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## ARGENTINE REPUBLIC.

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### CUSTOMS DUTIES FOR 1896.

MONEY, WEIGHTS AND MEASURES.—The Customs duties are levied in the Argentine Republic in specie. The monetary unit is the *peso*—100 *centavos*—about 4s. (nominal value.) For weights and measures the metrical system has been adopted.

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ART. 1 Foreign goods imported into the Republic, and national products not exempt from export duties shall, respectively, during the year 1896, be subject to the hereinafter stipulated import and export duties.

#### CHAPTER I. IMPORT DUTIES.

ART. 2. The under-mentioned goods shall pay the following percentage duties on value:

§ 1.—25 % AD VALOREM.

- 1 All goods not specially enumerated in the present Law or which are not exempt from duty.

§ 2.—50 % AD VALOREM.

- 2 Arms, accessories and their appurtenances.
- 3 Harness, and saddlers' articles in general, complete or not.
- 4 Articles of all kinds of tissues, completely or partly made up.

- 5 Sword sticks.
- 6 Portmanteaus, valises and trunks.
- 7 Bags, leather, exceeding 25 centimetres, with or without their accessories.
- 8 Boots and shoes, ready-made or in pieces.
- 9 Vehicles, finished or not, with bodies and shafts in the rough, for the same.
- 10 Cartridges for fire-arms.
- 11 Fireworks.
- 12 Mosaics.
- 13 Furniture, finished, or parts of furniture.
- 14 Ammunition (bullets and shot.)
- 15 Perfumery in general.
- 16 Gunpowder of all kinds.
- 17 Ready-made clothing.
- 18 Hats or caps not subject to a specific duty.

## CHAPTER II.

## EXPORT DUTIES.

ART. 4. The following products and manufactured articles of the country shall, on exportation, pay the following percentage duties on value:

## § I.—2 % AD VALOREM.

246 Jerked or salted meat.

## § II.—4 % AD VALOREM.

247 Animal oil.

248 Horns and scrapings of horn, of all kinds.

249 Bone ash.

250 Bristles.

251 Hides and skins.

252 Hoofs of ovine or bovine animals.

253 Cabaline oil.

254 Bones of all kinds.

255 Wool, sheep's, in the grease or washed.

256 Hoofs and claws, other than of ovine or bovine animals.

257 Ostrich feathers.

258 Tallow or grease, rendered or pressed.

259 Scrap iron and steel shall pay a duty of 10 pesos per 1,000 kilogs.

## CHAPTER III.

## ARTICLES ADMITTED FREE OF DUTY.

ART. 5. The following articles shall be exempt from import duty:

260 Cork (bark or slabs).

261 Sand and stone imported on vessels as necessary ballast and destined to Municipalities.

262 Animals of all kinds, provided that they have been previously examined by a veterinary surgeon.

263 Vessels, complete or in sections.

264 Sugar cane.

265 Coal and charcoal, for fuel.

266 Casks of wood or iron, put together or not, used as receptacles.

- 267 Coke.
- 268 Chairs, rails of iron or steel, iron sleepers, and fish-plates, for railways or steam tramways.
- 269 Staves for casks.
- 270 Recipients, special bales or sacks, cases (put together or not), and tin-plate cut for receptacles, imported directly by establishments for meat preserving, for packing their products.
- 271 Sheep dip of all kinds.
- 272 Fruits and vegetables, fresh, excepting grapes.
- 273 Flour of wheat or maize.
- 274 Fire wood of all kinds.
- 275 Locomotives, and extra parts thereof.
- 276 Maize, in cobs or in the grain.
- 277 Mowers, binders or reapers, with or without motors, platforms, tarpaulins or oilcloth, and extra parts thereof.
- 278 Thrashers, steam, with or without motors, oilcloth or tarpaulins, and extra parts thereof.
- 279 Steam gins, with or without motors, oilcloth or tarpaulins, and extra parts thereof.
- 280 Furniture and implements of immigrants, included in their baggage.
- 281 Coin (specie.)
- 282 Naphtha and crude petroleum, and carbuarine.
- 283 Objects intended exclusively for Churches, imported at the request of ecclesiastics.
- 284 Gold, in nuggets, ingots or powder.
- 285 Water filters, of the Pasteur system and the like.
- 286 Fish, fresh.
- 287 Silver, in bars or ingots.
- 288 Plants, live, imported conformably to the Law, No. 2384.
- 289 Powder, blasting.
- 290 Reviews, journals, and scientific and literary publications, with or without illustrations, and copy-books with models, for schools.
- 291 Seeds, for sowing, of all kinds, other than those dutiable according to the present Law.
- 292 Wheat.
- 293 Articles for schools, imported at the request of the Provincial Governments or the National Council of Public Instruction.

ART. 6. Products of the country which are not specially taxed in the present Law may be exported free of duty.

ART. 7. The Executive may not accord exemptions other than those established in this Law or in special Laws.

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## EXTRACTS FROM THE DECREE OF JANUARY 24, 1896, REGARDING THE EXECUTION OF THE CUSTOMS LAW.

ART. 18. When captains, commissaries or masters of vessels, sailing or steam, of whatever nationality and tonnage, sail with a cargo shipped in ports of a neighboring State in destination of ports of the Republic or in transit to foreign ports, they must present in the first Argentine port of arrival the general manifest of their cargo, in duplicate copies, one of which must be viséd by the Argentine Consul. These two copies must contain the following details:

1. The name of the shipper ;
2. The place of destination of the goods ;
3. The name of the consignee ;
4. The marks, numbers of the packages and their special designation ;
5. The contents of each package, with statement of the kind and quality of each article ;
6. Date and signature of the captain or master or of his agent.

ART. 19. The general manifest of sailing vessels or steamships, other than mail packet-boats, must be drawn up by the Customs from whence proceeding in the above-mentioned form, and accompany the vessel during the voyage.

Mail packet-boats which could not obtain the Consular legalization to their manifest before departure, may present these documents on the arrival of the next vessel of the same line ; immediately on their entry into the port of destination they must, however, deposit a general manifest, in duplicate, signed by the Captain of the steamer and by his agent in the port, containing all the details stipulated in Art. 25.

ART. 20. Fines incurred by Captains, commissaries or masters of vessels for not having presented the manifests legalized by the competent Argentine Consuls must be paid in gold and conformably to the prescriptions established in the Customs ordinances in force.

