


Reference Operational Directive 25, par 40, Hqs Eighth Army, dated 9 April 1948. The following report is submitted on the former Yokaichi Army Airfield for your information and action as deemed necessary.

1. The former Yokaichi Army Airfield was officially released 17 July 1947. The airfield was 1,343,575 tsubo in size. 1,204,370 tsubo was transferred to the Agricultural and Forestry ministry. The remaining 138,103 tsubo of land is the building area.
2. There is 20,134 tsubo of buildings in the building area of 138,103 tsubo. Of this, 5,693 tsubo of building and 11,644 tsubo of land have been sold. All these sales have been to prefectural government agencies and they are only small and isolated buildings. 8,616 tsubo of building and 76,057 tsubo of land is rented out temporarily to private enterprises. 5,128 tsubo of buildings and 40,401 tsubo of land are unused.
3. According to Mr Sadao Hori, Chief Secretary of Otsu Local Office of Osaka Financial Bureau, these buildings and land areas are not for sale to private individuals or concerns. They have only sold the isolated parts of the building area. He says the reason for holding the main building area intact is they hope for some large company to buy it and convert it into a factory of some sort. No offers have been received as yet from any acceptable concerns. As a result much valuable materials are laying unused and depreciating rapidly. This includes barracks type buildings, office buildings, aircraft hangars etc.

2. It is suggested that increased publicity be given the availability of this building site and the buildings located thereon, and that in this fashion, arrangements may be made at an early date whereby the property can be put to use.
