

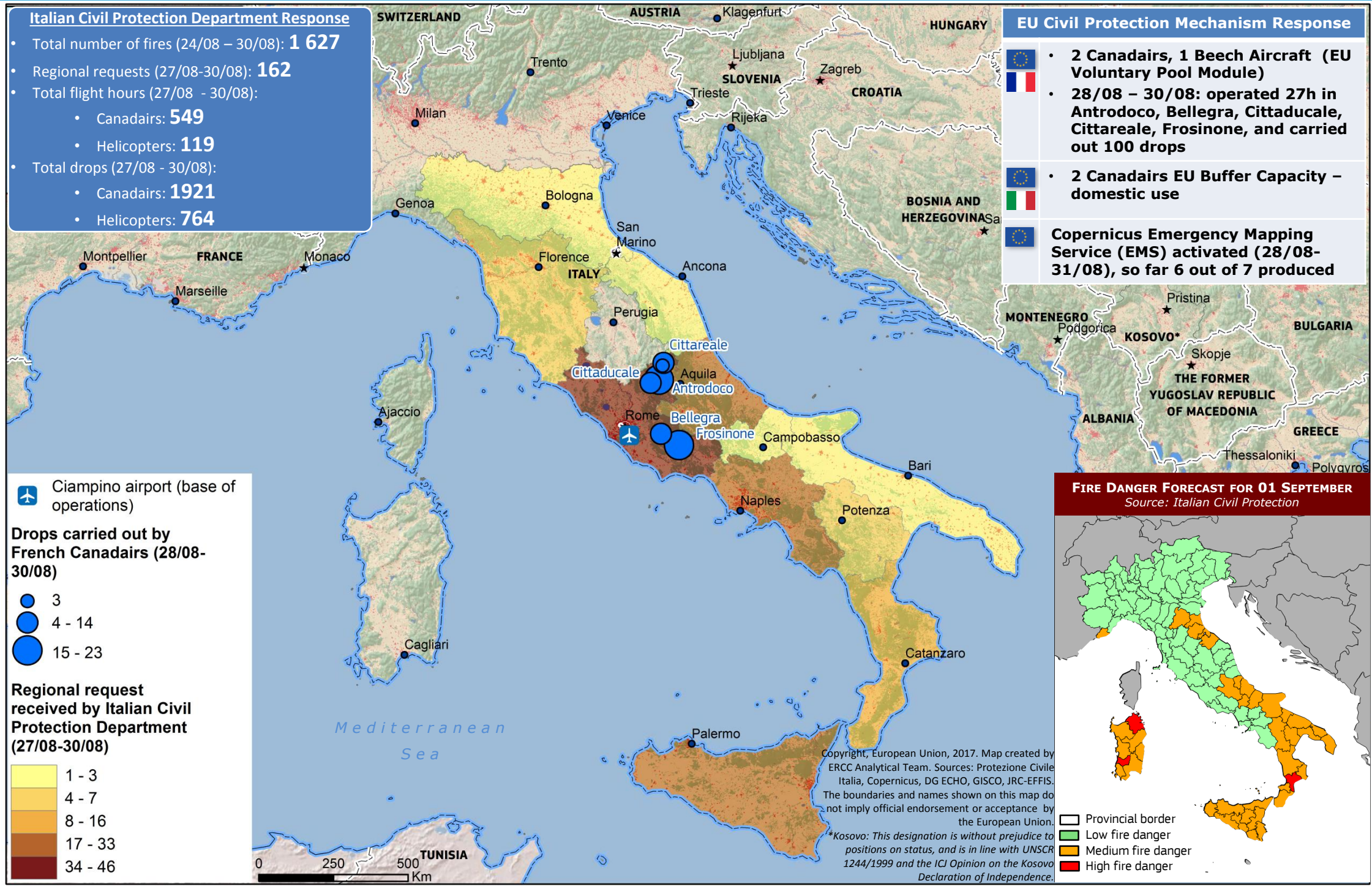
Italy – Forest Fires Response

Italian Civil Protection Department Response

- Total number of fires (24/08 – 30/08): **1 627**
- Regional requests (27/08-30/08): **162**
- Total flight hours (27/08 - 30/08):
 - Canadairs: **549**
 - Helicopters: **119**
- Total drops (27/08 - 30/08):
 - Canadairs: **1921**
 - Helicopters: **764**

EU Civil Protection Mechanism Response

- **2 Canadairs, 1 Beech Aircraft (EU Voluntary Pool Module)**
- **28/08 – 30/08: operated 27h in Antrodoco, Bellegra, Cittaducale, Cittareale, Frosinone, and carried out 100 drops**
- **2 Canadairs EU Buffer Capacity – domestic use**
- **Copernicus Emergency Mapping Service (EMS) activated (28/08-31/08), so far 6 out of 7 produced**

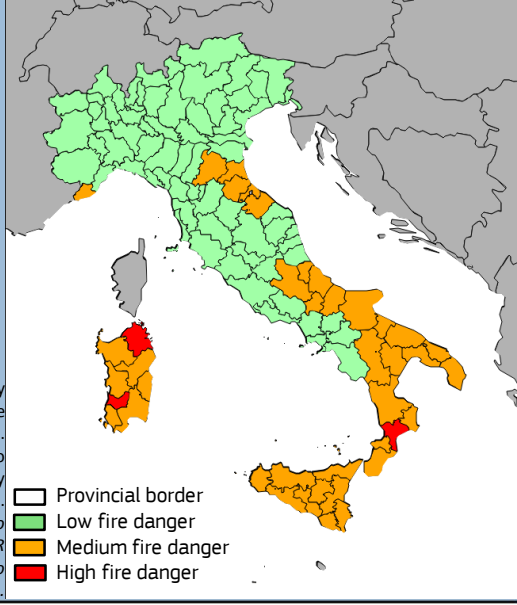
