IAW REF A, THIS BULLETIN DIRECTS THE REALIGNMENT OF THE ACTIVE COMPONENT CIVIL AFFAIRS (CA) CAPABILITY FROM THE 10TH AND 11TH MARINE REGIMENT HEADQUARTERS BATTERIES TO MARINE EXPEDITIONARY FORCE (MEF), COMMAND ELEMENT (CE) TABLES OF ORGANIZATION (T/O). THIS ACTION IS EFFECTIVE FISCAL YEAR (FY) 13, AND SUPERSEDES GUIDANCE PROVIDED IN ALMAR 061-05. 2. BACKGROUND. IN THE LAST TEN YEARS, CA FORCES HAVE BEEN DEDICATED PRIMARILY TO SUPPORT CIVIL MILITARY OPERATIONS (CMO) WITHIN MAJOR COMBAT OPERATIONS ENVIRONMENTS. HOWEVER, THERE IS AN INCREASING DEMAND FOR CA FORCES TO SUPPORT THEATER SECURITY COOPERATION AND STABILITY OPERATIONS IN DIVERSE REGIONS ACROSS THE GLOBE. AT THE SAME TIME, THE NUMBER OF STEADY STATE OPERATIONS HAVE INCREASED AND THE MARINES CORPS HAS EXPERIENCED SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGES ENSURING MARINES WITH THESE SKILL SETS ARE STAFFED AND TRAINED TO MEET THIS DEMAND. AS RECOMMENDED BY THE COMMAND ELEMENT ADVISORY BOARD (CEAB) AND APPROVED BY REF A, THE ASSIGNMENT AND MANAGEMENT OF THIS CAPABILITY IS BETTER SUITED FOR THE MEF. 3. GENERAL. THE DEPUTY COMMANDANT (DC), COMBAT DEVELOPMENT AND INTEGRATION (CDI), WITH THE MARINE FORCE COMMANDERS AND OTHER HEADQUARTERS MARINE CORPS (HQMC) AGENCIES, VALIDATED THE ACTION DIRECTED IN REF (A). THE COMBAT DEVELOPMENT PILLARS (DOCTRINE, ORGANIZATION, TRAINING, MATERIEL, LEADERSHIP & EDUCATION, PERSONNEL, FACILITIES, AND COST - DOTMLPF/C) WERE USED TO FORMULATE A STRATEGY AND SOLUTION FOR THE SUBJECT ACTION. DC CDI WILL TRACK THE TRANSITION OF THIS INITIATIVE UNTIL COMPLETION. THE IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY ASSOCIATED WITH THIS TASK ARE AS FOLLOWS:

A. DOCTRINE. THERE ARE NO DOCTRINAL GAPS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS INITIATIVE. HOWEVER, THE MARINE CORPS WARFIGHTING PUBLICATION (MCWP) 3-33.1, MARINE AIR-GROUND TASK FORCE CIVIL-MILITARY OPERATIONS, DATED SEPT 2011 WILL REQUIRE UPDATING. MCCDC, SWCIWID IS DIRECTED TO BEGIN THE REVISION PROCESS FOR MCWP 3-33.1.

(1) 10TH AND 11TH MARINE REGIMENTS: MCT 1.15 CONDUCT CIVIL-MILITARY OPERATIONS (CMO) WILL BE DROPPED FROM CORE MISSION ESSENTIAL TASK (MET) TO CORE PLUS MET. THE MARINE DIVISION STANDARDS FOR MCT 1.6.6.9 CONDUCT STABILITY OPERATIONS WILL BE MODIFIED TO REMOVE THE LINKAGE TO ARTILLERY REGT CMO.

(2) CE I MEF AND CE II MEF: MCT 1.15 CONDUCT CMO WILL BE ADDED AS A CORE MET. THE MEF STANDARDS FOR MCT 1.6.6.9 CONDUCT STABILITY OPERATIONS WILL BE MODIFIED TO ADD A LINKAGE TO MEF CE CMO.

(3) ENSURE MEF, CE CMO MET AS DEFINED IN THE UNIVERSAL JOINT TASK LIST (UJTL) IS CAPTURED AT THE MEF LEVEL, AS REQUIRED.

B. ORGANIZATION. THE REALIGNMENT OF THIS CAPABILITY AND THE ASSOCIATED FORCE STRUCTURE FROM 10TH AND 11TH MARINE REGIMENT HEADQUARTERS TO MEF CE, G-3 WILL BE SIMILAR TO THE MODEL CURRENTLY EMPLOYED BY III MEF CE. THERE IS NO STRUCTURAL GROWTH ASSOCIATED WITH THIS INITIATIVE (ZERO SUM).