ART. 21. Captains, commissaries or masters of vessels, as well as their agents, who shall not deposit their Consular manifests on the arrival of the next steamer plying for the same line, or who present these documents not containing the details stipulated in Art. 18, shall be liable to the penalties prescribed by the Customs ordinances.

The viséd manifests, transmitted by the next steamer, can not modify the details given in the manifest presented to the Customs on the entry of the vessel.

ART. 22. As conformably to the prescriptions of the Ordinances and to the Customs Law, Captains of vessels, taking cargo in a foreign port in destination of ports of the Republic, must cause their manifests and

bills-of-lading, as well as the certificate attesting that they sailed in ballast and their bills of health to be legalized by an Argentine Consul. Captains who have not complied with these stipulations, whatever be the tonnage and nationality of the vessel, shall be liable to the taxes established by the law of December 6, 1886, without prejudice to a fine of double the amount.

National vessels, of a tonnage of less than 40 tons and exempt from all Consular fees, which have not complied with the above-mentioned formalities, shall be liable to the taxes and fines conformably to the Schedule established in Art. 24 of the Customs ordinances.

ART. 28. Masters of vessels must comply with Art. 54 of the Law and for this purpose must present on their arrival a separate manifest, giving in detail the kind, quality and quantity of the goods referred to in the aforesaid Article.

ART. 29. Masters of vessels, or their agents, must see that the cases they ship with goods destined to the Republic bear their proper marks and numbers, not on the lids, but on the side. They must likewise indicate on the packages the name of the importing vessel. The non-observance of these formalities will suffice to prevent the landing of the cases.

NOTE.—A tare of 5% for leakage shall be granted to wines, oils, brandy, beer and liquors, in casks, proceeding from ports situated north of the Equator.

Similar goods proceeding from ports situated south of the Equator shall enjoy a tare of 2% for leakage.

Should the same articles be imported in bottles, from wheresoever proceeding, they shall be entitled to a tare of 2% for breakage. (*Article 15 of the additional Customs Law*).

La unidad monetaria es el *peso*, que vale nominalmente 5 pesetas y se divide en 100 *centavos*. Con respecto á pesas y medidas se ha adoptado el sistema métrico.

ART. 1.—Las mercaderías de procedencia extranjera, á su introducción, y los productos del país, cuya exportación no es libre, pagarán respectivamente los derechos de importación y exportación que en seguida se establecen, durante el año de 1896:

ART. 6.—Los productos del país que no estén especialmente gravados por esta ley se exportarán libres de derechos.

ART. 7.—El Poder Ejecutivo no podrá acordar otras franquicias que las establecidas en esta ley ó en leyes especiales.

DISPOSICIONES SACADAS DEL DECRETO REGLAMENTARIO  
DE LA LEY DE ADUANA DE 24 DE ENERO DE 1896.

ART. 18. Los capitanes, comisarios ó patrones de buques de cualquier bandera ó tonelaje, sean á vela ó á vapor, que zarpen con carga tomada en los puertos de los Estados vecinos, con destino á puertos de la República ó en tránsito para puertos extranjeros, presentarán en el primer puerto argentino que toquen, el manifiesto general de todo su cargamento, en dos ejemplares, uno de ellos visado por el Cónsul argentino, expresándose en ambos:

1º El nombre del remitente; 2º el punto donde se destinan las mercaderías; 3º el nombre de las personas á quienes van consignadas; 4º las marcas, números y envases de los bultos, determinándose con precisión la clase de envase; 5º el contenido de cada bulto, expresándose la clase y calidad de cada género; y 6º la fecha y firma del cargador ó su agente.

ART. 19. El manifiesto general de los buques á vela ó de los vapores sin privilegio de paquete deberá ser expedido por la Aduana de procedencia en la forma antedicha y conducido por el mismo buque en el mismo viaje.

Los vapores con privilegio que no puedan obtener la legalización consular de sus manifiestos antes de su salida podrán presentarlos á la llegada del siguiente vapor de la misma carrera; pero á su arribo al puerto de destino, presentarán un manifiesto general firmado por el capitán del vapor y su agente en el puerto, en dos ejemplares y con todos los detalles que se determinan en el artículo 25.

ART. 20. Las multas en que incurran los capitanes, comisarios ó patrones de buques, por no presentar los manifiestos legalizados por los Cónsules argentinos respectivos, se harán efectivas á oro y en el modo y forma que determinan las Ordenanzas de Aduana vigentes.

ART. 21. Los capitanes, comisarios ó patrones de buques y sus agentes que no presenten sus manifiestos consulares en el siguiente vapor de la carrera, ó que los presenten sin los detalles establecidos en el artículo 25, sufrirán la pena establecida por las Ordenanzas de Aduana.

Los manifiestos visados que llegasen por el siguiente vapor no podrán alterar lo detallado en el presentado á las Aduanas á la llegada del buque.

ART. 22. Debiendo los capitanes de buques que carguen en puerto extranjero con destino á los de la República haer legalizar por el Cónsul argentino los manifiestos y conocimientos de sus cargamentos, como también los certificados de salir en lastre y la carta de sanidad, con arreglo á las prescripciones de las Ordenanzas y á la ley de Aduana, á todos los que no llenen ese requisito, cualesquiera que sean su tonelaje

y bandera, se les cobrará el impuesto que determina la ley de 6 de Diciembre de 1886, con más la multa del duplo.

A las embarcaciones de bandera nacional menores de cuarenta toneladas exceptuadas de todo emolumento consular y que falten á esos requisitos, se les aplicará el impuesto y multa con arreglo á la escala establecida por el artículo 24 de las Ordenanzas de Aduana.

ART. 28. Los capitanes de buques cumplirán lo preceptuado en el artículo 54 de la ley, presentando á su entrada al puerto un manifiesto por separado, con determinación de la especie, calidad y cantidad de las mercaderías á que dicho artículo se refiere.

ART. 29. Los capitanes ó agentes de buques tratarán que los cajones que conduzcan á su bordo con mercaderías para la República lleven la marca y números respectivos, no en las tapas, sino en los costados: debiendo también consignarse en ellos el nombre del buque importador. La falta de estos requisitos será causa bastante para que se impida la descarga de los cajones

## REPUBLICA ARGENTINA.

LEI ADUANEIRA DE 1895, COM AS MODIFICAÇÕES  
INTRODUZIDAS PELA DE 1896.

