Details: Austin, Texas has long attracted political extremists due to its position as the Capitol of Texas and because of the University of Texas at Austin (UT). The Austin branch of the International Socialist Organization (ISO) is a registered student organization at UT. On the Student Organization website, their stated purpose says that they believe "ordinary people should democratically control society, and run it on the basis of meeting human needs rather than for the profits of a few." The main website (www.internationalsocialist.org) states the goal of the ISO is the overthrow of the United States' current form of government.

The Austin branch of the ISO believes they are "involved in today's struggles for justice-from the fight against the racist injustice system, to the movement against corporate

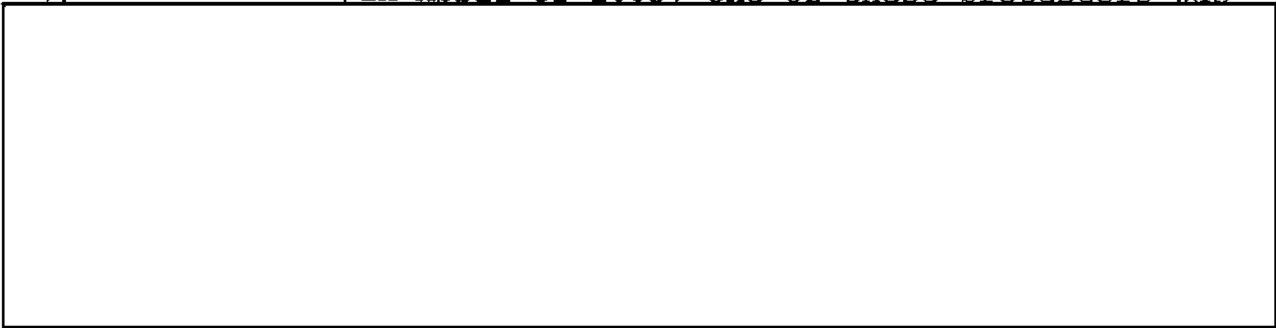

domination, to the struggle for workers rights at home and abroad, to opposition to US militarism." They want a participatory membership, with members active and engaged in activities of the group. These activities include regular meetings, educational talks and public lectures/discussions, tables, rallies, and public demonstrations.

The public demonstrations by the Austin ISO have recently become more aggressive, and group members have been mixing with other extremist groups. Several members of the ISO were arrested for disrupting a speech by using air horns and shouting down the speaker. This was done during the speech given by [redacted] in April of 2005; one of these protestors was

At another public event, members of the ISO used profanity, vulgar gestures, and attempted to shout down [redacted] during a speech at the University of Texas at Austin, in May of 2005. One member, [redacted] was arrested.

The ISO also participated in a protest of a Haliburton meeting in Houston, Texas in May of 2005, along with Anti-Racist Action (ARA). Several police officers were assaulted, bottles were thrown, and 15 protestors were arrested. At a Ku Klux Klan rally in Tomball, Texas, in June of 2005, ISO members showed up dressed in black clothing, wearing knit hats with handkerchiefs covering their faces. They arrived with 30-50 University of Texas students and tried to incite the crowd into rushing the building and disrupting the meeting.

On 05/01-05/05/2006, Austin will be hosting the World Congress on Information Technology (WCIT 2006). This global event occurs at a different location every two years, and attracts world leaders in business, government and academia. Keynote speakers in the past included Margaret Thatcher, Former Prime Minister of the UK; John Howard, Prime Minister of Australia; Bill Clinton, Former President of the United States of America; Bill Gates, President of Microsoft; and Michael Dell, Chairman of the Board, Dell Inc.

Confirmed speakers for the 2006 Congress include Colin Powell, Former Secretary of State; John Thompson, Chairman and CEO of Symantec; Anne Mulcahy, Chairman and CEO of Xerox; Paul Otellini, CEO of Intel; David Kirkpatrick, Senior Editor of Fortune Magazine; and Dr. Theogene Rudasingwa, Former Ambassador to the US, Republic of Rwanda.

Anticipated guests include President of the United States George W. Bush; President of Mexico Vicente Fox; Prime Minister of Canada Paul Martin; Prime Minister of the United Kingdom Tony Blair, and delegates from Mexico, Venezuela, Argentina, and China.

The UT branch of the ISO may be serving as an umbrella organization for other extremist groups and using the status as a recognized student organization to draw members. At the least, they are meeting with members of other extremist groups. [redacted] who associates with the ISO and may be a member, is also affiliated with Dirty South Earth First (DSEF), with ties to Earth First, Earth Liberation Front (ELF), and Stop Huntington Animal Cruelty (SHAC), all who advocate the use of violence to influence or coerce a civilian population. These groups also have connections with Black Bloc, an anarchist group that espouses extremely violent tactics to bring about change. Members of ISO advocate the overthrow of the US government. Recent protests by the ISO have resulted in police officers being assaulted, beer bottles being thrown, and ISO members attempting to incite riots.

