SUBJECT: Authorization of T/O&E Strength for 74th Engr Hvy Equip Co

1. CG 8th Army requests authority to reorganize the 74th Engr Hvy Equip Co to full T/O&E strength. C/N 1 from Engr to G-3 thru G-4, subject as above, dated 24 Oct 50, concurs in CG 8th Army request and adds further justification for the action.
2. The justification contained in C/N 1 is deemed adequate.
3. Recommend G-4 indicate concurrence by initialing C/N 1.
4. If this request is approved it will effect an increase in Engr strength on hand and requisitioned on DA from 33,310 to 33,375 as compared to Engr slice of 33,484.
5. Within established policy.
6. Completes action on G-4 Journal No. 15696.

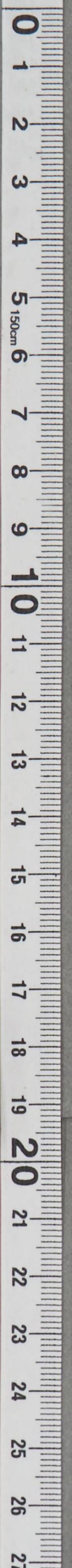

 2. Request action be initiated immediately to increase the 74th Engineer Heavy Equipment Company to full TO&E strength for reasons indicated below.
 3. The Company is currently authorized a strength of 5 officers, 1 warrant officer, and 150 enlisted men under Col-4, TO&E 5-328, dated 11 May 1950. Full TO&E for this organization authorizes 6 officers, 1 warrant officer, 214 enlisted men. The full allowance also includes some additional items of equipment not presently permitted.
 4. The 74th Engineer Heavy Equipment Company is the only organization of its type presently assigned to Eighth Army. Requests initiated to DA per reference 1b and c above included 4 Engineer Heavy Equipment Companies. A reduction of one such company was later recommended by reference 1d above. DA has not to date designated any Engineer Heavy Equipment Companies in addition to the 74th.
 5. There are two Engineer Construction Groups presently in Korea and one additional has been designated for shipment per reference e above. Since the normal basis for assignment of an Engineer Heavy Equipment Company is one per construction group, it is readily apparent that the 74th Engineer Heavy Equipment Company is faced with a difficult task in providing the needed support at its presently reduced strength.
 6. It is believed that the personnel and equipment required for this requested increase can be provided through normal channels.

MEMO FOR RECORD:

- CG X Corps msg X 11750, 30 Oct, stated that a requirement exists to bring the Trans Sec of Hq X Corps to strength authorized by T/O&E 100-1, 1 Jul 50 (sic). Msg stated that primary initial need is for a qualified and experienced Col or senior Lt Col as X Corps Trans Officer, MOS 0692.
- Actually, authority has not yet been received from the Dept of Army to reorganize Hq X Corps under T/O&E 100-1, 26 Jul 50. The volume and complexity of transportation activity in the X Corps area, however, necessitate the immediate assignment of a qualified Col for duty as the Trans Officer, X Corps.
- The time element precludes asking the Dept of Army to fill this reqmt. Col Ayers (currently assigned as Deputy Cmdr, 2 Trans Major Port - Yokohama) is considered qualified and experienced for this assignment by the Trans Off, GHQ, FEC.

