of Production of Essential Civilian Commodities.

1. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 3 of Directive No. 3 from the Supreme Commander Allied Powers, dated 22 September 1945, you are authorized to commence operation of your plant, and to manufacture the essential civilian commodities listed in annex 1 to this permit.

2. This permit grants authority only to operate. The acquisition of materials, parts, and sub-assemblies, as well as the disposition of finished products and establishment of sales prices, will be in accord with the regulations of the Imperial Japanese Government.

3. You will notify this Headquarters in writing of the exact date upon which you commence manufacturing operations. This notice will be mailed not later than date of commencement of operations.

4. Two months after the date of commencement of operations, and at the end of each month thereafter until notified to the contrary by this Headquarters, a report will be made to the Commanding General, I Corps, APO 301, Attention: Military Government Section. This report will be written in English and will list each item, by name, type, and quantity produced by the above identified factory. This report will be delivered to Corps Headquarters not later than fifteen (15) days after the conclusion of the period to which the report pertains.

TO : WGO Sixth Army (thru channels)

1. Survey of the above application was made this date. Complete inspection of the plant as to equipment was also made.

2. The president Mr. Shuzo Goto was interviewed. Under paragraph 4 there was no relation to the Japanese Government.

3. A loan was made of Yen 100,000.- Senji Kinyu Kinko which they claimed as now paid out. On July 4th 1941 the above company bought Nozato Machine Shop and is now being operated as part of the parent company. Under paragraph 7 (c) it will be noticed that there is listed a 700 ton friction press. They claim that machine was purchased as a 100 ton press but after delivery it was discovered that it is not more than a 500 ton press. Made a personal survey but there were no named plate or equipment identifications in order to verify statement.

4. The future plan of production are drop forgings for parts of railway cars and agriculture equipment as listed under paragraph 11 (b). Under paragraph 11 (d) the stock of bar material listed under (Military) represents stocks supplied by the military to the company for military production. Said stock was paid for by the above company and, therefore, belongs to the company.

5. This office recommends that the application be approved or the manufacture of such civil and domestic articles for agriculture purposes as listed in the application.
