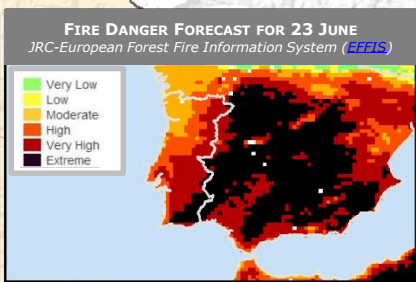
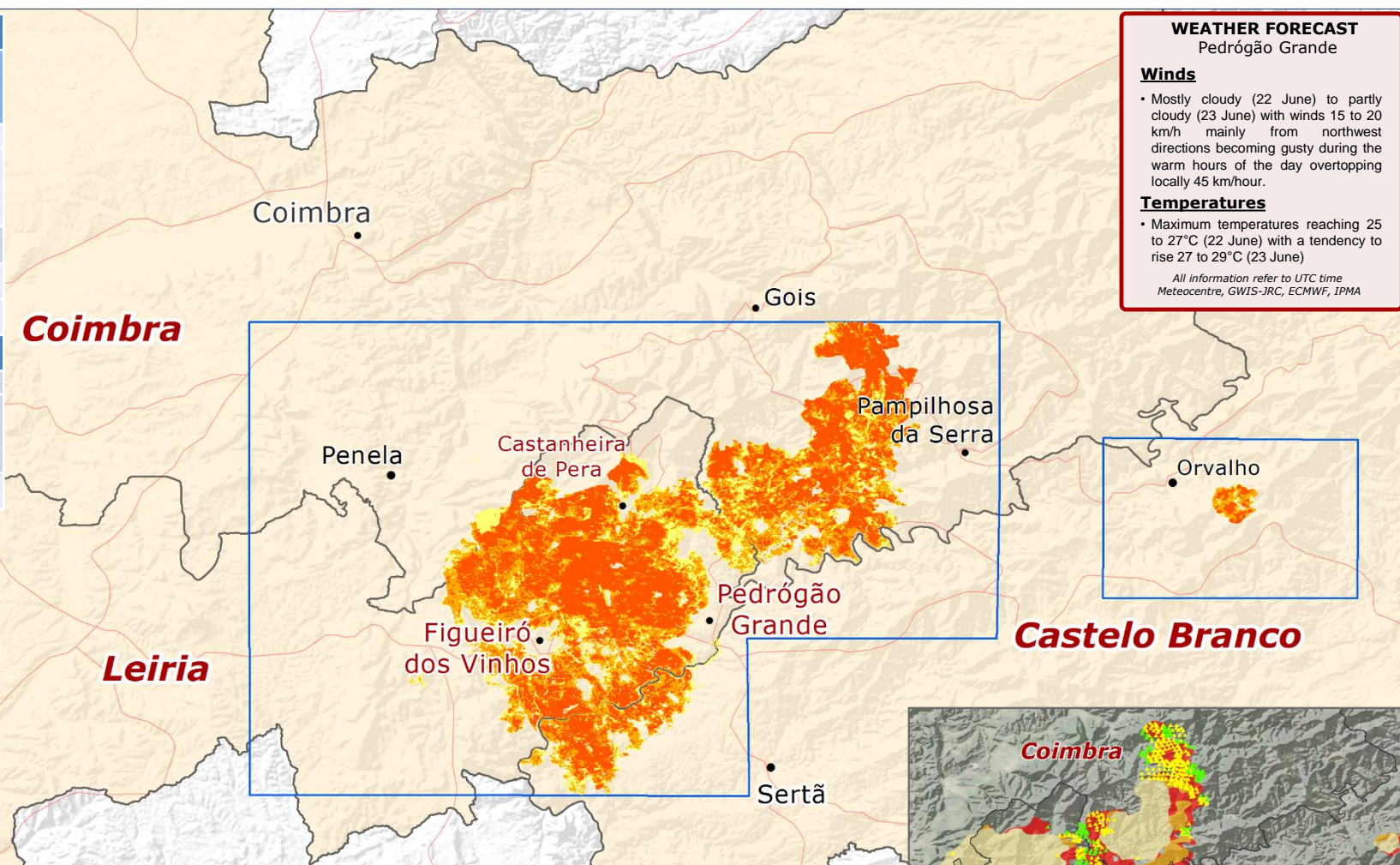
Winds
