1. C/N 1, G-4 to Technical Services, Report of Critical Items, 3 October 50, forwarded a critical item movement report originating from SFPE to Technical Services for review and appropriate action. C/N stated that plans should be made to either expedite delivery of critical items or to cutback on those items which indicate a possible generation of excessive surplus. C/N directed attention to certain specific Ord items.

2. By C/N 2, Ord to G-4, subject as above, dated 12 October 50, Ord replies to C/N 1. The item by item resume was given. From a review of Ord C/N it is determined that Ord is planning to take the necessary corrective action and therefore no further G-4 action is required.

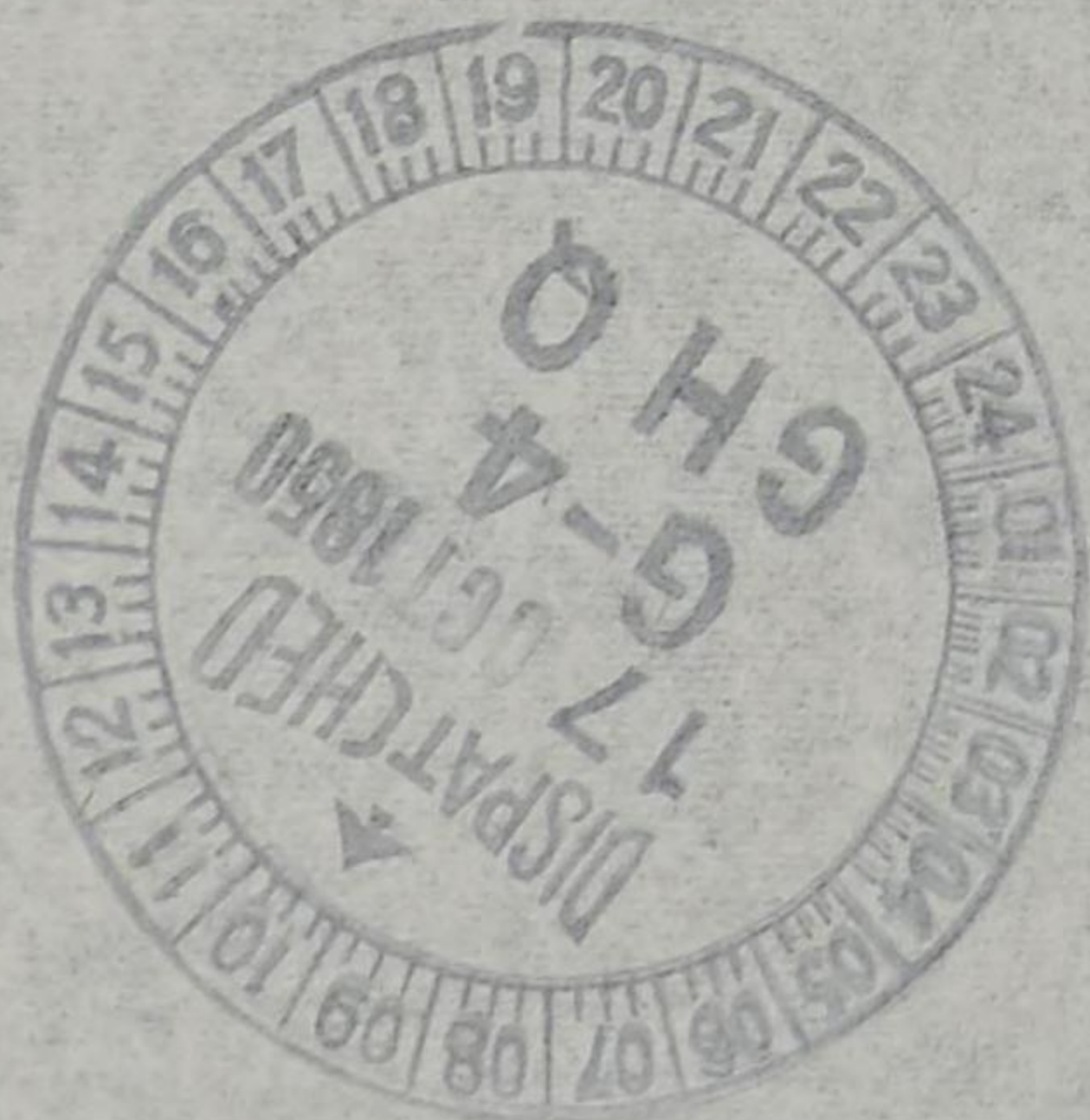

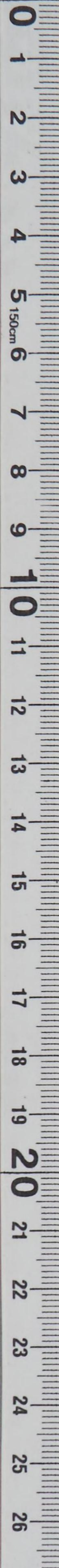

In compliance with preceding C/N, the Ordnance items have been reviewed.

a. Armament and Vehicles:

