



Itayi T. Mushohwe

Itayi Trevor Mushohwe is a Zimbabwean author. Born on 30 September 1982 in Harare, Itayi T. Mushohwe did his schooling at St. Francis Xavier's College Kutama and attended university at South Africa's Rhodes University and in China. He speaks Russian and Chinese languages.

His first novel, *Aridity* (2017) chronicles life in a Chinese prison and was inspired by his years spent in China, where he lived for almost 10 years. The book was begun in

early 2015, & was published online on Amazon in 2018.

His second book, a Youth Adult fiction set in Zimbabwe is titled *Aviridity* (2020). It is loosely related to his first book to make it a second in a collection. It chronicles the return of the main character in *Aridity*, back to Zimbabwe and his adventures therefor, leading to his unwittingly saving the country with grandiose results.

His third book, and the third in the Constellation series collection is *A Silver Lining* (2021). It continues off where *Aridity* concluded. It's 3 years later and our hero is again enthralled in a series of fantastic adventures that again save the country from certain destruction.

The writers love for history supports the book greatly and sets it apart from contemporary Zimbabwean writer styles. As a genre science fiction is not very common in Zimbabwe, so for Itayi T. Mushohwe this presented a couple of challenges and so again the books were published on Amazon, for a wider audience.
