### TwoColConflict Extension

- Provide a better way to resolve edit conflicts
- Passed security review, some open tasks
- Planned as a beta feature

### Show changes in moved text paragraphs

- Needs to be written in C++ and PHP
- First prototype written in C++
- Next steps: Check performance issues, check if it is doable in PHP, too

### **Book Referencing Wish**

**Problem:** When referencing different sections of the same book, the whole source always needs to be repeated


**Solution:** Provide an efficient way to refer to different pages of the same work when adding references to an article by implementing a "refines" parameter.

- A reference that was named with name="animal" can then be refined through <ref refines="animal">
- <ref refines="animal"> Page 25 </ref> will lead to "Page 25" being printed in the references section, below the definition of the "animal" source