Moedas, pesos e medidas.—Os direitos de Alfandega na Republica Argentina pagar-se-hão em moeda metallica de curso legal.

A unidade monetaria é o peso, que se divide em 100 centavos. Para pesos e medidas rege o systema metrico.

ARTICLE 1º.—As mercadorias de procedencia estrangeira, no momento de sua importação, e os productos do paiz cuja exportação não é livre, pagarão respectivamente os direitos de importação e exportação indicados em seguida, durante o anno de 1896:

## CAPITULO I.

## DIREITOS DE IMPORTACÃO.

ART. 2º.—Pagarão um direito de tanto por cento *ad valorem* as mercadorias seguintes:

## CLASSE 1ª—25% AD VALOREM.

- 1 Todas as mercadorias para as quaes não se especifique nesta tarifa algum direito, e as que não estejam izentas de direitos.

## CLASSE 2ª—50% AD VALOREM.

- 2 Arinas e suas pertenças ou accessorios.
- 3 Arreios em geral, completos ou incompletos.
- 4 Artigos de qualquer tecido, acabados ou por acabar.
- 5 Bengalas com estoque.

EXTRACTOS DO DECRETO REGULAMENTARIO DA LEI ADUANEIRA.—BUENOS AIRES, 24 DE JANEIRO DE 1896.

ART. 18. Os capitães, commissarios ou patrões de navios de qualquer bandeira ou tonelagem, quer de vela, quer a vapor, que seguirem com carga tomada nos portos dos Estados vizinhos, com distina aos da Republica, ou em transitio para portos estrangeiros, apresentarão no primeiro porto argentino em que entrarem, o manifesto geral de todo o seu carregamento, em dous exemplares, um delles visado pelo Consul argentino, cpressando—se em ambos :

1º. O nome do consignante ; 2º o porto de destino das mercadorias ; 3º os nomes dos consignatarios ; 4º as marcas, numeros e acondicionamento



dos volumes ; 5º o contendo de cada volume, expressando-se a classe e qualidade de cada artigo ; 6º a assignatura do carregador ou seu agenté, com a data.

ART. 19 O Manifesto geral dos navios de vela e dos vapores seu privilegio de paquete, deve ser expedido pela Alfandega do porto de procedencia, na forma indicada e vir no mesmo vapor na mesma viagem.

Os vapores com privilegio de paquete, que não pudérem conseguir a legalização consular de seus manifestos antes de sua sahida, poderão apresentar-los á chegada do seguinte vapor da mesma linha ; porem ao chegarem ao porto de destino, devem apresentar um manifesto geral assignado pelo capitão do vapor e seu agente no porto, em dous exemplares, e com todos os detalhes enumerados no Art. 25.

ART. 20. As multas em que eucorrerem os capitãos, commissarios ou patrões de navios, por não apresentarem os manifestos legalizados pelos respectivos Consules argentinos, devem—ser pagas em ouro e na forma determinada pelas Ordenanças da Alfandega.

ART. 21. Os capitãos, commissarios ou patrões de buques e seus agentes, que não apresentem seus manifestos consulares no seguinte vapor da linha, ou que os apresentem seu os detalhes indicados no Art. 25, soffrerão a pena estabelecida pelas Ordenanças da Alfandega.

ART. 22. Devendo os capitãos de navios que recebam carga em porto estrangeiros com destiuo aos da Republica, mandar legalizar pelo Consul argentino os manifestos e conhecimentos de su carregamento, como tambem os certificados de sahir em lastro e a carta de saude, de accordo com as disposições das Ordenanças e a lei aduaneira, a todos os que não cumprirem esta disposição, qualquer que seja a bandeira e tonelagem do navio, será cobrado o imposto estabelccido pela lei de 6 de Dezembro de 1885, com mais uma multa do dobro.

ART. 28. Os capitãos de navios devem cumprir o disposto no art. 54 da lei, apresentando á sua entrada no porto um manifesto separado, especificando a classe, qualidade e quantidade das mercadorias referidas no dito artigo.

ART. 29. Os capitãos ou agentes de navios exigirão que as caixas que tragam a seu bordo com mercadorias para a Republica tenham a marca e numeros respectivos, não nas tampas, mas sim nas costas ; devendo-se tambem trazer o nome do navio portador. O não cumprir esta disposição será motivo sufficiente para impedir a descarga das caixas.

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EXTRAITS DU DÉCRET DU 24 JANVIER, 1896, RELATIFS A LA  
MISE EN VIGUEUR DE LA LOI DOUANIÈRE.

ART. 18. Lorsque les capitaines, commissaires ou patrons de navires, à voile ou à vapeur, quels que soient le pavillon et le tonnage, prendront la mer avec un chargement embarqué dans les ports des Etats voisins à destination des ports de la République ou en transit pour des ports étrangers, ils devront présenter, dans le premier port d'arrivée argentin le manifeste général de tout leur chargement, en deux exemplaires, dont l'un devra être visé par le consul argentin. Ces deux exemplaires contiendront les indications ci-après : 1° le nom de l'expéditeur ; 2° le point de destination des marchandises ; 3° le nom des consignataires ; 4° les marques, les numéros des colis et leur désignation spéciale ; 5° le contenu de chaque colis, avec mention de l'espèce et de la qualité de chaque article ; 6° la date et la signature du chargeur ou de son agent.

ART. 19. Le manifeste général des navires à voiles ou des bâtiments à vapeur, autres que les paquebots-poste, devra être rédigé par la douane de provenance dans la forme ci-dessus indiquée et accompagner le navire pendant le voyage.

Les paquebots-poste qui n'auraient pu obtenir la légalisation consulaire de leur manifeste avant le départ pourront présenter ces documents à l'arrivée du prochain vapeur de la même ligne ; cependant, dès leur entrée dans le port de destination, ils déposeront un manifeste général en deux exemplaires signé par le capitaine du vapeur et par son agent dans le port, et comprenant toutes les indications stipulées à l'article 25.

ART. 20. Les amendes encourues par les capitaines, commissaires ou patrons de navires pour ne pas avoir présenté les manifestes légalisés par les consuls argentins compétents, seront acquittées en or et conformément aux prescriptions établies dans les ordonnances de douane en vigueur.

