On 9 January 1946 the records of the Personnel Section, Cabinet Secretariat were examined at the Diet Building, Tokyo.

Complete personnel records of the subject were micro-filmed. Photostatic copies, together with translation, are on file as Exhibit No. 126.

Following is a transcript of the translation:

AICHIRO TOKUTOMI

BORN: January 1863

RESIDENCE: Kumamoto Prefecture

STATUS : Samurai

Received home education from his father, Ikkei TOKUTOMI

1871 - 1880 Studied Chinese classics and English

1882 - 1886 Founded the Oe School, offering lessons equivalent to those of the middle-school course;

Engaged thereafter in the publication of Koku-min-no-Tomo

(Nation's companion) and the Kokumin-Shimbun newspaper

Went to Hiroshima in company with the Imperial Headquarters; In the following year, made an observation trip to Liaotung Peninsula in company with the Government-General of War

> against China; Returned homeon May 13

1896 May 20 Started on a tour of Europe and America
