Subject discussed: Five-day system.

Five-day system has been adopted by all municipal junior high schools since April. Discussion was carried out on the merits and demerits of the system and opinions were given from three sides - students, parents and teachers.

Summary of Discussion:

Merits:

1. Regular lessons are given throughout five days without any interruption by outside activities.
2. Students have club activities on Saturday.
3. Teachers spend Saturdays on in-service training, such as faculty meetings, study groups attending conferences and giving demonstration of classwork and also on guiding students' club activities.
4. Students help parents in house work.

Demerits:

1. Parents are **against** it, because they find it hard to take responsibility on guiding their **children** on Saturdays.
2. Students are not mature enough to spend Saturdays on their own responsibility and without supervision of either parents or teachers, they are likely to get into trouble.
3. Teachers are **getting** worn-out as they cannot take rest on Saturdays but **have** to spend them on in-service training and students' club activities.
4. When teachers use Saturday on in-service training, they do not find time in guiding students' club activities.
5. Students' standard of learning is lowered.
6. There is danger of Saturday being used for preparation of entrance examination for senior high schools.
7. As prefectural junior high schools have not adopted five-day system, conferences which teachers are required or want to attend are held on week days.

Judging from the whole discussion more than half of parents, teachers are in favor of it, but strong necessity is felt in training parents to cooperate with school policy and take more responsibility in home education. Some principals and teachers have a wrong idea that students should be given home work for Saturday.

SUBJECT: Election system of vice-principals

Periodical change of principals of primary and secondary schools on a larger scale is being contemplated by Chief of Education Bando and other main officials of the secretariate of Municipal Board of Education.

With the materials obtained from vice-principals conference as well as the list of teachers' records, the leading members of the secretariat of the Board of Education are now deliberately considering the matter. On the other hand, they are studying the concrete plan of appointing vice-principals by the Board of Education in order to stabilize the vice-principals' situation actually based upon the classified positions system, instead of existing election system, which, combined with the evils of academical cliques, have constituted a of school scandals.
