

Report on Tetsuzo Yamanouchi

As he passed the test of the Foreign Office, the passage of which might offer him a position in the office, Tetsuzo Yamanouchi submitted the representations to be summarized as that he was seeking an expediency by which he would get a position at the office earlier than otherwise.

According to what he said on June 9th, he had been formally notified by the office of his failure to get a position therein.

On the ground that he applied for a position as a Russian interpreter to whom as is known these days, there is left a small space for employment, so far as it is concerned. The interested office in charge of the matter of this kind extended to the office its explanations so that he might be adopted. As his hope now hinges upon that he would be hired as a Russian interpreter in the Occupation Quarters, there can be found no job title whatsoever corresponding to Russian interpretation in the LR recently received by the Tokyo Labor Liaison Management Office. Furthermore, it can't be expected that a job title of this kind be added in the LR. Yamanouchi is for the present gaining a monthly income, though irregular, of 8,000 yen by means of his home work--Russian translation.

If there is no vacancy for his speciality, he says, he will be satisfied with any kind of job, even a job of guard if offered. Under these circumstances, we sent for chief of Employment Division, Shinjuku PESO and told him to exert effort to settle this issue in favor of him.
