INFORMATION FOR TRAVELERS

1. TICKET OFFICES at important Stations are open in time to permit the purchase of tickets before the departure of trains. Passengers should purchase tickets before boarding train. Fares on trains exceed fares charged at ticket offices.

2. UNLIMITED LOCAL TICKETS are good until used and will be accepted for passage in reverse direction.

3. COUPON TICKETS to practically all points in United States, Canada or Mexico are on sale at the Company's principal stations. Such tickets may be obtained at smaller stations upon three days advance notice.

4. CHILDREN under five years of age will be carried free when accompanied by parent or guardian; five years of age and under twelve, half fare, twelve years of age or over, full fare. The law requires the passenger to pay, and the railroad company to collect published tariff fares for children as well as for adults, and penalties are provided for failure to do so.

5. FARES IN DRAWING ROOMS AND COMPARTMENTS.

Minimum transportation charge:

in Drawing Room—For two (2) adults.

In Compartment—For one and one-half (1½) adults.

Pullman fares are additional

EXCEPTION—On limited trains—minimum four and one-half (4½) limited train tickets.

6. PULLMAN RESERVATIONS. Space in parlor and sleeping cars may be obtained on application at the City Ticket Offices listed on page 2 and at the principal station ticket offices.

Applications by mail or telegram for reservations from New York or Boston should be addressed to:

Advance reservations should be paid for 24 hours before departure of train.

7. STOP-OVERS. First-class unlimited one-way tickets or regular excursion tickets, not limited to continuous passage, permit stop-over upon notice to conductor at any point on the Company's lines except as noted below:

Stop-over will not be permitted when the regular fare from point of stop-over to next canceling point is less than 10 cents nor will a second stop-over be issued between the same two stations.

When tickets reading via New Haven are presented via Waterbury on through New York and Boston trains, no stop-over will be allowed after leaving Bridgeport Eastbound, or Hartford Westbound.

No stop-over will be allowed on rail portion of journey on excursion tickets to points on Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket islands.

First-class limited one-way or excursion tickets permit stop-over at Boston, New York, Springfield and Worcester, for 10 days or less by the deposit of ticket with Ticket Agent at such point immediately on arrival. Stop-over will not be allowed on excursion tickets to exceed the original going or final return limit.

8. LOST TICKETS. The railroad company is not responsible for lost tickets and passengers are advised to make a memorandum of their tickets showing issuing line, office where purchased, form and numbers and date.

In case of loss, pay fare to conductor or purchase another ticket and take receipt. Write to the General Passenger Agent of the road issuing the ticket, enclose receipt and explain the circumstances. If ticket is returned unused the Company will redeem it.

9. ADJUSTMENT OF FARES. In case of disagreement with conductor relative to tickets, passengers should pay conductor's claim, take receipt, and refer to the General Passenger Agent.

The conductor has no discretion in such matters, but is governed by rules.

10. REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Unused or partially used tickets will be redeemed at their legal value if presented in person or sent by mail by the original purchaser to the General Passenger Agent with a statement of reason for non-use or partial use.

Such tickets of this Company's issue may be deposited with local Ticket Agent, who will give receipt and forward them to the General Passenger Agent for redemption.

11. ARTICLES LEFT ON TRAINS. Receiving depots for articles found in passenger coaches are maintained at the following points:

In case of loss, inquire at the nearest receiving depot if practicable, or notify General Baggage Agent at New Haven, Conn., giving full description of property, date of trip, between what points and number of train.

When articles are left in Pullman cars notify Superintendent of Pullman Company, New York, N. Y., or Boston, Mass.

12. DOGS OR OTHER ANIMALS will be transported only in baggage cars under the Company's lawful tariff, particulars of which will be given by baggage-masters.

The inspection of baskets or other enclosures, carried by passengers in coaches, is not expected, even though such receptacles may contain small domestic pet animals. If offensive to passengers however, such animals will be sent to the baggage car.

Permits will not be issued for the transportation of animals in coaches.

13. ATTENDANTS AT NEW YORK AND BOSTON. Attendants, wearing gray uniform and red cap, meet trains on their arrival at Grand Central Terminal, New York, and South Station, Boston. They will assist passengers with their hand baggage; direct them to the elevated, subway, street car lines or cab stands and render such other assistance as may reasonably be required. These men, however, are not required to do porter's work or to handle heavy baggage.

14. MOTOR CARRIAGE SERVICE is maintained by the Westcott Express Company at Grand Central Terminal, New York, and the Armstrong Transfer Co. at South Station, Boston. Stands for this service are maintained in the terminals.

