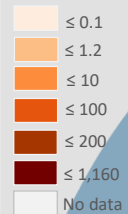
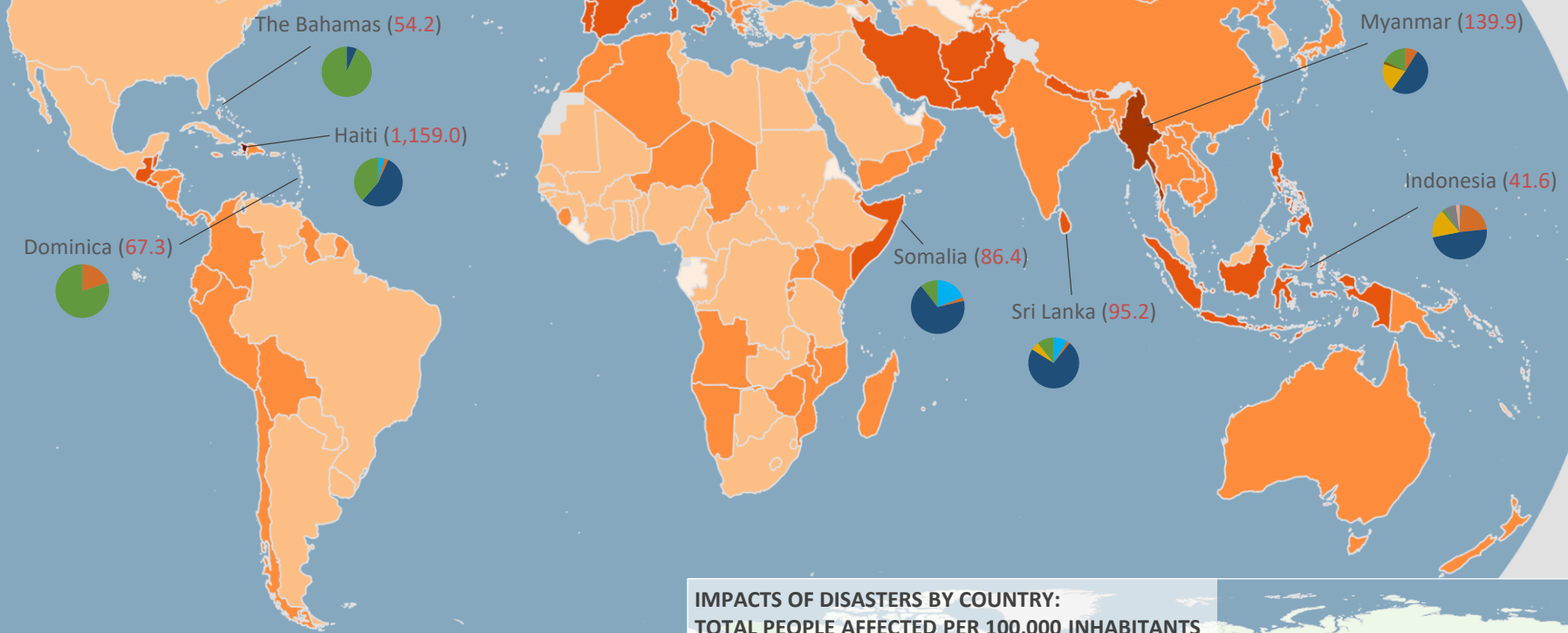
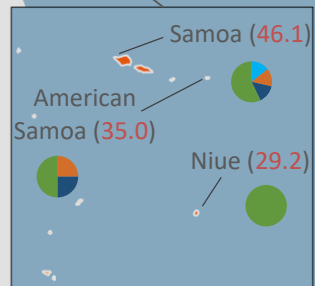
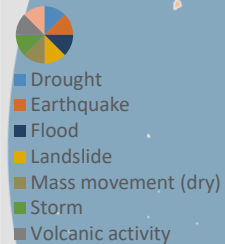


**IMPACTS OF DISASTERS BY COUNTRY:  
TOTAL DEATHS PER MILLION INHABITANTS**

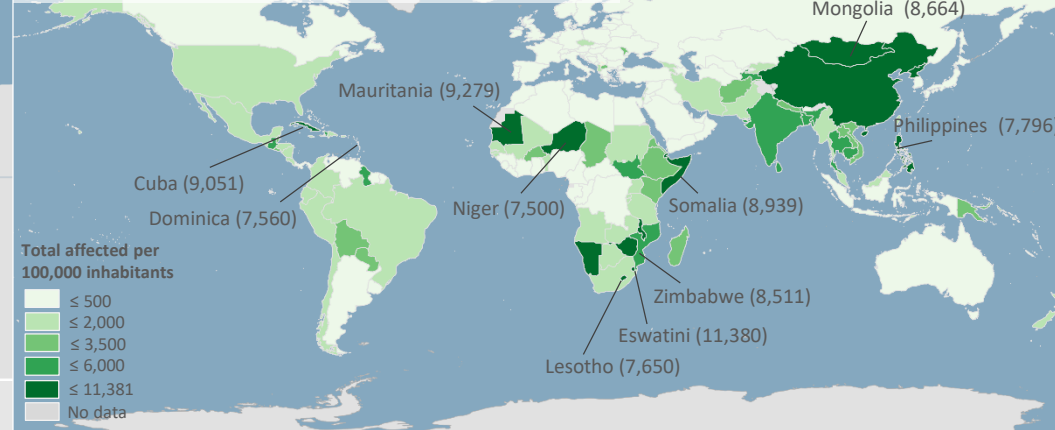
Deaths per million inhabitants
