Dear Mr. Goldstein and Mr. McClinton:

Please be advised that Capstone Industries products Eco-i-Lite NF-L200 and Eco-i-Lite NF-L100 have been removed from the ENERGY STAR Qualified Products List. These products use inductively coupled charging technology and are therefore outside the existing scope of the ENERGY STAR Program Requirements for Battery Charging Systems.

Even though the test data submitted for these products meet the efficiency requirements of ENERGY STAR Battery Charging Systems, this specific type of technology is not eligible for ENERGY STAR qualification.

Capstone Industries and the retailers selling Eco-i-Lite products will not be required to recall those Eco-i-Lite products currently on the market that are marketed as having ENERGY STAR qualified battery charging systems. However Capstone will not include the ENERGY STAR label on products shipped after October 31, 2009.

This ENERGY STAR delisting is the result of the existing ENERGY STAR qualification scope and has no reflection upon the Eco-i-Lite products or their technology or performance.