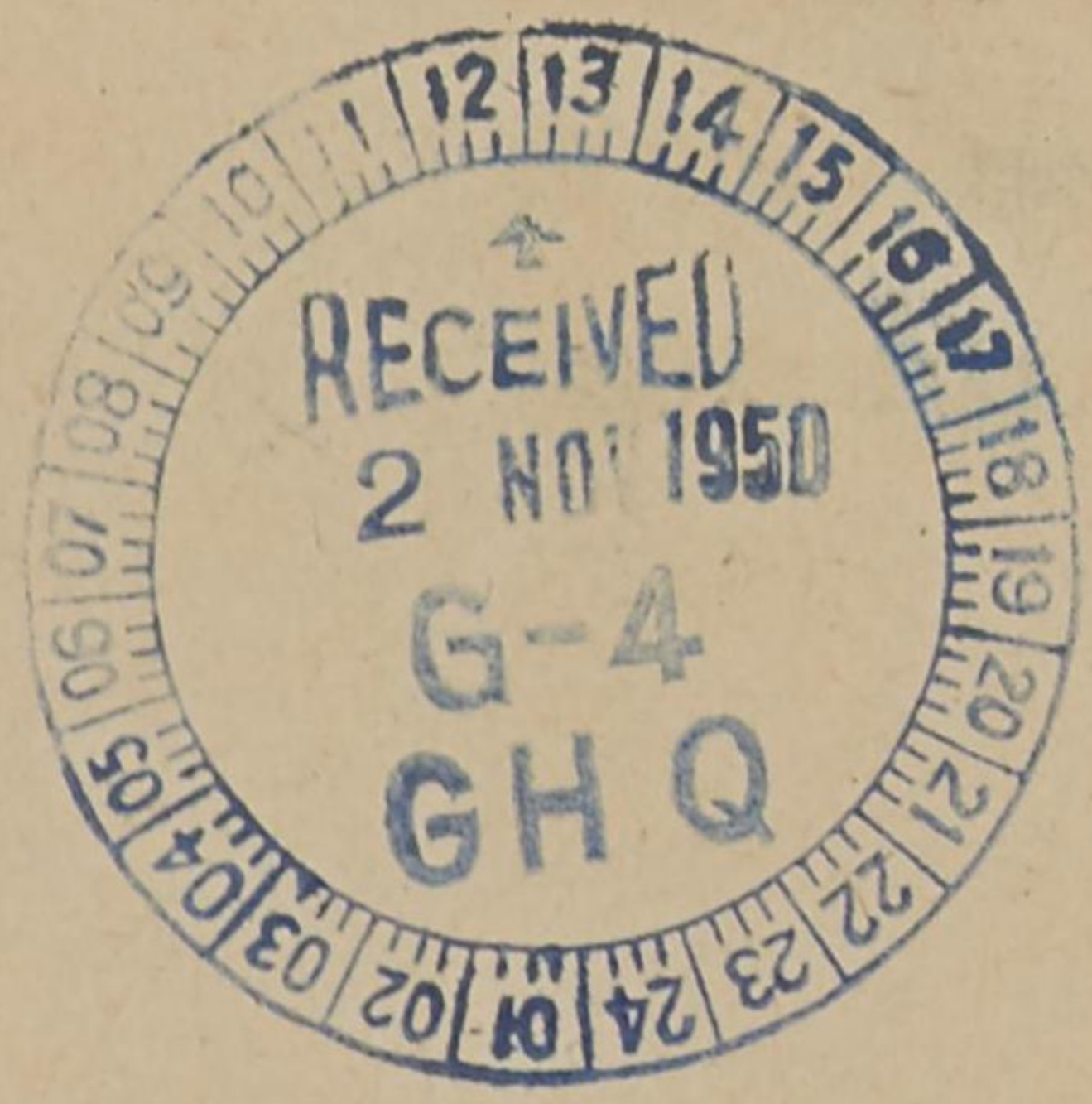

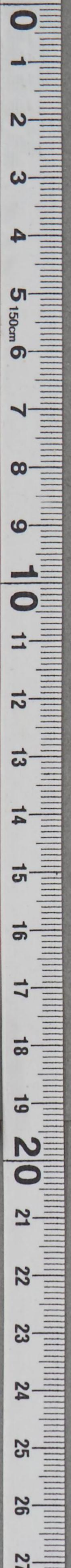

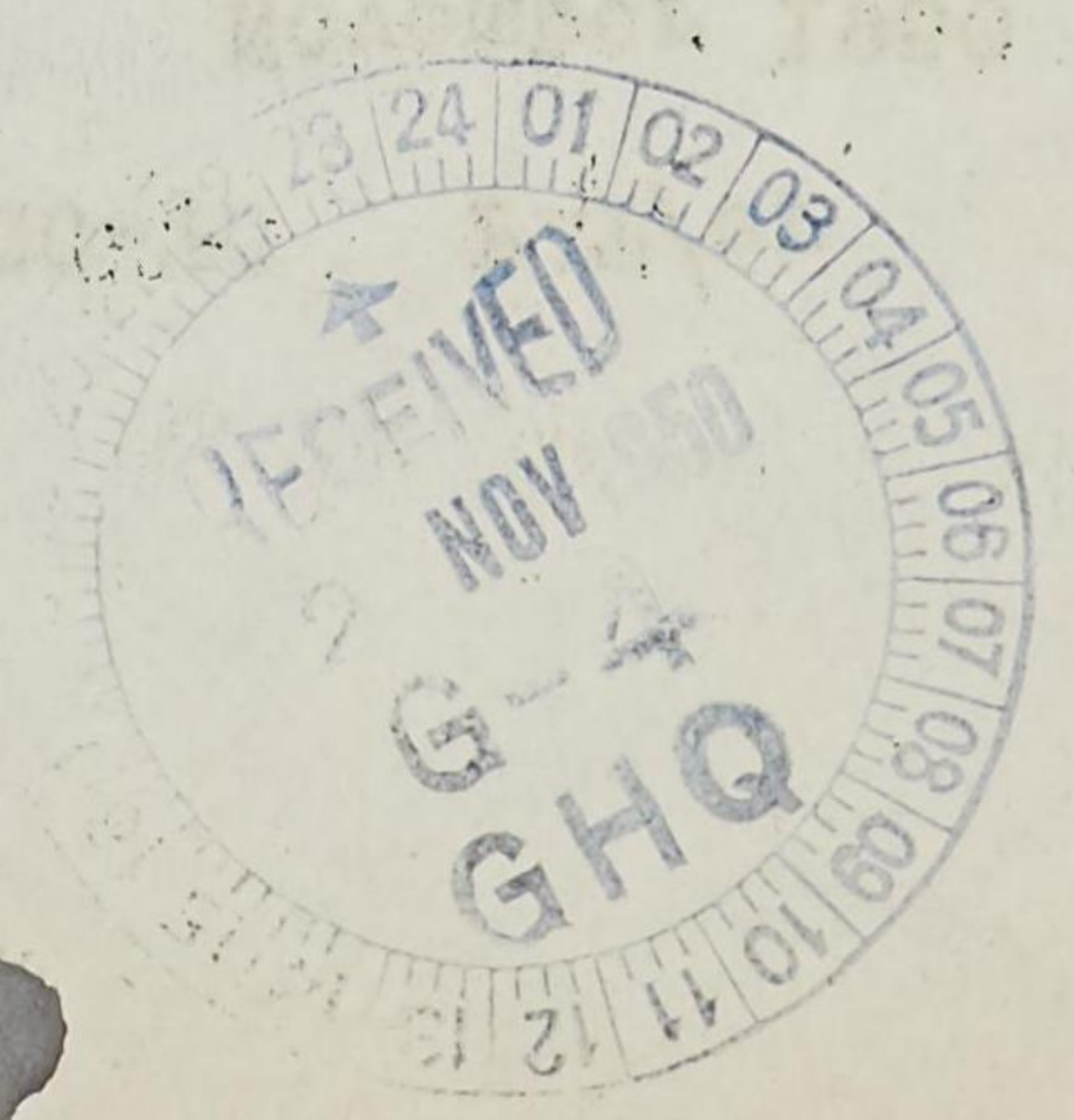

1. G-4 agrees with the Signal officer in his statement that the Korean situation has changed to such an extent as to make any further discussion of Signal strengths required to support the operation academic.
 2. The point still unresolved is the number of Signal troops on hand and on requisition from the DA. As of 31 Oct 50 Signal has on hand and requisitioned from DA a strength of 14,808. It is recommended that the Signal officer submit a list of units to be deleted from requisition on DA to bring Signal strength within the Signal slice of 12,082, originally set up to support the Korean operation.
 3. Further, it is G-4's considered opinion that as rapidly as the Korean situation permits, the Signal officer and for that matter all Technical Services should take appropriate action to reduce their strength, to within their post hostilities deployment slice.

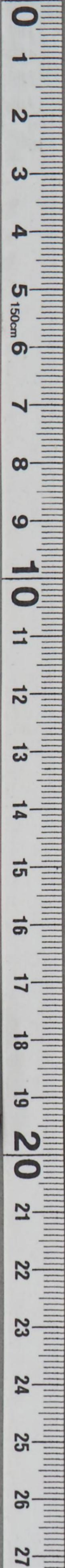
