Foreword

When Isaac Newton, the first Commissioner of Agriculture, outlined the program for a new Department in 1862, he placed near the top of his list the establishment of an agricultural library. It was his belief that "the most valuable work would gradually accumulate by exchange, gift and purchase, forming a rich mine of knowledge." Since that time, the National Agricultural Library (NAL) has assembled a collection of over 1,800,000 volumes, inclusive of historic and/or rare imprints.

The National Agricultural Library's special collections area comprises original manuscripts, archival materials, rare books, early periodicals, pamphlets, photographs, works of art, audiovisual materials, and microforms. It also includes a variety of ephemeral material which, because of physical characteristics, age, value, content, or appearance, has been judged rare or requires special custodial or environmental care. The Library's special collections program staff welcomes the opportunity to receive, preserve, and make available manuscript material of historic value including diaries, account books, letters, notebooks, memoirs, and reminiscences pertaining to agriculture and its many related fields. Early scientific materials created prior to 1870 will be especially welcomed, as well as later unique material of a definite historical and scientific significance.

International in scope, the subject range of the special collections, although quite diverse, has strong concentrations of rare books in botany, natural history, zoology, and entomology, as well as extensive imprint literature documenting agricultural observations, experimentations, and practices in England, Western Continental Europe, and America. In addition to important travel accounts by early naturalists, there is an extensive collection of pre-Linneana imprints relating to the description of plants, as well as works by or about the eminent botanist Carl Linnaeus (1707-78).

Particularly noteworthy manuscript collections include the following: the personal papers of Julian N. Friant (1888-1939), a special assistant to Secretary of Agricultural Henry Wallace; the personal papers of Charles E. North (1869-1961), physician, public health officer, and agricultural scientist; the organizational records of the Prince Family Nursery (1779-1914) and the American Association of Agricultural College Editors (1913-present); the Charles Kellogg Soil Conservation collection; the James P. Gwin Poultry collection; the Papers of Layne R. Beaty; the Papers of Charles Valentine Riley; and the M. Truman Fossum Floriculture Collection.

From the time of the first librarian on the Department roster (Aaron Burt Gosh, 1867-69) to the present, outstanding works and collections have been donated to the National Agricultural Library by individual Americans and private organizations to be preserved and made available to scholars and researchers. In an effort to provide awareness and access, the following historical finding aids have been published: Historic Books ..., List No. 86; Linneana, List No. 89; Historic Books Concerning Horticulture and Forestry, List No. 90; Heritage of American Agriculture: A Bibliography of Pre-1860 Imprints, List No. 98; Heritage of Apicultural Literature...Pre-1870, Associates NAL Today, N.S., 1, No. 101; Guide to Manuscripts in the National Agricultural Library, Miscellaneous Publication No. 1374; The Papers of Layne R. Beaty, Bibliographies and Literature of Agriculture No. 33. We are greatly indebted to Lisa Karpinski, who prepared the arrangement and description of the M. Truman Fossum Floriculture Collection and the register for the collection. The papers of Mennick Truman Fossum (1912-present) were deposited in the National Agricultural Library in Beltsville, Maryland, between April 1982 and October 1983 under the terms of a cooperative agreement signed by Mr. Fossum, North Dakota State University, and the National Agricultural Library.

M. Truman Fossum, originator of statistical, marketing, and related economic research and information services for commercial floriculture, has dedicated any literary rights including copyrights that he possesses in the collection to the public. The public has access to all but 56 boxes in the collection. These 56 boxes (263(4)-314 and 317-321) will remain closed until the donor's death.

Key to the collection:An asterisk (*) in the file folder listing (e.g., *2. Advertising) indicates that there is
oversize material (i.e., material larger than 8 1/2 by 11 inches) for that subject.
The oversize boxes are at the end of the collection.

"See Oversize" on the file folder listing indicates that material on that subject heading will be found only in the oversize section of the collection.

"Oversize Only" on a file folder indicates that only oversize material is located in that folder. No letter-size material will be found under that subject heading.

When a box number appears followed by a number in parenthesis (i.e., 263 (4)), the reader should start looking at file folder number 4 in box 263.

Header folders, which are in bold in the file folder listing, are markers for the beginning of a specific subject area. These subject areas may either be titles or dates (e.g., Latin America, Wholesale Markets, or 1956). In contrast to other numbered folders in the file folder listing, header folders do not contain documents.

Scope and Content Note The M. Truman Fossum Floriculture Collection

The papers of M. Truman Fossum span the years 1890-1990; the bulk of the material focuses on the period 1945-85. This collection, which occupies 213 linear feet of shelf space, consists primarily of statistical and marketing data, personal and business correspondence, published and unpublished surveys of the floriculture industry, and projections of future trends in the floriculture industry. The original order of the collection was kept to maintain provenance and to fulfill the wishes of the originator, M. Truman Fossum.

The Fossum collection is divided into four series: I. General Reference; II. Floriculture Career; III. Biographical; and IV. Additions. The first series entitled "General Reference" contains materials relating to marketing research and information for commercial floriculture in the United States and abroad, miscellaneous business and personal correspondence, and a variety of magazines including supplements to "The Packer."

The second and largest series contains information on the floriculture career of M. Truman Fossum. Included in this section are several important statistical surveys of the floriculture industry that the donor prepared. This group also contains a report entitled "Trade in Horticultural Specialities," dated 1890-1950. This report, along with a "Forecast of Projections" for the years 1981-90, is the basis for the 100-year timespan of the collection. With these surveys excluded, the bulk of the collection falls between 1945 and 1985. It was during these years that Mr. Fossum worked for some of the most prominent organizations in the floriculture industry. These included the Society of American Florists (SAF), Grant Advertising, Keyes Madden and Jones Advertising, Florists' Telegraph Delivery Association (FTD), and Marketing Facts for Floriculture.

The third series, entitled "Biographical," contains the personal papers of M. Truman Fossum. Included here are professional and business records from 1929 to 1985, personal information about the collector's life from grade school forward, employment and biographical data, records of the Fossum Foundation Library in North Dakota, and financial statements. This section will remain closed until Mr. Fossum's death.

The fourth series contains a wide variety of material that was added to the collection after the original gift. These additional papers are an attempt by Mr. Fossum to keep the collection current.

Each series consists of subseries and each subseries (organized by box number) consists of file folders, listed at the end of the register. The file folder listings mirror the subject headings contained within each box. All material of standard size (8 1/2 by 11 inches) is in letter-size boxes and any oversize material has been separated and can be found in 24 by 24 inch boxes at the end of the collection. Asterisks have been used in the file folder listing to indicate the presence of oversize material (see the key at the beginning of the register).