ART. 21. Les capitaines, commissaires ou patrons de navires, ainsi que leurs agents, qui ne déposeront pas leurs manifestes consulaires à l'arrivée du prochain vapeur affecté au service de la ligne qu'ils



des-servent ou qui présenteront ces documents non munis des indications imposées par l'article 25, seront punis conformément aux ordonnances de la douane.

Les manifestes visés qui arriveront par le prochain vapeur ne pourront changer les indications portées sur le manifeste aux douanes à l'arrivée du navire.

ART. 22. Attendu que, conformément aux prescriptions des ordonnances et aux termes de la loi douanière, les capitaines de navires, chargeant dans un port étranger à destination des ports de la République, doivent faire légaliser par le consul argentin les manifestes et connaissements de leurs chargements, ainsi que les certificats établissant qu'ils sont partis sur lest et la patente de santé, les capitaines qui ne se seraient pas conformés à ces stipulations, quels que soient le tonnage et le pavillon du navire, seront soumis à la taxe établie par la loi du 6 décembre 1880, sans préjudice de l'amende du double.

Les bâtiments nationaux, jaugeant moins de 40 tonneaux et exemptés de tous droits consulaires, qui ne se seraient pas conformés aux formalités sus-indiquées, devront acquitter la taxe et l'amende conformément au tableau établi à l'article 24 des ordonnances douanières.

ART. 28. Les capitaines des navires se conformeront à l'article 54 de la loi, et à cet effet ils présenteront à l'arrivée un manifeste à part, contenant la désignation de l'espèce, de la qualité et de la quantité des marchandises auxquelles ledit article se rapporte

ART. 29. Les capitaines de navires ou leurs agents feront en sorte que les caisses qu'ils embarquent avec des marchandises destinées à la République, portent la marque et les numéros qui leurs sont propres, non pas sur le couvercle, mais sur les côtés. ## HONDURAS.

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Advices from Tegucigalpa of recent date state that a great impetus has been given to the cultivation of coffee and cacao in Honduras. Large tracts of land for this purpose have been purchased by foreign syndicates who are setting about for the immediate development of the land.

## MEXICO.

The Board of Health of the City of Mexico has issued the following circular calling for tenders for steam machinery, etc., to be used in the drainage of that city :

The Sanitation Board, appointed by the City Government of Mexico, to administer the funds and carry out the Sanitation Works, invites the builders of steam machinery and pumps of all nations to present tenders by the 14th of November next, for the sale of a steam engine which will operate one or more pumps, with a capacity for driving nineteen millions Imperial gallons every twenty-four hours through the pipes that will be employed to carry the water for flushing the sewers, with a pressure equivalent to that of a column of water 40 feet high, taking it from a reservoir with a constant level of water 5 feet below the level of the soil.

The engine and the pump, or pumps, must be of a simple and strong pattern, adapted to continuous work and of the most economical type possible with regard to the consumption of coal.

The boilers must be of the pattern known as "water tube boilers," raising plenty of steam with small consumption of coal. The contractors must supply one boiler more than the number required, so as to have a substitute.

The engine must not have more than the pieces absolutely required for the purpose to which it will be dedicated, and it must be a condensing and ample expansion engine.

The pumps must be of the vertical, single acting plunger type, with outside packing, or of any other system that the builder considers more advantageous.

The boilers, engine and pumps must come accompanied by their fittings, and also by the necessary gauges to observe and correct their working.

The contractors must guarantee that the duty obtained by the consumption of one hundred pounds of Cardiff coal, "Crown" brand, in the boiler furnaces, shall not be less than one hundred million seven hundred thousand (100,700,000) foot-pounds.

The machinery and pumps to be tendered for, must be delivered in the City of Mexico, not later than nine months after the date on which the tender is accepted.

The erection will be carried out at the cost of the Board, under the direction of the contractor's engineer, and in accordance with the instructions supplied by the contractors, or, should it be so desired, the contractor may also undertake the erection for a specified sum.

The value of the machinery will be paid by gold drafts drawn on New York, London, Paris or Hamburg, each draft being for twenty-five per cent. of the total amount, and the dates of payment distributed from the date on which the contract is executed, up to that on which the machinery is received in Mexico. The last payment will be deposited in one of the Banks of the City of Mexico, and will bear interest at the rate of half per cent. per month to the credit of the contractor, who will not receive that money until the necessary trials have been made to show that the machinery fulfills the requirements of the specifications.

The contractors will guarantee the sums that they may receive in advance on account of the machinery, and they will also furnish a bond of ten thousand dollars, to guarantee the fulfilment of the contract they execute.

The Sanitation Board of Mexico City will admit tenders of a different character from those specified, both as to the form of the machinery and as to the form of payment, always provided that they do not make any change in the time of delivery, the amount of water to be elevated by the machinery, the pressure with which it has to be pumped, or the duty of the engine.

The tenders must be forwarded in sealed covers addressed to the Sanitation Board of the City of Mexico, and must be accompanied by the specification, plans, elevations, and sections that may be necessary for their perfect understanding. They will be publicly opened on the 31st of October next, at 3 P. M., in the offices of the Board, and the Board will decide during the month of November if it will accept any of the tenders presented, in which case the corresponding contract will be made out, in which a clause will be inserted, that the differences arising as to the quality and condition of the machinery or its erection will be decided by experts, one of whom shall be appointed by each side, and an umpire in case of discord, who shall be appointed by mutual agreement. Should no agreement be reached as to the appointment of the umpire, he will be appointed by the Director of the School of Engineers in the City of Mexico.

The contract will be executed as a public instrument, at the expense of the Board.

The tenders which may be presented to the Board must be accompanied by the designation of a person in the City of Mexico, who is fully authorized to execute the respective contract, in case the tender is accepted by the Board.

The specifications of the machinery, in Spanish and English, can be obtained in Mexico at the offices of the Sanitation Board, Calle de San Juan de Letran No. 13; in New York, at the Mexican Consulate, No. 35 Broadway, and in London, at the Mexican Consulate, Broad Street House, New Broad street, E. C.

FOREIGN COMMERCE OF THE UNITED STATES FOR  
JULY 1896 COMPARED WITH JULY 1895.

The total value of the imports of the United States for the month of July, 1896, as shown by the report of the Bureau of Statistics of the Treasury Department, amounted to \$52,108,552; of this 43.52 per cent. were free of duty. For the corresponding period of the previous year the imports were \$73,025,646; of which 44.94 per cent. were free.

