MENORANDUM FOR MR. MOCLOY: GENERAL HILLDRING:

Brief of Item 2 for 9th Meeting of SWNCC on Unconditional Surrender of Japan (SUNCC 21)

BACKGROUND

- 1. Surrender terms were drafted by JPWC in consultation with State Department.
- 2. After the issuance of Samco 16 (memorandum by Mavy representative on SaMCC outlining politico-military problems in Pacific for consideration by SaNCC) the JFWC - State Department papers on Unconditional Surrender of Japan were approved by the Presc (Dooman, Strong and Train only) recommending that Samoo transmit documents of unconditional surrender to the Mar and Navy Departments for their comments and recommendations and for those of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

DISCUSSION

- 3. It is not believed that the documents on the unconditional surrender of Japan have received the consideration of the interested staff agencies of the War Department thus far.
- 4. The War Department representative on SUNCC should not approve SWNCC 21 at this time but should recommend that Samcc note it and transmit it to the har and Navy Departments.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Note SWNDC 21.
- 6. Fransmit the Appendices to SwMCC 21 to the War and Mavy Departments for comment and recommendations
