Baby Health Examination Campaign  
according to Article 19 of Child Welfare Law

1. Purpose of the campaign

In order to cut down the death rate of babies and to bring them up into healthy children, babies under 2 years old will get thorough health examination. Their parents will be guided on necessary things for baby's health and nursing, especially on improvement of nutrition and disease control, particularly TB control. For such babies as are found sick or irregular, proper steps for protection will be taken immediately.

2. Period of the campaign

About the middle of October - end of November 1949

3. Method of carrying it out

- a) Each Health Center will have its own schedule.
- b) The examination will include weighing, tuberculin test, X-ray test, blood test for syphilis, nutrition, etc.

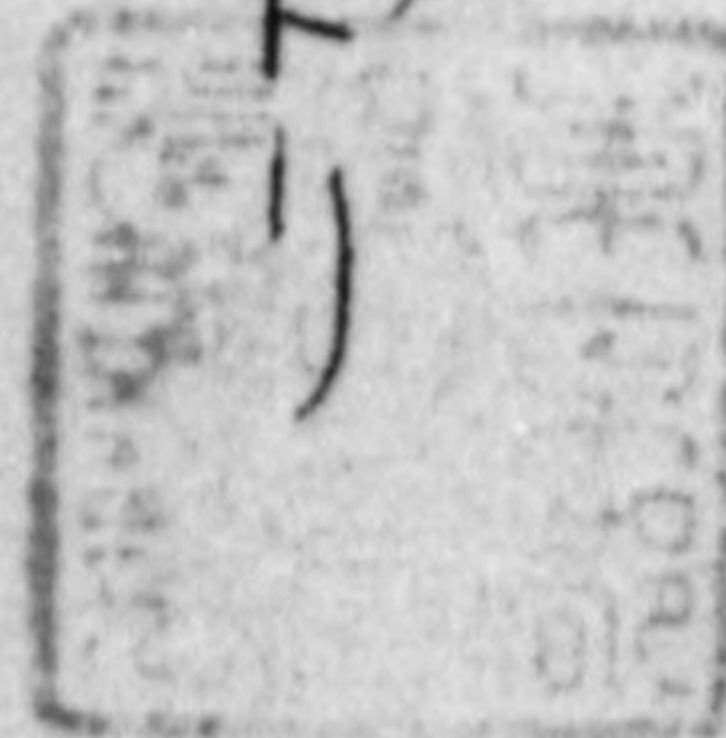

DUTIES OF NURSES IN PREVENTIVE INJECTIONS

