MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Status of ECA Officials in Japan

1. Because of an increasing number of requests for logistic support for ECA officials coming into Japan, G-4 (Lt. Col. Godman and Lt. Col. Belardi) queried G-1 (Lt. Col. Benson and Major Rosseau) as to the number of ECA personnel authorized to be in Japan. As a result of this discussion, it was decided that G-1 would determine the ceiling figures for ECA personnel.
2. ECA had no ceiling set on the number of personnel for Japan and no Table of Organization. G-1 made a Staff Study on the status of ECA officials in Japan, and concluded that:
 - a. The entry of permanently assigned ECA personnel should be limited to twenty representing ECA in Korea, and eight representing ECA in China, and that TDY for a maximum period of ten days be authorized for other ECA officials in Japan upon request provided that accommodations are available in other than procured facilities.
 - b. That commissary, PX, APO privileges, motor pool facilities operated by the U. S. Army, and procured recreational facilities which are available and will not cause increased demand on the Japanese Government, viz: movies, swimming pools, golf courses and other athletic playing fields should be made available to ECA personnel.
3. Current DA Regulations require the DA to provide logistic support to the extent available from Army sources for ECA personnel. However, JCS and SCAP directives do not contemplate use of procured facilities by other than occupation force personnel.
4. As it is considered necessary to adopt a policy to govern the admission of ECA personnel into Japan on a temporary or a permanent basis, it is recommended that the conclusions of G-1, derived from their Staff Study, as indicated in sub-paragraphs 2a and b above, be concurred in and the G-4 concurrence be indicated by initials in the space provided on the Memorandum for the CS, subject, "Brief of Staff Study, 'Status of ECA Personnel in Japan'", 17 Jun 49. It is requested that Lt. Col. Belardi be given the Staff Study for further hand-processing.
5. Within established policy.
6. Completes action on G-4 Journal No. 85041.
