



Fall 2011: 51universities




Key metrics: courses



Fall 2011: 98 courses






Key metrics: Campus Ambassadors






Key metrics: Online Ambassadors






Key metrics: Students per course






Key metrics: Ambassadors per course






Key metrics: Online Ambassadors per course