1. Preparation

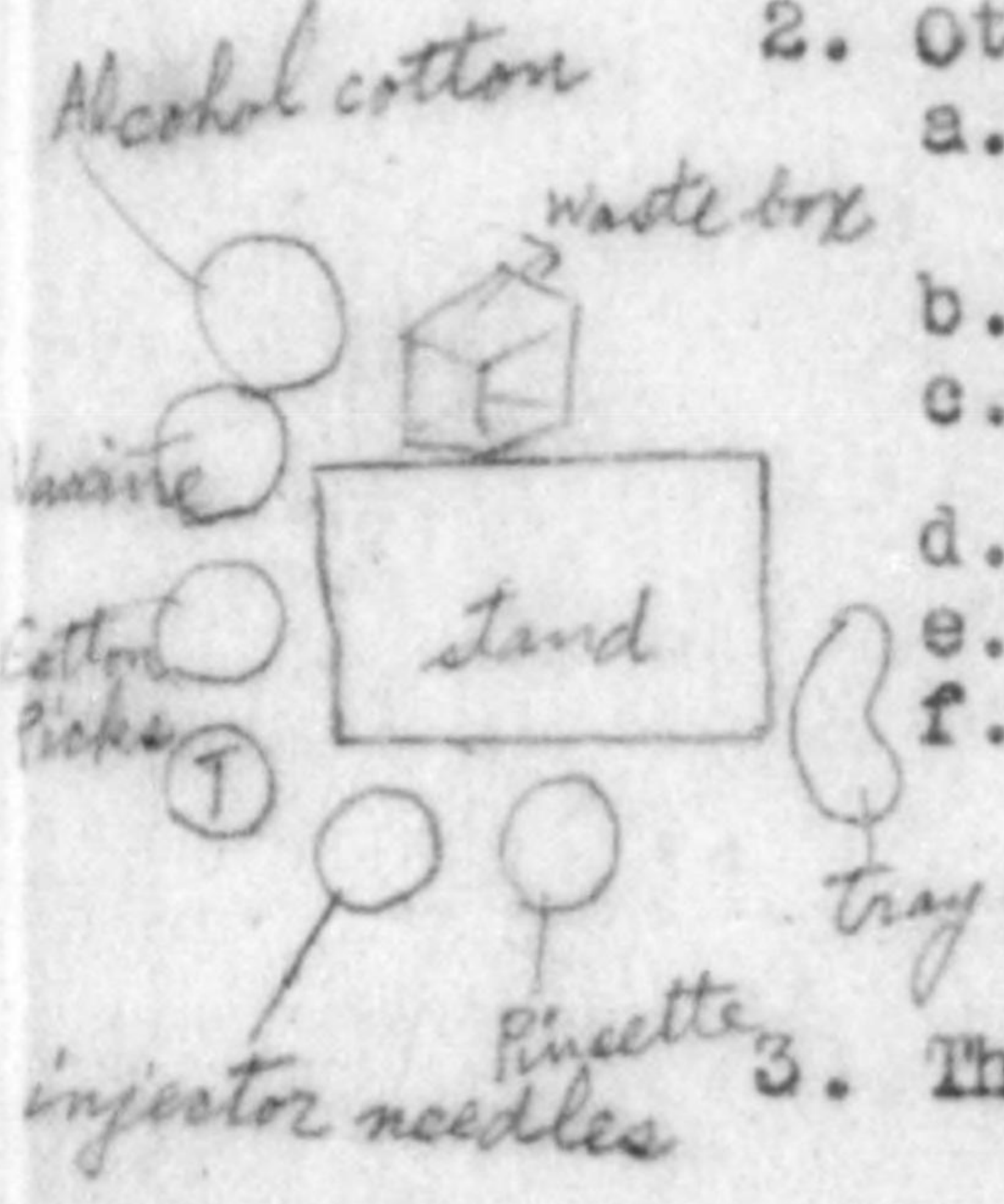
The disinfection-can will be filled with water and heated.

- a. Proper number of 1.0-2.0cc of injectors will be wrapped in gauze.
- b. After a careful examination,  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$  needles will be wrapped in gauze.
- c. Pincette, and pincette-stand,
- d. Petri-dish and tray,
- e. Injector-stand

All these things will be put in the can, and after five minutes' boiling taken out on the tray, which will be covered with gauze.

2. Other things to be prepared

- a. alcohol cotton (prepared in a pot or petri-dish and covered)
- b. Tincture of iodine
- c. Cotton-picks ) to be used for disinfection of injecting spot.
- d. Trays (for soiled injectors and needles)
- e. Waste box (Paper)
- f. Vaccine (taking out of the refrigerator, ~~assure~~ the label, *be assured,*)