- (1) No action is being considered at this time for Item 63, in that a requirement for the major item still exists.
- (2) Item 52: JLCOM msg EX 30608, 18 Sep 50, requested requisition and items be changed to read M46; JLCOM msg EX 30740, 24 Sep 50, further amends requisition to reflect a reduction in the total amount required.
- (3) Item 68 and 126: CINCFE msg CX 61382, 28 Aug 50, submitted requirements and phased shipment for these items.

b. Ammunition:

- (1) CINCFE msg CX 57638, 11 July 1950, requested that the Day of Supply for certain weapons be increased as much as 300 to 600% of that normally authorized. Subsequent data based on actual expenditure rates of these items of ammunition indicate that the Day of Supply rates established by the Dept of Army authorized sufficient ammunition to support the operations in Korea.
- (2) The increase in the Day of Supply resulted in an excessive Theater authorized level for these items which in turn indicated an enormous shortage on hand. On 1 October the temporary increase in the Day of Supply was terminated as prescribed by DA msg W 86040. JLCOM dispatched msgs EX 31148 OA and EX 31149 OA requesting that shipments of certain items be cancelled. These msgs include items 4 and 14. Items 40 and 41 are still in short supply within this theater.

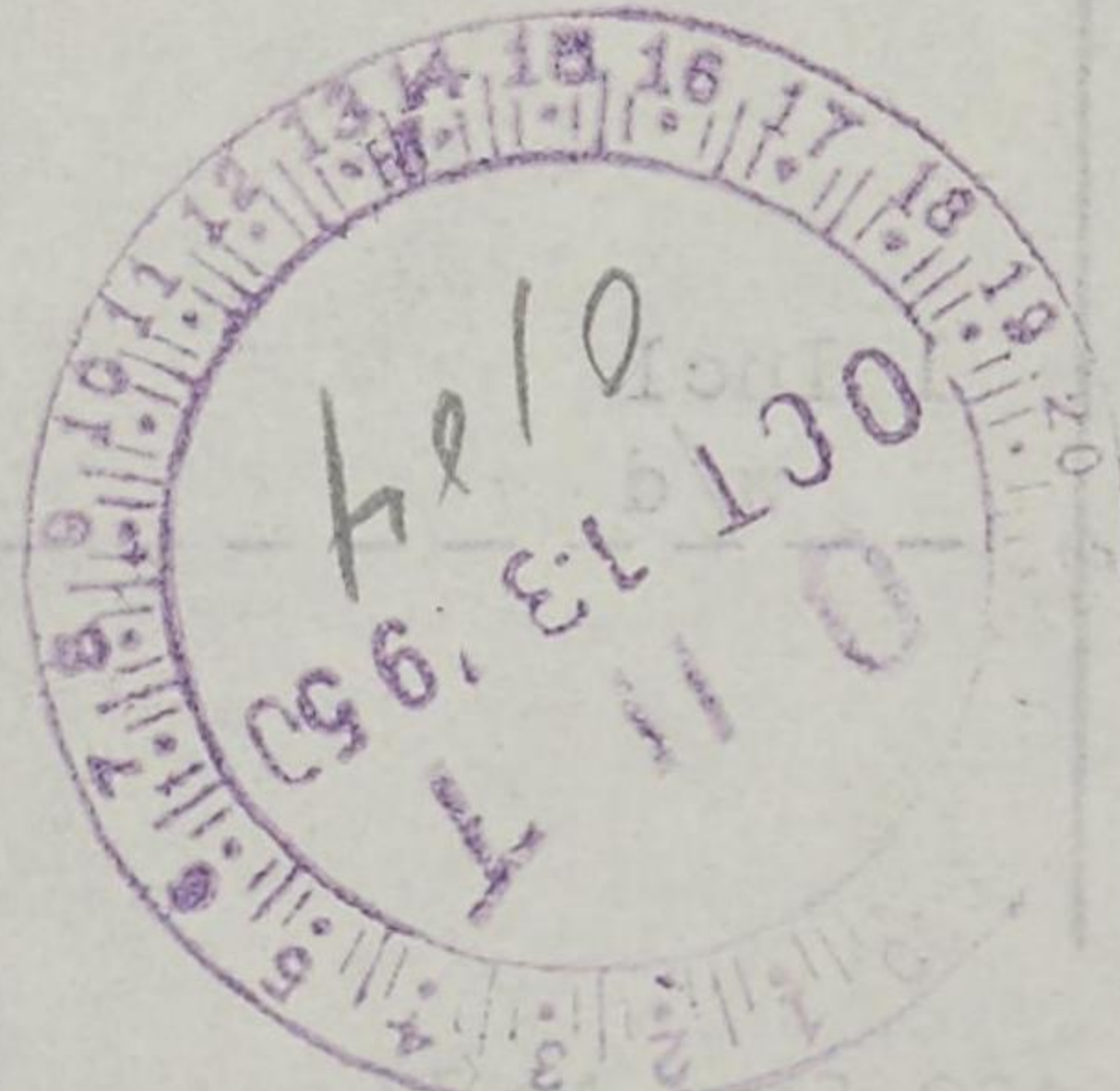
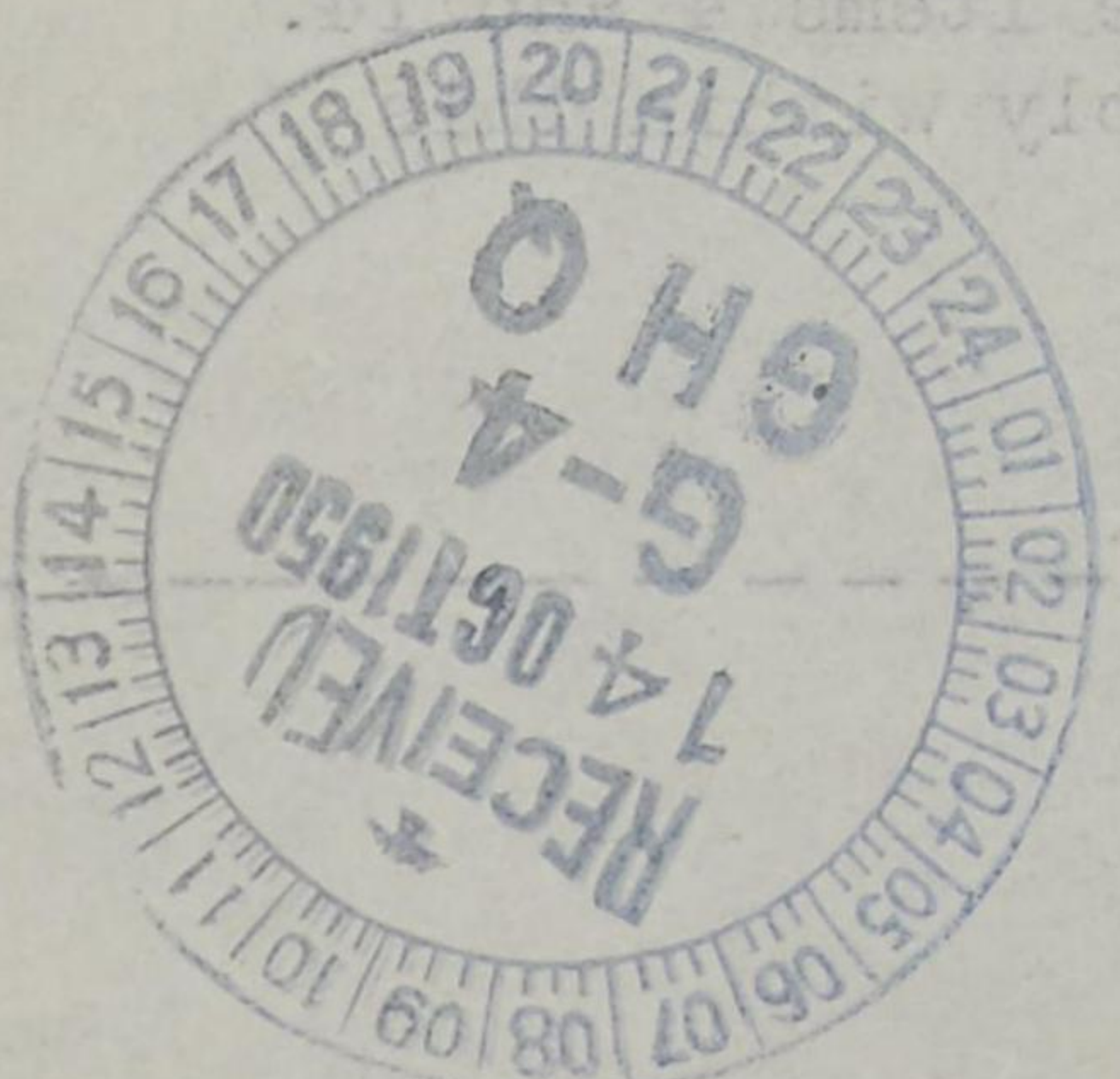
(2) Item 52: JICM mag CX 30608, 18 Sep 50, requested reposition and items be changed to read M4; JICM mag CX 30740, 24 Sep 50, former amends reposition to reflect a reduction in the total amount required.

(3) Item 58 and 138: CIMOT mag CX 31388, 28 Aug 50, admit- ted requirements and phased shipment for these items.

Arms and Ammunition:

(1) CIMOT mag CX 57338, 11 July 1950, requested that the Day of Supply for certain weapons be increased as much as 500 to 600% of that normally authorized. Subsequent data based on actual expenditure rates of these items of ammunition indicate that the Day of Supply rates estab- lished by the Dept of Army authorized sufficient amount- tion to support the operations in Korea.

(2) The increase in the Day of Supply resulted in an excessive theater authorized fuel for these items which in turn in- dicated an enormous shortage on hand. On 1 October the temporary increase in the Day of Supply was terminated as prescribed by DA msg W 88040. JICM dispatched msg CX 3148 GA and CX 3149 GA requesting that shipments of certain items be cancelled. These items include items 53, 52, 58 and 138 and all are still in short supply.
