**Albania** (Albanian: *Shqipëria*) is a country in the Balkans with nearly 3 million inhabitants. The country has been part of Ancient Greece, the Roman Empire and the Ottoman Empire until its first declaration of independence in 1912, and is one of few traditionally Muslim nations in Europe.

### Regions [ edit | edit source ]

- Coastal Albania**  
the long narrow strip between about 10 and 30 km wide along the whole Albanian coast, bordering both the Adriatic Sea and Ionian Sea
- Northeastern Albania**  
the inland region to the north of the Shkumbin River, bordering Montenegro, Kosovo and Macedonia.
- Southeastern Albania**  
the inland region to the south of the Shkumbin River bordering Macedonia and Greece, and including the great border lakes, Lake Ohrid and Lake Prespa.

### Cities [ edit | edit source ]

- Tirana** (Tiranë) — the capital. Trees and mountains surround the city. Mt. Dajt is a popular tourist site for a great view of the city.
- Elbasan** - A large, poor, intriguing industrial city that is full of life. The market is fascinating, and the breakfast "Bugace"