From the above figures it will be seen that there was a falling off of \$20,817,094 in imports for July of the current year.

An examination of the details of the report discloses the fact that this large decrease is shared in an almost uniform degree by all of the leading articles of importation.

The importation of live animals, dutiable and free, amounted in July, 1896, to \$82,680, in 1895 to \$176,116—a loss of \$93,436, which is found mainly in dutiable cattle shipped from British North America.

The importation of breadstuffs exceeds that of July, 1895, by \$78,000. This excess is made up in the shipments of wheat.

The falling off in the receipts of logwood amounts in round numbers to \$118,000, all of which is found in the receipts from the West Indies and Cuba. In this commodity the imports from Central America and Mexico were practically the same for the two months under consideration.

The importation of cacao shows a falling off of exactly \$100,000. From the Central American states the receipts were nothing, against \$1,430 for July, 1895. Brazil shows a loss of \$27,000, and other South American republics \$67,000. The total receipts were: July, 1896, \$225,236, and July, 1895, \$325,201.

The importation of coffee reached 41,187,935 pounds, valued at \$5,626,291, against 50,425,506 pounds, valued at \$7,027,155 for July of the previous year; a loss amounting to nearly one and half million dollars, the whole of which is found in the receipts from Brazil.

Under the general head of cotton and manufactures of, there is no notable change in the imports for the periods under review.

The importation of oranges from Mexico to the United for the month of July of the current year is marked by a great improvement over the same period of the preceding year; the receipts were \$3,937, against \$12.00 for July, 1895. The receipts from Italy show an astonishing decrease, the figures being, in July, 1896, \$1,067, and for July, 1895, \$60,554. In other fruits the change is not notable.

Under the head of hides and skins the following figures are found; July, 1895, \$4,269,256; July, 1896, \$1,295,946, the difference in favor of the previous year being \$2,973,310. South America supplies \$700,000 of this loss, and Mexico \$40,000. The balance is shared by the various European countries.

The importation of crude India rubber from the Latin American countries shows no appreciable change for the two months at present under consideration. The shipments from Brazil were \$331,235, and for the corresponding date of 1895, \$327,510. From other Latin American countries the imports amounted in the aggregate to \$78,000, against \$89,359 in July, 1895.

Under raw silks there is found a striking decrease of \$916,000, and in manufactures of silk \$840,000.

In the category of sugar, molasses and confectionery, the difference is inappreciable.

In leaf tobacco there is a decrease shown amounting to \$1,200,000, of which \$600,000 is chargeable to Cuba, and a corresponding amount to the imports from the Netherlands. Mexico shows a gain of \$3,000.

In the list of wools there is a decrease of \$2,120,000 in class 1 (clothing). Of this amount South America sustains \$53,000, the balance coming from the United Kingdom and France.

In class 2 (combing) the report shows no receipts for either month. Class 2 (carpet) shows a gain of \$59,000 in the imports from South America.

The total exports of domestic merchandise for July, 1896, amounted to \$65,687,277, compared with \$55,156,878 for the corresponding period of the previous year; a gain of \$10,530,399.

With the exception of Mexico, which shows an improvement of \$6,400, the exportation of agricultural implements to the Spanish American countries is marked by a general decrease; that to Argentina alone reaching \$195,433 for the month, and to the other South American countries a total decrease of \$10,400.

In live animals the exportation of hogs to Mexico continues to show a satisfactory gain—the figures for the two months were; July, 1896, \$15,115, July, 1895, \$400. In other animals there is no change to note.

Under the general head of breadstuffs the report shows for July, 1896, \$13,000,907; July, 1895, \$8,750,165; an increase of \$4,250,742. Mexico took from the United States corn to the value of \$142,213 against \$9,137 for the same period in 1895; a gain of \$133,000.

The total exportation of cotton reached 99,000 bales, valued at \$3,601,602, against 58,270 bales in July, 1895, estimated at \$1,918,979.

The exportation of American machinery shows a gratifying improvement, amounting in round numbers to \$1,000,000—the showing being, July, 1896, \$2,176,162; July, 1895, \$1,175,778.

The shipments of oil show an improvement in all grades. In the grade of "mineral refined" there was an increase of \$271,694, divided amongst the several Spanish American republics.

The total exports of provisions, comprising meat and dairy products, were for July, 1896, \$11,506,307, against \$12,204,310

for the corresponding month of 1895—a falling off of \$798,003. Three hundred thousand dollars of this is found in the item of cheese alone, mostly confined to the shipments to the United Kingdom and British North America. The exportation of lard fell off from \$2,807,650 in 1895 to \$1,754,029 in July, 1896. The shipments of fresh meat (beef) showed a gain of \$822,000, exclusively in the traffic with the United Kingdom.

Of manufactured tobacco there was a falling off of, approximately, \$400,000; while in manufactures of tobacco the two months under consideration showed no appreciable change.

With the exception of Cuba and Santo Domingo the trade in lumber with the Spanish American countries shows a satisfactory improvement. The total business of the United States in the exportation of wood, and manufactures of, was \$3,364,488, against \$2,778,121 for July, 1895.

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#### EXPORTS FOR AUGUST, 1896, IN COMPARISON WITH AUGUST, 1895.

The extraordinary improvement in the exports of the United States for July, 1896, as stated in the preceding article is carried into the month of August, as shown by the report of the Bureau of Statistics, just issued.

For the month the exports of the four principal articles show a total of \$35,863,003, against \$27,185,853 for the same month of the previous year.

The total for the eight months ending August 31st is shown to be \$437,761,220, against \$410,158,917 for the same period in 1895.



COMERCIO EXTRANJERO DE LOS ESTADOS UNIDOS  
EN EL MES DE JULIO DE 1896 COMPARA-  
DO CON EL DEL MISMO MES  
DEL AÑO ANTERIOR.

El valor total de las importaciones de los Estados Unidos en el mes de Julio de 1896, según consta del informe de la Oficina de Estadística del Departamento del Tesoro, ascendió á \$52,108,552. Un 43.52 por ciento de las mercaderías representadas por esta suma entró libre de derechos. En el mismo mes del año anterior las importaciones subieron á \$73,025,646, en cuya suma las mercaderías admitidas libremente representaron un 44.94 por ciento.

Resulta por lo tanto que ha habido una baja de \$20,817,094 en el mes de Julio del presente año.

