Concept A: Learning

Idea in brief:

Newcomers open Add a link in a new pseudo-Visual Editor mode, which enables them to more easily access and learn about editing broadly on Wikipedia (beyond the structured edit).

PROS:

- Users learn to edit in the existing framework.
- Uses the existing Suggested edits features
- Potentially greater opportunity for growing editing expertise via “exposure therapy”

CONS:

- Potentially reduces users’ ability to do task as quickly as the “focused” structure of Concept B
- Potential confusion that there is no guidance in the other Suggested edits tasks.

Concept B: Task focus

Idea in brief:

Newcomers open Add a link in a new dedicated UI for doing structured tasks that involve machine suggestions review, and isolating only the most relevant parts of the article for them to complete the task.

PROS:

- Users can focus on doing the specific task more quickly as it is the only editing activity
- Users are able to review more efficiently without the 'noise' of article read and edit components that may distract/confuse task completion.
- Mobile users of all levels (newcomers and experts) can complete dedicated task quickly

CONS:

- Lack of context may lead to poorer quality contributions.
- Potentially stifles/stunts a newcomer's ability to learn how to do other non-structured edits (though this might be mitigated by providing encouragement to branch out later).








