUST, 1964, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 10(1) OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1935.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 10(1) of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 1935(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, after consultation with the County Court Judge and Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

Abolition of Petty Sessions District of Rosslea

1. The Petty Sessions District of Rosslea shall as from the 1st day of October, 1964, be transferred to, and become part of, the Petty Sessions District of Newtownbutler, and, in consequence of such transfer, the Petty Sessions District of Rosslea is hereby abolished.

2. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (Amendment No. 1) Order (Northern Ireland) 1964.
