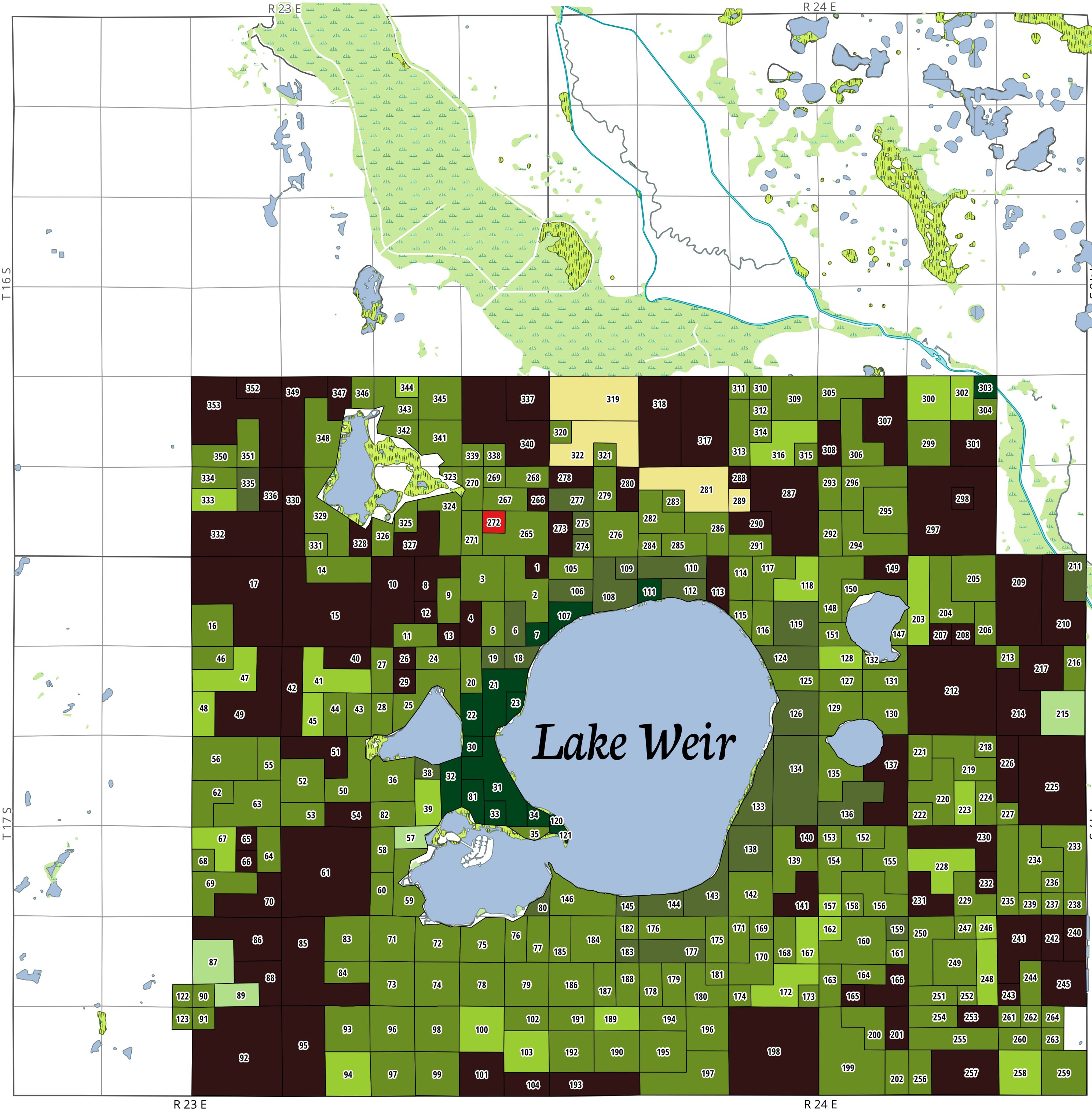


Historical Settlement Pattern at Lake Weir, Florida

Notes: This map shows the names of original property owners, around Lake Weir, as indicated by the records of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund Land Records Database and the Bureau of Land Management. While many deed recipients filed homestead claims, some exercised their option to purchase the land in cash, usually at \$1.25 per acre. It is important to remember that most of the tracts owned by the railroads and the various investment companies were also available for purchase, often at \$1.25 per acre; however, these records are not available through the aforementioned databases.

The extent of properties chosen for digitization was determined by reference to census boundaries. In 1880, this was all part of Precinct 9 (Lake Weir); by 1885, the area to the north and west of Lake Weir was designated Precinct 9 (Lake Weir), and the area to the east and south of the lake was separated into Precinct 19 (Stanton).

These parcels were digitized according to the legal property descriptions appearing on the original land patents. The modern hydrography data are made available by the Florida Geographic Data Library, as are the Public Land Survey System boundaries.
