SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. That between the 18 day of October 1941 and the 8 Day of December 1941 (Tokyo time), the accused Michiyo IWAMURA, Ken TERASHIMA, Nobusuki KISHI and Hiroya INO, as Cabinet ministers, together with divers other persons did willfully and unlawfully order, cause and permit the military Japanese Imperial Forces to commence hostilities against the United States of America without a previous and explicit warning in the form either of a reasoned declaration of war or an ultimatum with a conditional declaration of war, in violation of the Hague Convention III, 1907, thereby causing and contributing to the deaths and injuries of members of the United States Military Forces and United States citizens, and destruction to United States property and property of United States citizens.
- 2. That between the 18 day of October 1941 and the 8 day of December 1941 (Tokyo time), the accused Michiyo IWAMURA, Ken TERASHIMA, Nobusuki KISHI and Miroya INO, as Cabinet ministers together with divers other persons did willfully and unlawfully order, cause and permit the military Japanese Imperial Forces to commence hostilities against the British Commonwealth of Nations without a previous and explicit warning in the form either of a reasoned declaration of war or an ultimatum with a conditional declaration of war, in violation of the Hague Convention III, 1907, thereby causing and contributing to the deaths and injuries of members of the British Commonwealth of Nations Military Forces and British Commonwealth of Nations citizens, and destruction to British Commonwealth of Nations property and property of British Commonwealth of Nations citizens.
