- Wikipedia 10 meetings in three cities.
- Press coverage in major national newspapers.
- Partnership with other free culture institution.
- Talks with the Ministry of Economy and Development.
- Participation in Iberocoop.

- Next steps to become a Chapter:
 - ChapCom and Board approval.
 - Approval of bylaws and election of Board.
 - Inscription under Chilean authorities.
- First conference of Wikimedia Chile (July 2011?)
- Development of new projects
 - GLAM partnership w/ University of Chile.
 - Mapudungun and Rapa Nui potential WM projects.
 - Educational projects.

Membership:

- Chilean people use Wikipedia and social networks, but aren't interested to contribute in WM projects.
- Absence of a "culture of participation" (me > us).
