1. Attached is a letter, Ashiya Air Force Base and Japanese bills for services performed for the Occupation Forces in the amount of ¥207,399 and ¥9,518.

2. Obligation was incurred as a result of an air accident in which two planes crashed into the water along with the body of one of the fliers.

3. It would appear that some mechanism for payment must be devised. If approval from your headquarters is granted, it seems feasible that this cost could be included under JPNO 3744 (Port and Harbor Services - Wakamatsu).