The Attorney General's Guidelines for opening a Terrorism Enterprise Investigation require the following: "Facts/Circumstances indicate that two or more persons are engaged in an enterprise for the purpose of a) furthering political or social goals through activities that involve force or violence and a violation of federal law." The ISO has demonstrated that they believe in the use of force to silence other people's exercise of their First Amendment Rights.

Based on the background and facts listed above, the International Socialist Organization has the potential for criminal activity, especially in light of the World Congress of Information Technology occurring in Austin in May of 2006. The Austin RA AUSA was informed of the facts of the case, and has concurred with the proposed investigation. The new 100 PI, authorized by SAC San Antonio, [redacted]

Albright criticizes war in Iraq but says U.S. must complete its mission

Former U.S. Secretary of State Madeleine Albright hewed closely Thursday to her former boss's position on the war in Iraq.

President Clinton, whom Albright served in his first term as representative to the United Nations and in his second term as the first female secretary of state, has called the war a mistake but says the United States must nevertheless conclude its mission successfully.

Albright, in a 70-minute chat before an audience of more than 1,500 at St. Edward's University in South Austin, called Iraq "a war of choice" and said there was now no choice but to win.

Her remarks came in response to questions by former Mexican Secretary of State Rosario Green, who is director of the Kozmetsky Center of Excellence in Global Finance at St. Edward's.

Albright and Green, who joked as often as they were serious about foreign affairs, were frequently interrupted by laughter and applause.

They became friends at the United Nations, where Green was an assistant secretary general to former Secretary General Boutros Boutros-Ghali.

Albright criticized the Bush administration for "a deliberate way of not learning the lessons" of Clinton's efforts to make peace between the Israelis and the Palestinians. She said Clinton had so impressed the Arabs that he "could be

elect president of any country" in the Middle East.

She apologized for something that occasionally draws protesters to her public appearances, though none were seen Thursday: an old remark that a U.N. trade embargo against Iraq "was worth it" despite the alleged deaths of thousands of Iraqi children from a lack of food or medicine.

"It was a really stupid thing to say," Albright said.

But, she said, the embargo to punish then-Iraqi President Saddam Hussein for refusing to comply with U.N. resolutions never prevented trade for food or medicine. Any lack of those items for Iraqis was caused by Saddam diverting them to his cronies, she said.

Group protests Army presence at career fair

About 40 student activists stormed the College of Liberal Arts' job fair Wednesday to protest U.S. Army recruiters' role in the event. Cries of, "When recruiters lie, students die," and "Money for school, not for war," filled the Texas Union Ballroom, where about 70 employers had booths.

Members of the Campus Anti-War Movement to End the Occupation gathered on the West Mall at 10:30 a.m. to make posters and pass out pamphlets. They marched into the Texas Union and upstairs into the ballroom, surrounding the Army recruiter table.

CAMEO members shouted and

chanted as they waved signs that criticized the American war effort in Iraq.

"We're here to protest anything that facilitates recruiters on campus," said Mike Corwin, CAMEO co-founder and a LAN administrator at the Center for American History. "We're here to teach people that death isn't a career and to put an end to their discrimination against homosexuals."

The University provided CAMEO with a place to stand next to the Army recruiting station.

"We want to accommodate their right to free speech," said Margarita Arellano, associate dean of students. "The University tries to teach students that they can express their First Amendment rights."

Though the protestors blocked the Army booth and shouted at people who sought employment information from him, the recruiter from the Army's Dobie Mall office said that the group did have a right to be there.

Other recruiters said they were frustrated with CAMEO's actions.

"I think they're a pain in the butt," said Hunter Short, a recruiter for construction equipment company Neff Rental, whose booth was next to the Army's. "Our companies spend a lot of money to come here, and it's juvenile and disrespectful to distract us like this."

Short also said he wasn't happy with the protestors criticizing the military.

"Our freedoms wouldn't be here

if they didn't protect us," Short said.

CAMEO members screamed over recruiters' conversations and debated with students and employers. The group's size in the confined space prevented some people from getting to the tables. The group later turned its attention to other government organizations at the event, such as the National Security Agency and the Defense Intelligence Agency. CAMEO has protested against the Army recruitment offices in Dobie Mall in the past.

Most of the protesters were gone by 12:30 p.m. Five University Police Department officers were on hand to observe the demonstration. The event remained peaceful.

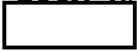
The following investigation was conducted by Task Force Officer [redacted] at Austin, Texas on October 17, 2005. Several groups are becoming more active in areas that may involve domestic terrorism and are beginning to appear in news stories and in newswires/blogs. These groups include the International Socialist Organization (ISO), the World Can't Wait (WCW), and Campus Anti-War Movement to End Occupation (CAMEO):


A CNN story indicated that 20 members of ISO and a group called One People's Project (not known to exist in Austin) attended a neo-Nazi march in Toledo, Ohio and incited African-American residents to commit violent acts.

An Austin Indy Media story by "Underminethemilitary" (NFI) states that CAMEO is calling for military recruiters scheduled for a job fair to be driven off the University of Texas campus. This is called the "cutting edge of anti-war protest" and advocates that groups "kick military recruiters off campus". The website utcameo.blogspot.com is mentioned as well as the Internet service provider riseup.net, mentioned in earlier communications.

