MEMO FOR RECORD;

SUBJECT: Establishment of Thai Mission in Japan

1. Basic is a copy of a radio dated 5 Jul 50 from the American Embassy in Bangkok to USPOLAD indicating desire of the Government of Thailand to obtain accreditation from the Supreme Commander of a diplomatic representative with the rank of Minister. By C/N 1, DS to CofS thru G-1, G-2 and G-4, in turn, subject as above, 8 Jul 50, DS considered that the establishment of a Thai diplomatic mission accredited to the Supreme Commander is in the interests of the occupation. The DS recommends approval of the proposed radio which advises the American Embassy at Bangkok that SCAP welcomes the establishment of a Thai mission in Japan.

2. No logistic support has been asked and the proposed draft radio advises that SCAP can provide no logistic support beyond the privileges generally accredited diplomatic personnel. G-1 and G-2 have concurred.

3. Since no logistic support is involved, recommended G-4 action is to indicate concurrence to proposed radio by initialing C/N 1 after G-4.

1. 1. Inclosed is a copy of a telegram dated 5 July 1950 from the American Embassy in Bangkok to US POLAD concerning the desire of the Government of Thailand to obtain accreditation to the Supreme Commander of a diplomatic representative with the rank of Minister. The proposed Minister is Naisan Ganilkan Haeng, Charge d'Affaires of the Thai Embassy in China.

2. The interests of Thailand in Japan are represented at the present time by Mr. Suphot Inganinanda whose status is that of Trade Representative of the Thailand Ministry of Commerce; he does not have diplomatic status.

3. The establishment of a Thai Mission in Japan would carry with it no occasion for request for logistic support inasmuch as the former Thai Embassy (former U.S. House No. 210) was released to the Government of Thailand on 15 April 1950, preparatory to the establishment of a mission.

4. DS considers that the establishment of a Thai diplomatic mission accredited to the Supreme Commander is in the interests of the occupation.

5. Recommend approval of inclosed draft radio (TAB A) and return to DS for dispatch.

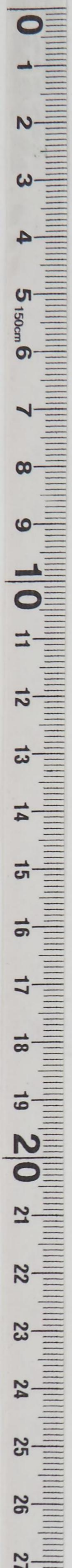

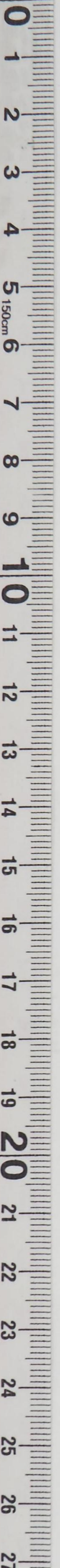