C. TRAINING. THERE ARE NO NEW TRAINING REQUIREMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH ACTION. THIS ACTION MAY REQUIRE A MISSION ESSENTIAL TASK LISTS (METL) CONFERENCE TO BE HELD TO ENSURE ALL TASKS ASSOCIATED WITH CA DETACHMENTS ARE REALIGNED TO THE MEF CE.

E. LEADERSHIP AND EDUCATION. N/A, UNIT COMMAND SLATING NOT EFFECTED BY THIS ACTION.

ENSURE THAT MOVE/ADD/CHANGE (MAC) COSTS FOR NMCI SEATS ARE CONSIDERED IN OPERATIONAL AND MAINTENANCE COSTS FOR MOVING INTO NEW FACILITIES. IN SUPPORT OF TIMELINE PROVIDE FACILITY AND MILCON STATUS UPDATES TO DC CDI (TFSD) VIA MSG IF PLANNED FACILITIES CHANGE FOR THIS ACTION.

(16) COSTS

(A) CONTACT LOCAL BASE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT OFFICE IF COMMERCIAL TRANSPORTATION ARRANGEMENTS ARE REQUIRED. LOW OR NO COST TRANSPORTATION WILL BE USED TO THE GREATEST EXTENT POSSIBLE. PACKING, PRESERVING, STORING, AND STAGING COSTS WILL BE BORNE BY THE RESPECTIVE MARFOR COMMANDER.

(B) ENSURE ALL FY 13 FUNDS WHICH HAVE PLANNED AND/OR BUDGETED FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CIVIL AFFAIR DETS AT 10TH AND 11TH MARINE REGIMENT'S IS TRANSFERRED/REALIGNED TO THEIR RESPECTIVE MEF, CE.

(17) ENVIRONMENTAL. INITIATE ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE PLANNING AND COORDINATE WITH MCIPAC, MCIEAST, AND THE INSTALLATION COMMANDERS TO DETERMINE THE EXTENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS IAW REF (AA).

(18) PROVIDE IMPLEMENTATION PLANS IN POAM FORMAT FOR THE ACTIONS SPECIFIED IN THIS BULLETIN TO DC CDI (TFSD) WITH AN INFO COPY TO DC MRA, DC IL, DC PR, AND DC PPO. SUBMIT PLANS VIA GENSER MESSAGE WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THIS MESSAGE. REPORT THE COMPLETION OF THE ACTIONS SPECIFIED AND PROVIDE STATUS OF THE IMPLEMENTATION PROGRESS AT 30 AND 15 DAY INTERVALS PRIOR TO THIS ACTION. SUBMIT ALL REPORTS BY GENSER MESSAGES TO DC CDI (TFSD), WITH AN INFO COPY TO DC MRA, DC IL, DC PR, AND DC PPO.

B. DC PPO. ENSURE THE MARINE CORPS TASKS ARE UPDATED IN DRRS-MC.

C. DC IL

(1) DISTRIBUTION. DC IL WILL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN FULL SITUATIONAL AWARENESS DURING EXECUTION, STATUS OF SHIPMENTS, AND PROVIDE RECURRING UPDATES TO DC CDI (TFSD) VIA GENMSG OF PROGRESS STATUS, ANY DEVIATIONS, AND WHEN REDISTRIBUTION/STORAGE IS COMPLETED. MCLC, SERVING AS THE DISTRIBUTION PROCESS OWNER (DPO) FOR THE MARINE CORPS, WILL PROVIDE DISTRIBUTION OF EQUIPMENT FROM IDENTIFIED SOURCES AND ACQUISITIONS IN SUPPORT OF THE CMC SOURCING PRIORITIES TO INCLUDE REPORTING AS REQUIRED BY DC IL.

(2) FACILITIES. PROVIDE OVERSIGHT TO THE FACILITIES PLANNING IAW REFS (K) AND (L).

D. DC MRA. IN SUPPORT OF THE TRANSITION TIMELINE, MONITOR ROSTERS PROVIDED BY MARFORCOM AND MARFORPAC TO ENSURE PERSONNEL ASSIGNMENTS ARE EXECUTED. PROVIDE UPDATES TO DC CDI (TFSD) VIA MSG IF STAFFING PLANS CHANGE FOR THIS ACTION.

E. DC PR. NO ACTION REQUIRED IN ASSOCIATION WITH ACTION.

F. CG TECOM. PROVIDE UPDATES TO MARFORCOM AND

MARFORPAC AND DC CDI (TFSD) VIA MSG OF ANY TRAINING CHANGES THAT WOULD AFFECT THE TIMELINE OF THIS ACTION.

G. CG MCSC. NOT ACTION REQUIRED FOR THIS IMITATIVE.

H. OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS. KEEP CONGRESS ADVISED OF ALL CHANGES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS ACTION, AS APPROPRIATE.
