hundred and forty-eight personally appeared before me the under-  
signed a justice of the peace for the County and State above mentioned John  
Cox who being duly sworn according to law declareth that he is the  
identical John Cox who was a private in the Company commanded by  
Capt Davis in the Mormon Battalion commanded by Capt Thos St. Geo Cooke  
that he was mustered into service at Council Bluffs by Lt Col of Albu on  
the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1846 for the term of one year, and was discharged at Rribles  
de los Angeles in California on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1847 by reason of expiration  
of time of service I never received any discharge The Battalion to which  
I belonged was mustered out of service  
Sworn to and subscribed before me } John Cox  
the day and year above written } C. H. Cooks justice of the peace