Un exámen cuidadoso de los detalles del mencionado informe revela que los principales artículos de importación han sufrido casi uniformemente una gran baja.

La importación de ganado vivo, tanto del que se admite libre como del que paga derechos, subió en Julio de 1896 á \$82,680, mientras que en 1895 la suma representada fue \$176,116, de donde resulta una pérdida en el presente año de \$93,436, experimentada principalmente en el ganado que paga derechos introducido de las posesiones británicas del Norte América.

La importación de cereales ha sido mayor en Julio de este año que en Julio de 1895. El exceso ha subido hasta \$78,000, y está representado por la importación de trigos.

La baja en la importación de palos de tinte llega en números redondos á \$118,000, que en totalidad corresponden á la isla de Cuba y las demás Antillas. Las importaciones de este artí

culo de México y Centro América han sido prácticamente las mismas en Julio de este año que en Julio del año pasado.

La baja en la importación del cacao fue exactamente \$100,000. Nada se recibió de este artículo de Centro América en el mes de Julio de este año, pero en Julio de 1895 la importación representó \$1,439. En el Brasil hubo una pérdida de \$27,000, y en las demás Repúblicas de Sud América, la baja ha sido \$67,000. La total importación de cacao en Julio de 1896 ha sido \$225,236, mientras que en Julio del año anterior fue \$325,201.

La importación de café ascendió á 41,187,935 libras, estimadas en \$5,626,291. En Julio del año anterior entraron 50,425,526 libras estimadas en \$7,027,155, de donde aparece una pérdida de cerca de millón y medio de pesos, correspondientes en su totalidad al Brasil.

En el capítulo de algodón y sus manufacturas no ha habido cambio alguno notable.

En Julio de este año ha habido un gran aumento en la importación de naranjas de México, comparándola con la del mismo mes del año pasado. En este último las naranjas importadas representaron el valor de \$12.00, pero en Julio de este año el valor de las introducidas fue \$3,937.

La baja en la importación de naranjas de Italia es asombrosa: en Julio de 1895 fue \$60,554, mientras que en Julio de este año ha sido solamente \$1,067.

No hay cambio notable respecto de la importación de las otras frutas.

En el capítulo de cueros y pieles se encuentran los siguientes guarismos: Julio de 1895, \$4,269,256: Julio de 1896, \$1,295,946; diferencia en favor de 1895, \$2,973,310. De esta pérdida corresponden \$700,000 á la América del Sud, \$40,000 á México, y el resto á diversos países europeos.

La importación de goma elástica en bruto de los países latino americanos, no ofrece cambio importante. La recibida del Brazil en Julio de 1896 se estimó en \$331,235, mientras que la

recibida en el mismo mes de 1895 representó un valor de \$327,510. La recibida de los demás países hispano americanos representó en su totalidad, en 1896, \$78,000, contra \$89,359 en Julio de 1895.

En el capítulo de sedas crudas hay una enorme baja de \$916,000, y en el de artefactos de seda se nota también una baja de \$840,000.

La importación de las azúcares, mieles y dulces ha sido casi la misma en el mes de Julio de este año que en el mismo mes del pasado.

Ha habido una baja de \$1,200,000 en la importación del tabaco en rama. De esa suma \$600,000 corresponden á Cuba, y otro tanto á los Países Bajos. México resulta ganancioso en \$3,000.

En el capítulo correspondiente á las lanas, clase primera, (ropa) ha habido una disminución de \$2,120,000, de los que corresponden \$53,000 á la América del Sud y el resto al Reino Unido de la Gran Bretaña é Irlanda y á Francia. En cuanto á la Clase número 2 (alfombras) se nota una ganancia de \$59,000 en las importaciones de Sud América.

La exportación total de mercancías de los Estados Unidos en Julio de 1896 ha representado un valor de \$65,687,277 que comparados con los \$55,156,878 del mes de Julio del año anterior muestran una ganancia de \$10,530,399.

Excepuando á México, donde aparece un aumento de \$6,400, la exportación de instrumentos agrícolas para países hispano americanos ha decrecido notablemente. La baja con respecto á la República Argentina ha sido de \$195,433, y con respecto á las otras Repúblicas de Sud América la suma total representada por la baja importa \$10,400.

La exportación de cerdos vivos para México continúa en aumento. En Julio de 1895 fue por valor de \$400.00. En Julio de 1896 el valor ha sido \$15,115.

No se nota cambio en la exportación para México de otros animales vivos.

La exportación de cereales en Julio de 1896 ha sido \$13,000,907, mientras que en Julio de 1895 fue \$8,750,165, de donde resulta un aumento de \$4,250,742. El maíz de los Estados Unidos llevado á México en 1896 representa un valor de \$142,213, contra \$9,137 en el mismo mes del año anterior, de donde resulta una ganancia de \$133,000.

La total exportación de algodón, 99,000 pacas, representó este año un valor de \$3,601,602, contra 58,270 pacas en Julio de 1895, estimadas en \$1,918,979.

En la exportación de maquinaria americana se nota un importante aumento, que en números redondos llega á \$1,000,000. Las cifras son: Julio de 1896, \$2,176,162; Julio de 1895, \$1,175,778.

También se nota aumento en los embarques de aceite. En el aceite mineral refinado hubo un aumento de \$271,694 correspondiente por partes á las diversas Repúblicas hispano americanas.

La exportación de provisiones, incluyendo las carnes, y los productos de lechería, llegó en Julio de 1896 á \$11,506,307. En el mismo mes de 1895 esa exportación había sido por valor de \$12,204,310, resultando por lo tanto una baja de \$798,003.

La suma de \$300,000 corresponde en su totalidad al ramo de quesos, cuya exportación se ha limitado en su mayor parte al Reino Unido de la Gran Bretaña é Irlanda, y á las posesiones británicas de Norte América. La exportación de la manteca que en Julio de 1895 se estimó en \$2,807,650, bajó en Julio de 1896 á \$1,754,029.

Los embarques de carne fresca (buey) muestran una ganancia de \$822,000, exclusivamente en el tráfico con el Reino Unido.

También ha habido una baja de \$400,000, aproximadamente, en la exportación del tabaco manufacturado, si bien en las fábricas no se ha notado variación alguna.

