Milbee's Masterpiece—(ID)

Very large, perfect yellow. Wonderful stems and blooms facing. At Chicago was judged a California Idol, although I have never grown or had a plant of California Idol in my garden. Seed from Mr. Ben Pfluger, Rainbow Gardens, California. The best yellow to date. Plants only \$12.50.

A beautiful long stemmed, large bloom. Perfect stems. Competition for Wenoka. Plants only \$10.00.