15. BAGGAGE REGULATIONS.

(a) **DECLARATION OF VALUE.** The shipper of baggage or other property, for interstate transportation, must when checking same, declare in writing the value thereof on form provided by the Company.

(b) **MARKING BAGGAGE AND RECORD OF CHECK.** For precaution, the owner's name and permanent address should be plainly marked on each piece of baggage checked, and the owner should make a note of the number of his check to aid in case of loss.

(c) **BAGGAGE TRANSFERS.** Where transfer of baggage is necessary enroute a transfer tag must be purchased at time of checking.

(d) **SPECIAL DELIVERY OF BAGGAGE** to hotel, residence or steamship pier in New York City, Brooklyn, Hoboken, Jersey City, Boston and other cities may be arranged at nominal cost, at the time baggage is checked.

(e) **BAGGAGE CHECKING FROM HOTEL OR RESIDENCE.** The following transfer companies will check baggage from hotel or residence to destination on presentation of necessary transportation tickets and transfer tags:

(f) **FORWARDING BAGGAGE.** Baggage should be delivered at the station in time to be forwarded, if practicable, on a train preceding that on which passenger intends to travel. Every effort will be made to forward baggage before or on same train with passenger; but this cannot be guaranteed, particularly in the case of Limited Trains, which have but small space for baggage. When baggage car space is exhausted, baggage will be forwarded by next available train.

(g) **BAGGAGE AGENTS ON TRAINS.** Uniformed agents of the Westcott Express Co. at New York City and of the Armstrong Transfer Co. at Boston, respectively, will pass through principal trains and arrange for the transfer of baggage to all parts of the city. Such agents are also located at the terminal stations.

Passengers are cautioned against dealing with outside expressmen.

(h) **BAGGAGE IN PASSENGER COACHES.** Passengers may carry a small quantity of hand baggage, which may be placed in the rack or under the seat. Baggage will not be allowed in or protruding into the aisle of the car, or to interfere with the seating of passengers.

(i) **BAGGAGE LIABILITY**—Baggage consists of a passenger's personal wearing apparel, and the liability of the New York, New Haven & Hartford Railroad Company is limited to \$100.00 (except a greater or less amount is provided in tariff) on full fare ticket, unless a greater value is declared by owner at time of checking and payment is made therefor. Charge for excess value is moderate.

16. PARCELS may be checked at principal stations at a nominal charge. Agents will issue a hand check to be surrendered when the parcel is taken out.