El tráfico de maderas de construcción con los países españoles de América, está creciendo satisfactoriamente, excepto única-

mente en Cuba y Santo Domingo. La exportación total de maderas y artefactos de madera de los Estados Unidos fue en Julio de 1896, \$3,364,488, contra \$2,778,121 en Julio de 1895.

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EXPORTACIONES DE LOS ESTADOS UNIDOS EN  
AGOSTO DE 1896 COMPARADAS CON LAS  
DE AGOSTO DE 1895.

El extraordinario aumento en las exportaciones de los Estados Unidos, en Julio de 1896, según se muestra en el anterior artículo, continuó sintiéndose en el mes de Agosto siguiente, como lo demuestra el Informe de la Oficina de Estadística, correspondiente á dicho mes, que acaba de darse al público.

La exportación de los cuatro artículos principales alcanzó en este mes á \$35,863,003, mientras que en Agosto del año anterior fue solo \$27,185,853.

La exportación total durante los ocho meses que terminaron el 31 de Agosto de este año representa \$437,761,220, contra \$410,158,917 que corresponden al mismo periodo de ocho meses en 1895.

COMMERCE EXTÉRIEUR DES ETATS-UNIS POUR LE  
MOIS DE JUILLET 1896, COMPARÉ À CELUI  
DU MOIS DE JUILLET 1895.

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La valeur totale des importations des États-Unis pendant le mois de Juillet 1896, telle qu'elle est démontrée dans le Rapport du Bureau des Statistiques du Département de la Trésorerie, s'est élevée à \$52,108,552, dont 43.52 pour cent ont été admises en franchise de droits, et à \$73,025,646, pour la même période de l'année précédente, dont 44.94 pour cent ont été admises en franchise de droits.

D'après les chiffres ci-dessus, on constate qu'il y a eu une baisse de \$20,817,094 dans les importations pour le mois de Juillet de l'année courante.

Un examen attentif des détails du Rapport établit le fait que cette grande diminution est répartie également entre les principaux articles d'importation.

L'importation des animaux vivants, tant ceux qui sont soumis aux droits d'entrée que ceux qui sont admis en franchise, a été de \$82.680 pour le mois de Juillet dernier, et de \$176,116 pour le même mois en 1895; soit une perte de \$93,436, qui se trouve principalement dans l'importation des bestiaux provenant des possessions Anglaises de l'Amérique du Nord, et qui paient des droits.

L'importation des céréales montre un excédant de \$78,000 sur celle de Juillet 1895, qui est dû aux expéditions de blé.

La diminution dans les recettes de bois de Campêche est, en chiffres ronds, de \$118,000, toutes provenant des Antilles et de Cube. Celles du Centre-Amérique et du Mexique ont été pratiquement les mêmes pendant les deux mois que nous examinons.

L'importation du cacao accuse une baisse de \$100,000. Les recettes des États Centre-Américains ont été nulles, contre \$1,439, en Juillet 1895. Le Brésil a subi une perte de \$27,000 et une de \$67,000 pour les autres Républiques de l'Amérique du Sud. Les recettes totales ont été de \$225,236 en Juillet 1896, et de \$325,201, pour le même mois en 1895.

L'importation du café s'est élevée à 41,187,935 livres, évaluées à \$5,626,291, contre 50,425,506 livres évaluées à \$7,027,155 pour Juillet de l'année précédente; une perte de près de \$1,500,000 qui se trouve entièrement dans les envois du Brésil.

Sous le titre général de Coton et ses Manufactures, il n'y a aucun changement notable dans les importations pendant la période que nous passons en revue.

L'importation des oranges du Mexique aux États-Unis, pour Juillet dernier, s'est élevée à \$3,937, montrant une grande amélioration comparée à celle du même mois de l'année précédente, qui n'a été que de \$12. Les recettes de l'Italie montrent une baisse étonnante; les chiffres donnent \$1,067 pour Juillet dernier, et \$0,554 pour la même période, en 1895. Les autres fruits ne présentent aucun changement qui appelle l'attention.

Sous le titre de cuirs et peaux, les chiffres suivants sont: pour Juillet 1895, \$4,269; et pour le même mois de cette année-ci, \$1,295,946, soit une différence de \$2,973,310 en faveur de l'année précédente. Les envois de l'Amérique du Sud ont accusé \$700,000 de cette perte, et le Mexique \$40,000. La balance est répartie entre diverses contrées d'Europe.

L'importation du caoutchouc brut des pays Hispano-Américains, ne montre aucun changement appréciable pendant les périodes que nous considérons, celle du Brésil a produit \$331,235, et \$327,510 pour la même date, en 1895. Celles venant des autres pays Latins-Américains, se sont élevées, en moyenne, à \$78,000 contre \$89,359, en Juillet de cette dernière année.

Il y a une grande baisse dans les soies écruës et manufacturées. Les premières ont produit \$616,000, et les secondes \$840,000.

Dans les sucres, mélasses et confiseries, la différence est peu sensible.

La baisse dans les tabacs en feuilles se chiffre par \$1,200,000, dont il faut défalquer \$600,000 de perte due à la condition actuelle des affaires dans l'Île de Cuba. Les importations des Pays-Bas, ont subi une diminution d'une somme égale ; tandis que celles du Mexique montrent un gain de \$3,000.

La liste des laines, Classe No. 1, (Vêtements) indique une baisse de \$2,120,000. De cette somme, l'Amérique du Sud est portée pour \$53,000 de déficit, et la balance est répartie entre le Royaume-Unis et la France.

Dans la Classe No. 2, (tapis) il y a eu un gain de \$59,000 provenant des importations de l'Amérique du Sud.

L'exportation totale des produits des États-Unis, pendant le mois de Juillet de l'année courante, a été de \$65,687,27, comparée à \$55,156,878 pour la même période 1895 ; soit une augmentation de \$10,530,399.

A part le Mexique, qui montre une amélioration par une hausse de \$6,400 dans ses achats, l'exportation d'instruments aratoires aux pays Hispano-Américains, se fait remarquer par une baisse générale ; la République Argentine seule, représente une perte de \$195,433 pendant le mois ci-dessus, et de \$10,000 pour les autres pays Sud-Américains.

Parmi l'exportation d'animaux vivants, celle des porcs envoyés au Mexique, accuse un gain satisfaisant—les chiffres pour les deux mois de Juillet 1896 et 1895 sont : pendant le premier, \$15,115 ; et \$400, pendant le second. Il n'y a aucun changement à noter dans celle des autres bestiaux.

