Law Providing for Emergency Trading in Rice.

Law No. 90 10 Sept. 1937

effective 1 Dec. 1937.

Article I. The Government shall be authorized to sell the rice belonging to the Special Rice Supply and Demand Adjustment Account if it is considered necessary for military use. The sale price of the above shall be decided in accordance with current prices.

Article II. Since the Government maintains a necessary amount of rice in connection with the China Incident, when it is especially considered necessary it shall be authorized, in accordance with the provisions set forth in the Imperial Ordinance, and after consultation with the Rice Control Committee, to purchase rice in case current prices are lower than that which correspond to the rate of "standard maximum prices" which are fixed by orders issued based upon the Rice Control Regulations. The purchase price of the above shall be decided in accordance with current prices.

Article III. The entire revenue and expenditure concerning the sale and purchase of rice prescribed in the two foregoing

articles shall come under the Special Rice Supply and Demand Adjustment Account.

Supplementary Law

The date of enforcing this law shall be decided by an Imperial Ordinance and the law shall be abolished within a year after the China Incident terminates.
