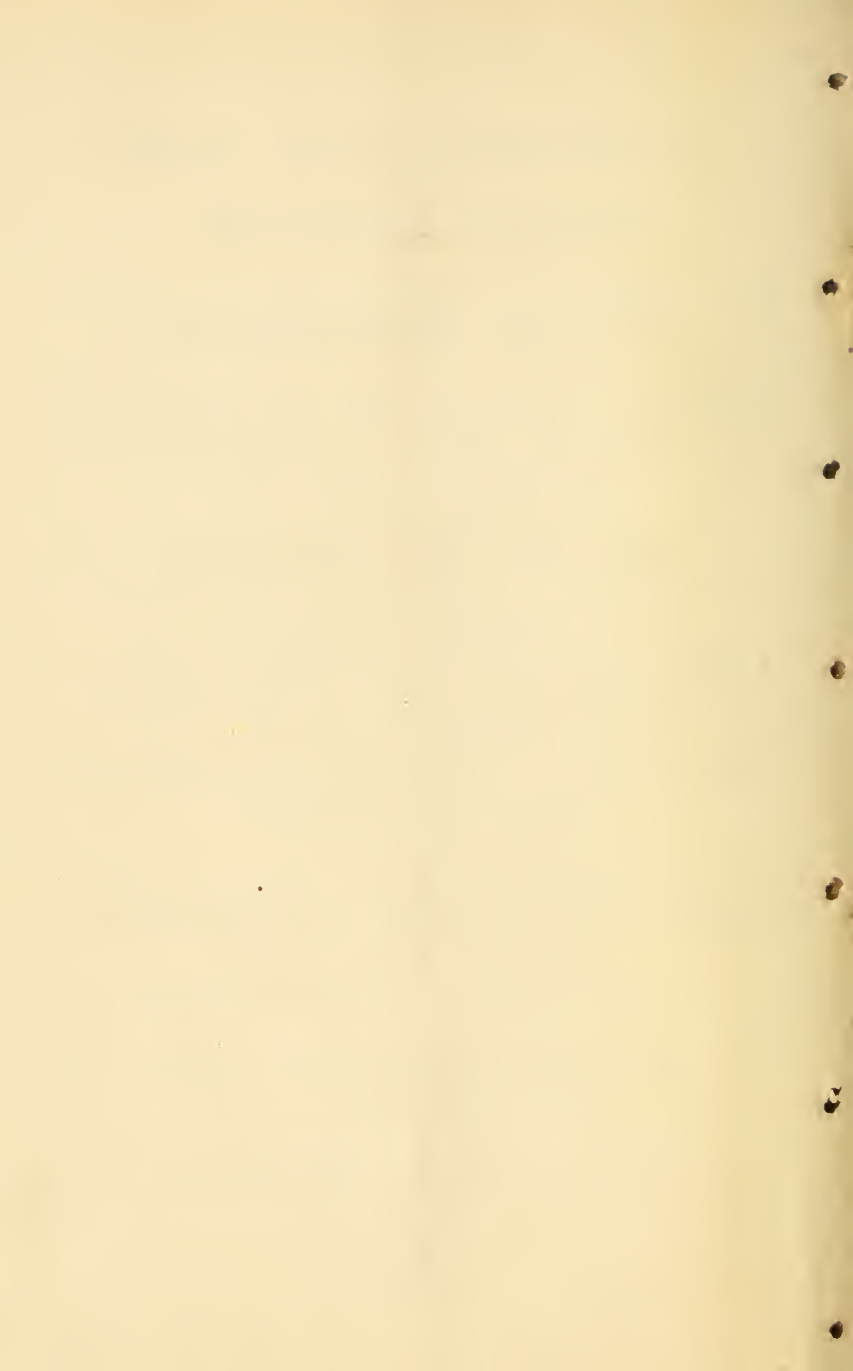

5. To prevent inaccuracy in delivery and inconvenience in the settlement of the Purchases, no Lot can on any account be removed during the Sale.

6. Upon failure of complying with the above conditions, the money deposited in part payment shall be forfeited; all Lots uncleared within the time aforesaid shall be sold by public or private Sale, without further notice, and the deficiency (if any) attending such re-sale shall be made good by the Defaulter at the Sale, together with all charges attending the same.
