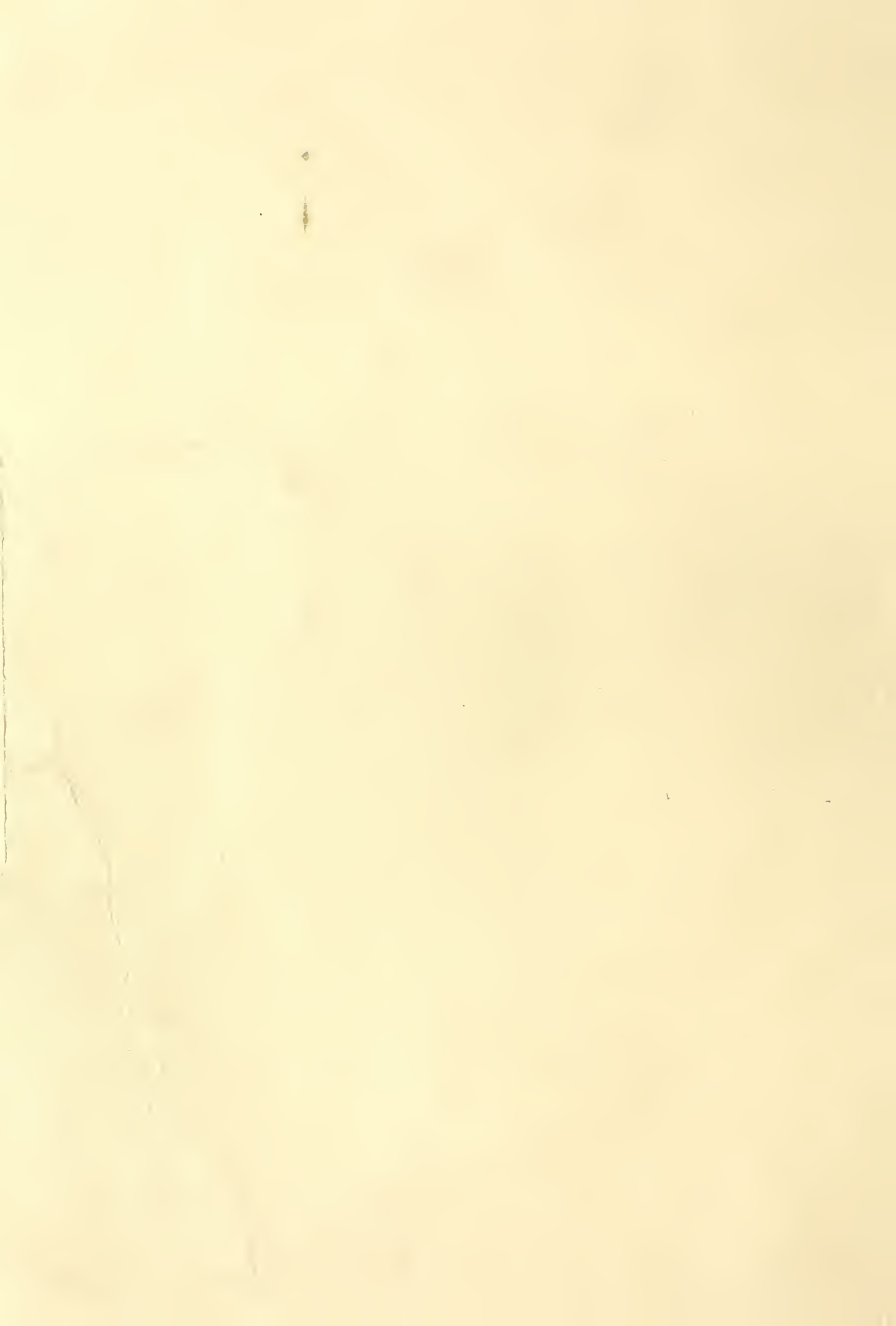

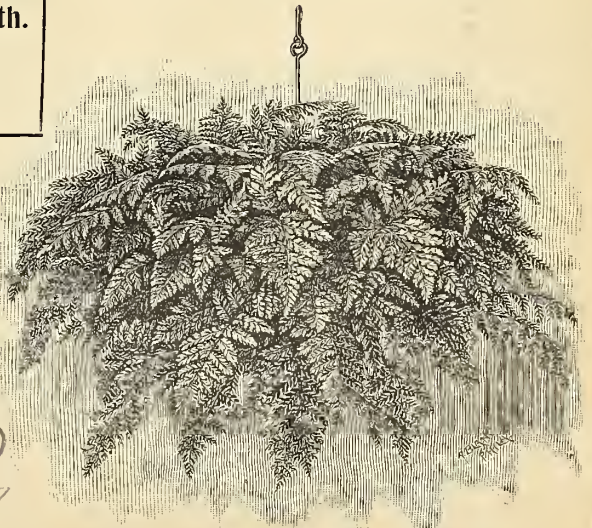

Japan Lilium Longiflorum have proved a most desirable substitute for Lilium Harrisii, because of their comparative freedom from disease, as well as being unmixed with the latter variety. While they are later blooming than Harrisii, florists should experience no trouble to bring them into flower in good time for Easter.

# Japan Grown Longiflorum Giganteum Multiflorum.

Florists have no doubt noticed in Japan Lilium Longiflorum an occasional plant much different from others, taller in growth with handsome foliage which covered the stem from the pot up, and producing much more abundantly of flowers than its neighbors. 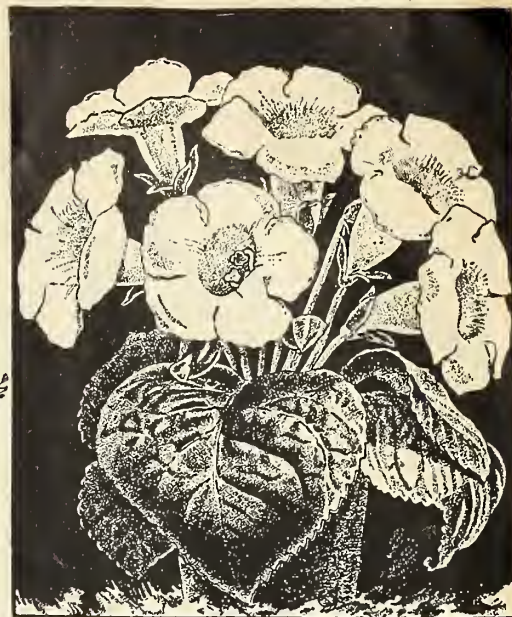

ADJUSTABLE PLANT STAND.



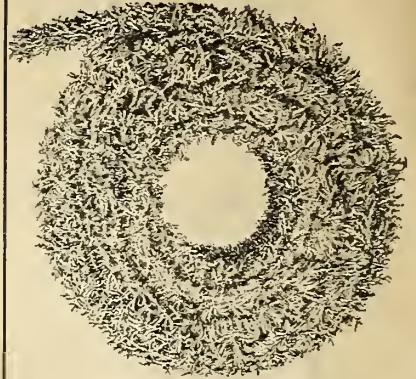
