This document discusses the relationship of the I.R.A.A. to the Imperial Constitution, contains Premier KONOYE's explanations regarding the purposes and aims of the organization; (centering around unification and manifestation of total energy of the people to bring about complete development of the country); reveals plans for reorganization, developments of Central Cooperative Conference and results achieved, and like topics correlated with I.R.A.A. and revealing its character.
