a) Physical Description

Height: 5'7"
 Weight: 150 lbs.
 Build: Slender
 Features: Slightly stooped.
 Hair: Light brown, thinning on top.

Other features: Hollow-cheeked and wore a thin smoky mustache.

b) Life Long: He was a laborer all his life employed in the Electric Vehicle factory.

c) Early History: Married to a peasant girl and had three children.

d) Language: Spoke only Hungarian.

e) Political Activities: Was associated with the Arrow Crossists during World War II and was later induced into joining the Hungarian Workers' Party when the Communists came into power. He was not ideologically inclined and it was my impression that he was one of the opportunistic small fry who changed affiliations with the political situation. In fact, he abhorred political discussions and thought that politics was the bane of mankind. *As of November 1957 he had not rejoined the reformed HSWP.*

f) Psychological Assessment: Subject's sole interest in life appeared to be hunting. He would interrupt his household chores at the mere mention of going after wild game. He expressed anti-Bolshevik opinions when in the company of close friends. He was dubbed as the "Yellow grained interpreter," by his hunting colleagues because he came walked his way out of the group of Bolshevik soldiers while on a hunting trip after the Revolution. He referred to this incident as being "one step from hell."

g) Military Background: Subject had seen service as an infantryman in World War I.
 h) Extra-curricular Activities: Other than his wife membership in the MAF, Subject was not the type to join social organizations.

i) Initial Contacts: I met Subject in May 1956 through my association with his son, Istvan DOMBOSI, Jr. Our relationships were very informal and friendly through our common interest in hunting. Usually on hunting trips he would be the first to suggest that the group stop at a nearby saloon and partake of refreshments in spite of the fact that his tolerance for liquor was limited by a mild case of stomach ulcers.

Memorandum for the Record:

The Subject of [] was a social contact of a CIA staffer assigned to Budapest 1953-57. The question of subject's possible connection with the Hungarian intelligence service has not been definitely resolved, but in the light of our knowledge of AVH modus operandi, i.e. facts amassed from debriefing two former AVH staff officers [] and [] and an AVH agent [] whose assigned target was the U.S. Legation in Budapest, plus reports received from the U.S. Legation since 1951, it is most likely that the Subject of this [] was and will remain under AVH control as long as he was or remains in contact with a member of the U.S. Legation staff in Budapest. It is therefore recommended that no action be taken with regard to the Subject of this [] ut prior consultation with the CE section of the EE/Hungarian desk.
