Atchison County } On this 38<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight personally appeared before me the undersigned a justice of the peace for the County and State above mentioned John Cox who being duly sworn according to law declares that he is the identical John Cox who was a private in the Company commanded by Capt Davis in the Mormon Battalion commanded by Capt Ph. St. Geo Cooke that he was mustered into service at Council Bluffs by Lt Col J Allen on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1846 for the term of one year, and was discharged at Redlands de los Angeles in California on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1847 by reason of expiration of term of service I never received any discharge The Battalion to which I belonged was mustered out of service
