b. General Information:

- (1) During the reporting period 7 enlisted related to CONUS. 2 Marine Corps Officers and 47 Marine Corps enlisted replacements were received. 1 Navy enlisted replacement was received.
- (2) During the reporting period the battalion had 5 WIANE.

3. Significant Events:

a. Intelligence.

- (1) Enemy activity: VC Mine and booby trap incidents continue to increase with (7) reported incidents during July 1966. Enclosure (1) contains Battalion Intelligence Summaries, ~~MEMORANDUM~~ for period of 1-31 July 1966.
- (2) Intelligence: Normal administrative and Combat Intelligence during month of July 1966.

A rewards fund of 2000\$VN was obtained from Division CI. These funds are to be used as outlined in DivO 7000.4.

b. Training.

- (1) Formal training was conducted throughout the month of July in conjunction with operational commitments.
- (2) Live firing of the M-14, .45 caliber and .30 caliber MG constituted the practical application phase of weapons instructions.
- (3) An LVTP5 Crewmans Maintenance Pamphlet was published.
- (4) OJT and normal maintenance procedures were conducted throughout the month.
- (5) Communications procedures school was conducted for LVT crewman, by the communications section.

c. Schools.

- (1) (1) officer to Civic Action.
- (2) (1) ~~officer~~^{SUBSTITUTED} to Crypte Communication.
- (3) (1) man to M-16 Rifle Repair.

d. Special Operations.

- (1) During July this battalion participated in numerous small search and destroy operations in support of the infantry.
- (2) On the 31st of July (1) platoon consisting of (1) officer (41) enlisted and (11) LVTs returned from SLF duty with 3/5.
- (3) On two occasions during July provisional rifle platoons were attached to the Chu Lai Combat Defense, Sub-Sector V.
- (4) Enclosure (2) contains the Battalion Sit Reps for July 1966.

e. Logistics

- (1) Important Events: A 500 man galley was constructed by MCB-4 and is now in operation. A laterite road was constructed by 1st Eng. Bn. on the access road through the battalion area.
- (2) Supply. AMRD was computed using 12 months usage history, with the exception of selected LVT and Meter Transport repair parts which were computed on "In Country" usage only.

Road wheel assembly FSN 2530-447-0723
Qty 31 and Track kit FSN 2530-523-541
Qty 20 were placed on "Red Ball"
- (3) Meter Transport wheeled vehicles in the battalion accumulated a total of 18,414 accident free miles during the month with a vehicle deadlining average of 20%.
- (4) Medical Support. The medical support was routine during the month with this battalion. The Battalion Surgeon and corpsman offered medical care to the Vietnamese in the village of Hai Ninh and Vinh An on a basis of three times a week. A total of 1074 patients were treated for a variety of ailments. The battalion surgeon was attached to the 7th Marines from 25 July to 29 July for Operation Franklin.
- (5) Battalion Maintenance. During the period Battalion Maintenance continued to exert all efforts in support of Co. "A" and "B". Highlight of the month was the recovery of a submerged LVT from the Seng Ben Van river. Recovery was swiftly accomplished despite extremely muddy terrain.

f. Civic Action.

- (1) During period 1-31 July MED CAP Team made 13 visits to the hamlet of Vinh Am and treated 1074 patients for a total 1169 ailments.
- (2) During the reporting period 600 bars of soap were handed out along with 100 lbs of clothing, 2 basketballs and 1 velleyball.
- (3) On 12 July 1966, 20 bags of cement were given to the village Chief for the construction of a water well in Vinh Am. The villagers are constructing the well.

Damage to LVT, suspension system, No. (8) road wheel was blown off, (1) torsion arm damaged, ruptured deck plate, and one fuel cell. The LVT did not catch fire.
- ISUM No. 68 - 080440H - Elm BCo. 3dAmTracBn. located (100) meters east of BT (468068) received (4) rds SA from grave yard vic BT (468068). Marines illuminated area with neg. results.
- ISUM No. 69 - 101430H - Elm of BCo. 3dAmTracBn. loc BT (468068) Children alerted the Marines of Beeby trap located (100) yds east of position. It was investigated and found to be (1) M26 grenade rigged in G-ration can. Marines disarmed grenade.
- 102330H - Elm of BCo. 3dAmTracBn. observed (1) individual attempted to cross over wire, (2) bursts of M-14 & (2) rds of illumination in direction of individual and he fled. Vic BT(468068)
- 110400H - Elm ACo. 3dAmTracBn. received sniper fire from vic BT (581030), elm ACo. loc BT (581032) they received (2) rds sniper fire, returned (2) rds M-14 fire results unknown

- 161505H - Elm BCo. 3dAmTracBn. were in vic BT(435055) when they received one 60mm mortar rd from BT (452039). No casualties.
- ISUM No. 73 - 181345H - Elm of BCo. 3dAmTracBn. observed (2) mortar rds explode opposite side of hill vic BT (455044). No action taken, continued on mission.
- ISUM No. 74 - 191545H - 3Elm BCo. 3dAmTracBn. (5) received (5) rds enemy small arms fire. Returned (20) rds small arms fire neg results.
- ISUM No. 75 - 201830H - Elm ACo. 3dAmTracBn. LVT recd (5) rds of enemy small arms fire from vic BS (623993), LVT was vic BT (622009). LVT crew returned (40) rds of small arms fire, results unk proceeded on mission.
- ISUM No. 76 - 211730H - Elm BCo. 3dAmTracBn. observed (1) VC running in vic of BT (469071), VC fired (15) rds small arms fire. Squad of troops swept area, (1) VCS was captured without weapon or arms.