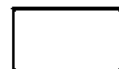
A Daily Texan article (the University of Texas student newspaper) advises that WCW states that the Bush Administration, which they refer to as the "Bush regime" will last only until their protest marches in 40 cities. On the University of Texas campus, a WCW slogan, "Resist or Die" has been spray-painted on buildings and sidewalks. Members have stated that they will not be "sitting at tables", but will instead be "making noise and getting attention" during the scheduled events.

Other activist calenders and sources show that the Texas Socialist Conference will take place November 5, 2005 at the University of Texas at Austin. The sponsor is ISO and more information is stated to be available from "Austin ISO". The announcement is very anti-Bush and anti-U.S. policy in its wording and calls for "a fight for a better society" through the "Socialist Alternative".

The target of the surveillance was the International Socialist Organization (ISO), which was hosting the Texas Socialist Conference in Parlin Hall on the University of Texas campus. TFOs [redacted] stationed themselves on the north side of the Parlin Hall, while TFO [redacted] was on the west, and TFO [redacted] and Agent [redacted] were on the east. [redacted]

TFO [redacted] reported this to the Austin Police Department, and gave a description of the subject. I have learned some of the details of the operation of a communist cult based in Chicago and I think that the FBI should be informed.

The group is called the International Socialist Organization and they operate out of, if you can believe it, Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois and out of some buildings in Chicago itself.

Their stated aim is the violent revolutionary overthrow of the United States Government.

They were the organizers of the attack on [redacted] the contra leader, at Northwestern University.

They divert money from University coffers into the organization's accounts through false honoraria and misrepresented fund-raising activities.

Their main activity is recruiting and brainwashing impressionable college students and transforming them into obedient communist troublemakers. I have observed this frightening transformation in a friend of mine. I believe the group used sex, drugs and liquor, and brainwashing techniques on him. The cult seems to me to be very much like the moonies, only worse, because they seek to do damage to American society through violence.

They have recruited and brainwashed a very rich Northwestern student, [redacted] who could be a source of lots of cash in the future.

The cult is headed by a charismatic leader who totally dominates everyone in the cult. He is an [redacted] communist educated in England. He doesn't work, he is supported by cult money, drives a fancy car, and he has a green card because of his marriage to an American girl, a brainwashed member of the cult.

He advocates the violent revolutionary overthrow of the U.S. Government. He promises the members of the cult a triumphant future in a new era, with him as Great Leader and the others as his faithful lieutenants. They seem to buy it after the brainwashing.

This cult recruits lonely or uncertain students through kindness. They meet their potential recruits at meetings they sponsor on

campus at Northwestern and other schools around the country. They use drugs, have their women attend to potential recruits, and ply them with liquor and sex. They brainwash potential recruits through constant indoctrination and social pressure, finally making them go out on the street and sell the communist newspaper. They are amazingly successful at turning intelligent students into robots.

The cult turns recruits into fighters for communism who I believe would kill if given the order by [redacted] They turn promising college students into mindless soldiers of communism, who dream of the day when they can destroy our society.

I saw a friend of mine go through this transformation. He was a very bright young man of Irish and English extraction. He was lonely and uncertain of his future. He fell, somehow, into [redacted] clutches. I know he was seduced by one of their women. Once he was indoctrinated, she left him. My friend used to be cheerful and talkative, but he changed. He would rant about communism whenever you talked to him. He lost his friends. Eventually a member of his family caught on to what was happening and came to Chicago to take him away. He was on the right track until this cult got ahold of him. It was a terrible tragedy. I find it very difficult to believe that Northwestern allows this to happen to its students.

Another case I know of was that of a young woman who was living in Chicago. She was recruited by the ISO and she too lost her grip on reality. She killed herself [redacted]

I hope this cult can somehow be stopped. [redacted] is a menace, and he wields terrible power over his communist subordinates. It would be best to neutralize him before he gets bigger, like Sun Yung Moon or Lyndon LaRouche. If he gets this rich girl's money, he could develop the means to do even more damage to America and her people. I shudder to think about the possibilities.

The rich girl I am speaking of is named [redacted] She is, or was, a Northwestern student. Her parents live in [redacted] Their phone number is [redacted] She needs help. Think what might have happened if the SLA had gotten [redacted] money.

[redacted] The cult has an office somewhere near there. The office phone number is 312-752-1500. It is listed under Aardvark Typesetting Enterprises. This office is in a residential building. It is where they publish their communist newspaper. Perhaps that is illegal and you can have them evicted. If you can get them thrown out that might help.

I have seen a friend destroyed and I am very worried that this cult might continue to operate or even get worse.

However, they then began disrupting the speech by shouting and blowing air horns while [Redacted] was speaking. The group was given several warnings, and after failing to heed them, were arrested one at a time as they violated the UTPD's rules related to official school functions. In particular, [Redacted] was an instigator for the group [Redacted]

Approximately twenty protestors were present, and six were arrested for their actions. One of the six, [Redacted] was released. The others were arraigned and released the following day. Arrested were:
