SUBJECT: Signal Equipment

TO: Chief, Government Section
GHQ, SCAP, APO 500

1. It is requested that a survey be made of all non-expendable signal equipment in possession of your unit or section and a list thereof in duplicate furnished this headquarters not later than 19 January 1951. This report will be entitled "Report of Signal Equipment on Hand". Reports control symbol is HC GD-(OT)-01. The purpose of this list is to obtain proper authorization for many items that are known to be in use but for which no formal authorization has been issued, and to establish a basis for requisitioning replacement parts and expendable items for this equipment. It is important that all items be listed regardless of the source from which they were procured.

2. The following information concerning each item is desired:

- a. Stock numbers.
- b. Correct nomenclature.
- c. Quantity on hand.
- d. Authority for use.
- e. Purpose for which presently used.
- f. How issued (organizational property or M/R).

A copy of a suggested form for this report with model remarks is attached. In connection with the "Authority for Use" it is desired that the actual method of and reason for procurement be stated. In the majority of cases this will merely be a reference to a TA or TO/GE. It is desired that TA 20-130 not be cited as authority. This TA is not, in itself, considered adequate authority for an item to be held by a specific unit or section. If the authority for having an item is unknown it should be so stated. In such instances it will be of material assistance if a statement of the use that is being made of the item is made together with a brief justification for continuing it in use, particularly in the case of major items. If it is not desired to retain an item it should be so stated and it should be turned in to the Class II and IV Supply Officer. Information desired under "How Issued" is whether the

item is held as organizational property or on memorandum receipt.
If the item is not on property records, it should be so stated and
action will be initiated to properly account for it. Questions con-


SUBJECT: Registration of Pets