Sous le titre général de céréales, le Rapport démontre que, durant le mois de Juillet de l'année courante, il en a été exporté pour \$13,000,907 ; et en Juillet 1895, pour \$8,750,165 ; soit une augmentation de \$4,250,742. Le Mexique a acheté aux États-Unis, pour \$142,213 de maïs, contre \$9,137 pendant la même période en 1885 ; un gain de \$133,000.



Le total de l'exportation du coton s'est élevé à 99,000 balles évaluées à \$3,601,602, contre 58,270 balles estimées à \$1,918,979, en Juillet de l'année précédente.

On constate une amélioration satisfaisante dans l'exportation des machines américaines : En Juillet 1896, elle a atteint le chiffre de \$2,176,162, et en Juillet 1895, \$1,175,778, démontrant une augmentation de plus de \$1,000,000 en faveur de la première de ces deux années. Les exportations d'huiles se sont aussi améliorées dans toutes les différentes qualités. Il y a eu une augmentation de \$271,694 dans les huiles minérales raffinées, répartie entre les différentes Républiques du Sud-Amérique.

L'exportation totale des provisions comprenant les viandes et les produits des laiteries, se monte à \$11,506,307 pour Juillet 1896, contre \$11,204,310, pendant le même mois de l'année dernière; accusant une hausse de \$798,003. De cette somme il faut défalquer une perte de \$300,000, qui est uniquement due aux expéditions de fromages principalement destinés à l'Angleterre et aux Provinces Britanniques de l'Amérique du Nord. L'exportation du lard est tombée de \$2,807 en 1895, à \$1,754,029, en Juillet de l'année courante. Les envois de viande fraîche (bœuf) montrent un gain de \$822,000, rien que dans le trafic avec le Royaume-Uni.

Il a eu une baisse approximative de \$400,000 dans les tabacs fabriqués; tandis que durant les deux mois que nous passons en revue, il n'y a aucun changement sensible à remarquer dans les manufactures de tabac.

Sauf pour l'île de Cuba et Saint Domingue, le commerce des bois de construction avec le Sud-Amérique, s'est amélioré d'une manière satisfaisante. Le total de l'exportation des bois et leurs différentes manufactures provenant des Etats-Unis, a été de \$3,364,488 contre \$2,778,121 Juillet 1895.

L'amélioration remarquable qui s'est produite dans les exportations des États-Unis pendant le mois de Juillet de l'année courante, constatée dans l'article précédent, s'est continuée durant le mois d'Août, ainsi que le démontre le Rapport du Bureau des Statistiques récemment publié.

Pour le mois ci-dessus, les exportations des quatre principaux articles, montrent un total de \$35,863,003, contre \$27,185,853, pendant la même période de l'année précédente.

Le total pour les huit mois finissant le 31 Août de cette année-ci, est de \$437,761,220, contre \$410,158,917, pour la même période de 1895.

EXTRACTS FROM ANNUAL REPORTS.

BUREAU OF THE AMERICAN REPUBLICS,  
No. 2 Jackson Place,  
Washington, D. C.

Many communications are received at this Bureau indicating a misconception of the plan and scope of its work, as well as of the policy adopted in the distribution of its publications. As a full reply to those who believe themselves entitled to copies of every publication issued by the Bureau, the following extracts from recent Annual Reports are given :

FROM ANNUAL REPORT, 1893.

There is, however, a more important reason for desiring the success of this effort to place the publications of this Bureau in the hands of those willing to pay for them. The letters received every day speak strongly of an increasing desire to receive something free at the general expense. Probably few of those who thus place themselves in the category of applicants for charity realize the true situation. But they must understand the impossibility of supplying government publications at the general expense to all who apply. Perhaps, if questioned, they would declare themselves opposed to all forms of class legislation. Yet in their demands for public documents they are helping to extend the most expensive sort of such legislation. Those who believe in a republican form of government have too great faith in the institutions of their country to oppose an effort looking to the defeat of tendencies toward the worst forms of centralization. All such will learn with pleasure of efforts to extend information upon proper lines. The Bureau has received many cordial expressions of approval of the new method of distributing its publications from those who have been for a long time recipients of copies of every edition printed.

FROM ANNUAL REPORT, 1894.

At the date of my last report there had been but a short trial of the experiment of selling the publications of the Bureau. As knowledge of this policy became more widely extended the sales constantly increased, and the Bureau is in receipt of abundant evidence that those having

need of its information are willing to pay the slight cost charged. There still remains in the minds of many applicants a misconception of the plan and scope of the work of the International Union of American Republics. In some cases application is made to members of Congress for full sets of the Bureau publications by constituents who assume that these are public documents, properly bound for library purposes and fitted to adorn shelves that might otherwise be empty. In others, librarians of public and institutional libraries, with a laudable desire to secure for the libraries in their charge as full a line of documents as are available, assume that because they have been made depositories of government publications, they are entitled to copies of all documents issued by this Bureau for a distinct commercial purpose.

As to the first class, it is noted with pleasure that in a very large majority of cases the applicants, when furnished with a circular stating the policy of selling the Bureau publications, have responded by remitting the price named. Although it has been an unpleasant duty to refuse applications for these documents, I believe the best interests of every legislator are consulted by a strict adherence to the plan adopted. It is quite clear that every member who sends to a constituent free copies of the Bureau Handbooks increases the demand for the same favor from other constituents, who assume that they have an equal right with those they know to have been favored. As to the second class, there has been more difficulty. Recognizing the purely commercial character of the Bureau, and the soundness of the principle that no privileges should be granted to a favored class, the list of libraries to which the Bureau sends its publications has been carefully revised. The aim has been to utilize these libraries for the double purpose of placing information within reach of the public and for the better extension of a knowledge of the work of the Bureau. Mistakes may have been made, but in considering them it must be remembered that the decision is in all cases made without regard to any supposed right of the applicant to receive, and solely on the ground of what might be the effect on the prosperity of the Bureau.

Uruguay has the gold standard without a gold currency. One million dollars in silver of various denominations were coined two years ago,

and \$1,000,000 more are now being issued. This currency is accepted as legal tender.

Paraguay has no gold or silver coins of its own stamping. The silver peso of other South American republics circulates there, and has the same value as in the countries that issue them.