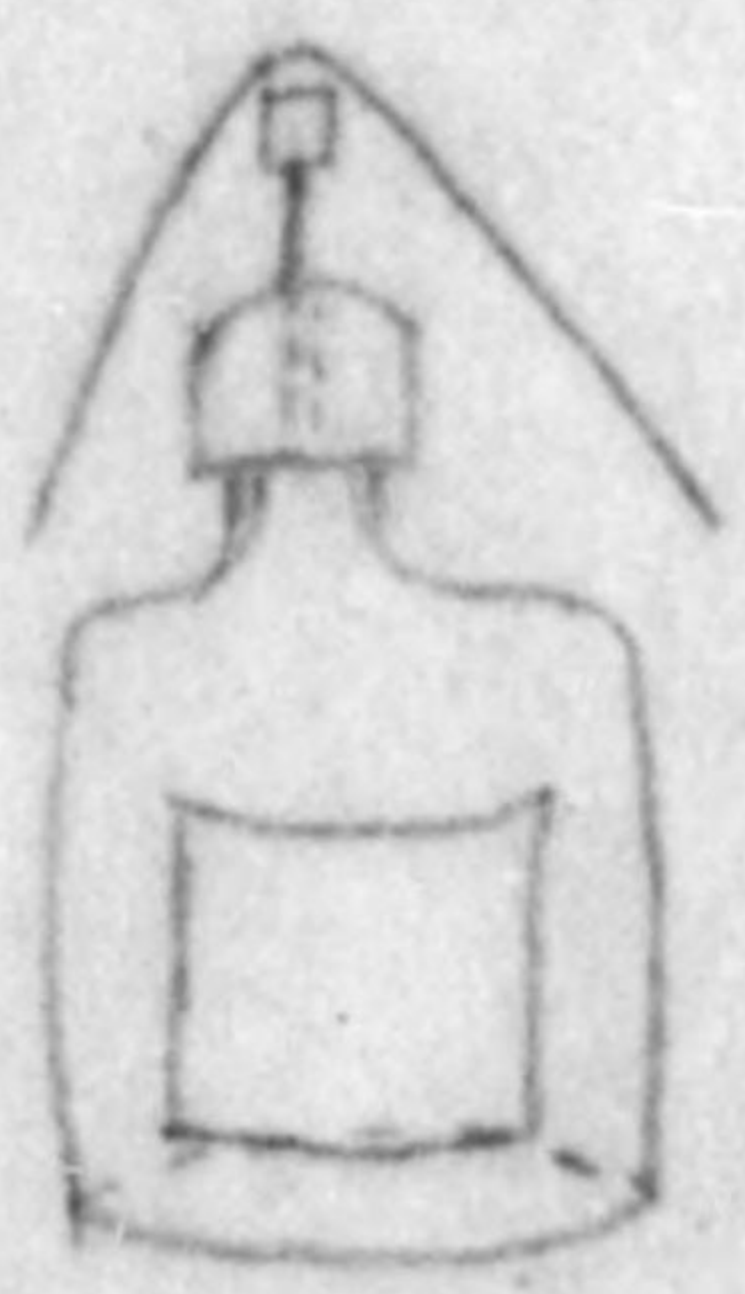


3. The place for arrangement ( a place convenient both to the doctors and nurses will be chosen)

4. Cautions for drawing the vaccine in the injector (Shake the bottle well)

- 1. In case where the stopper of the bottle is gum, it will be disinfected with alcohol-cotton carefully and a disinfected needle will be put through at the middle. Putting the injector in the needle, and keeping the bottle upside down draw 1.0-2.0cc vaccine in. The injector will be taken off the needle, which remain as it is, covered with disinfected gauze. A disinfected needle will be put on the vaccine containing injector, then it will be arranged in the disinfected tray.
- 2. In case where the stopper of the bottle is a thick gum or cork, the stopper and the neck of the bottle will be disinfected carefully with alcohol cotton, the stopper taken off, and the vaccine drawn in the injector directly through a needle. The stopper will be immediately put in the bottle and covered with gauze.

5. Disinfection of the spot of the injection

The spot will be disinfected with ticture of iodine, soaked in a cotton-pick, applying ~~the~~ it from the center to outwards. A cotton-pick will be used for one person only.

According to doctors, endodermic or subcutaneous injections are conducted.

The needle is taken off the syringe each time when it is used, then other disinfected one is put on the ~~syringe~~ with a disinfected pincette, for the continued injection.

6. The soiled injectors and the needles are washed and disinfected ready for the continued use by the doctor.

Note: Both doctors and nurses should wash their hands carefully before beginning the injection.

MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH PROGRAM  
19 July 1948

Maternal and Child Health Section  
Ministry of Welfare

Policy

Future Japan as a civilized peace loving country shall need to have full security of the health of mothers and children.

With the aim of a great reduction of mortality and morbidity of mothers, infants and preschool children of this country and promotion of children's health and development in view, the basic program is to be established and various necessary facilities will be installed within five years.

1. Health measures for pregnant and nursing mothers are to be carried out with special emphasis on the following items:
  - a. Reduction of maternal and fetal deaths by means of early diagnosis and treatment of toxemias during pregnancy.
  - b. Reduction of number of miscarriages, premature and stillbirths by means of early diagnosis and treatment of syphilis in pregnant women.
  - c. To reduce the maternal deaths and stillbirths due to malposition of fetus and hemorrhage of childbirth by improved obstetrical practices.
  - d. To prevent tuberculosis of mothers and children by diagnosis of pregnant mothers.
2. Measures for the reduction of infant and child deaths shall be carried out with special emphasis on the following points:
  - a. To reduce the infant deaths due to such outstanding causes as congenital debility, enteritis and diarrhea, pneumonia and congenital syphilis.
  - b. To prevent all contagious diseases of childhood.
3. For the improvement of constitutional strength of infants and children, emphasis shall be laid on the following points:
  - a. To provide standards and nutritional guidance for infants so that the supply of cow's milk and milk products to artificially or mixed fed infants will be sufficient and proper.
  - b. To provide standards for children's food and its distribution to preschool children in order to give them sufficient amount of protein, fat, calcium, iron and vitamins.
