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The Vanishing Point: Moving Images after Video (Volume 3 in the India Since the 90 s series) tracks the fugitive afterlife of the moving image ever since the proclaimed death of celluloid film took place. At once everywhere and nowhere, rapidly circulating moving images have become archives of public memory, degraded repositories of what was cinema, surveiliance tools, and instruments of governance. In this book filmmakers, moving image artists and theorists are assembled to reconstruct one of the most elusive, and significant, transformations of the millennial turn.