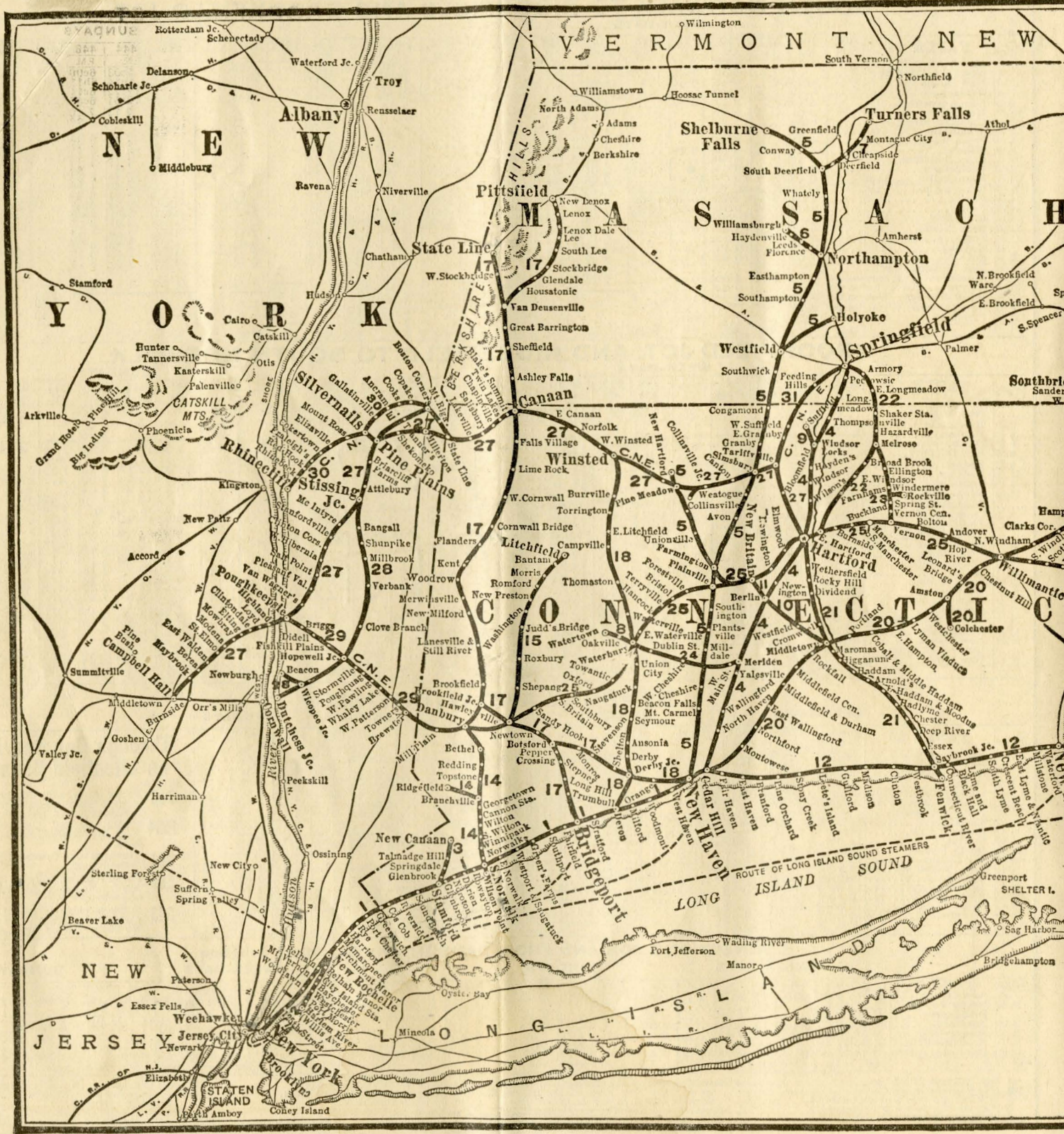

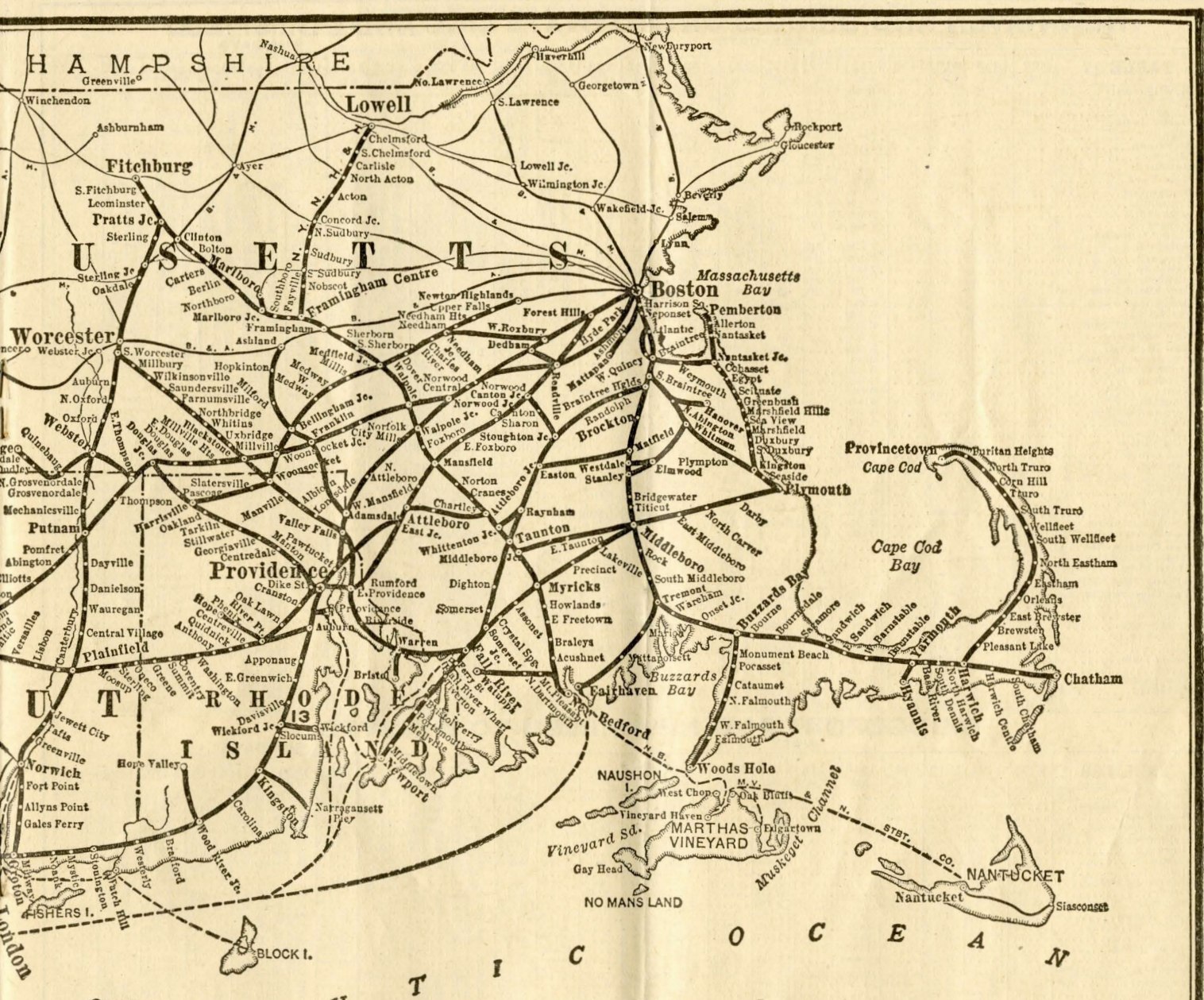

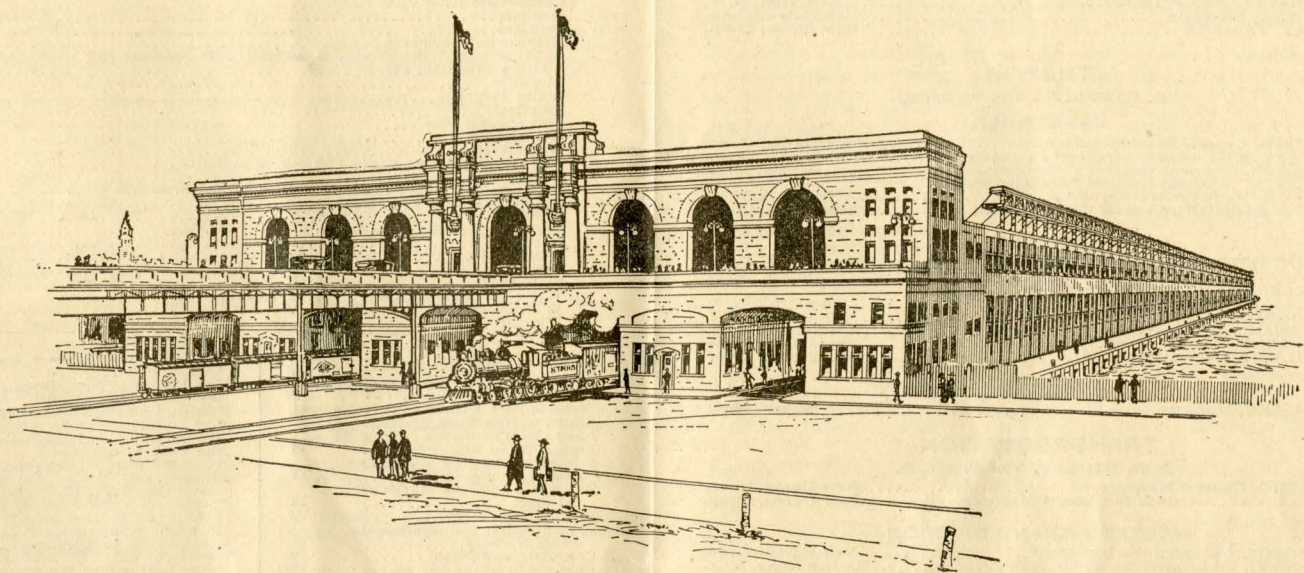

Commonwealth Pier was built by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts under the supervision of the Directors of the Port of Boston. It was opened in 1913 and is part of a great plan for the development of Boston's steamship terminals, including the building in South Boston of the biggest dry-dock in the world.

The net register tonnage of shipping entering the Port of Boston every year ranks it as the second largest port in America, and the fifth largest in the world, closely following New York, London, Hamburg and Rotterdam, and outranking such ports as Antwerp and Liverpool, even before the present European war.

The Port of Boston, with its 56 steamship lines to and from all parts of the globe, is one of the world's greatest gateways.
