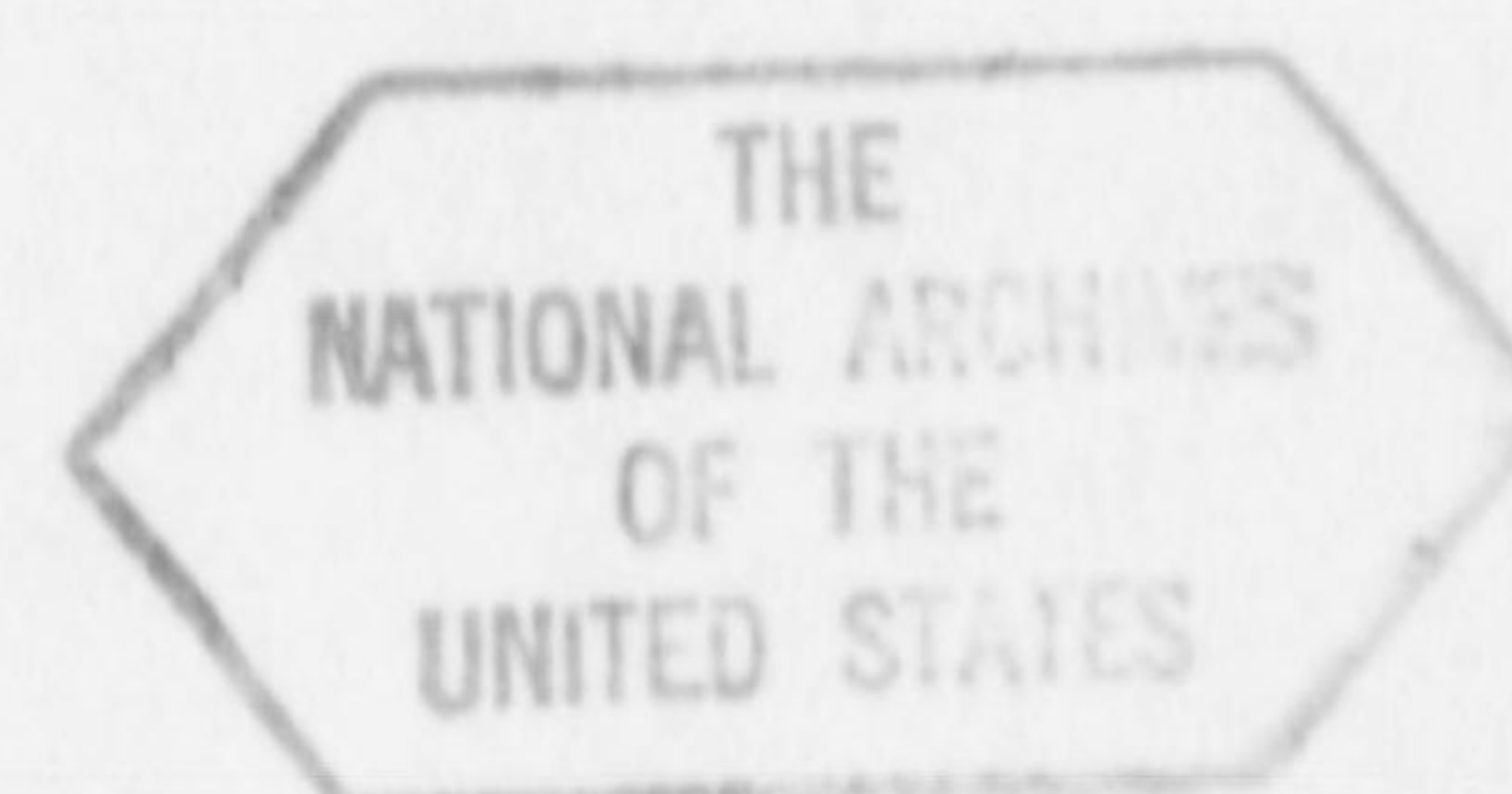

1. Payroll records indicate that tax code during 1950 for Mr. Walter B. Pedersen was I-2 and has never been shown as I-4. Therefore, the current change from I-2 to I-3 necessarily results in an increase in net pay because an additional tax exemption is being claimed.

2. Payroll records indicate that the tax code during 1950 for Mr. Lucius Smith was I-3. Therefore, the current change from I-3 to I-2 necessarily results in a decrease in net pay because one less exemption is being claimed.

3. Signed W-4 forms for Mr. Pedersen and Mr. Smith are currently on file for the years 1950 and 1951.

1. On payroll change slip, Standard Form No. 1126, Mr. Walter B. Pedersen had an decrease of \$4.60 under tax for pay period ending 30 December 1950. In the remarks it is stated that his exemption is changed to I-3 which is correct since his exemption has been changed to I-3 from I-4 which he had in 1950. Mr. Pedersen believes his pay should be decreased instead of increased because of his one less exemption and he desires an explanation of his increase in pay.

2. The payroll change slip of Mr. Lucius Smith has an increase of \$4.60 under tax for pay period ending 30 December 1950. Mr. Smith has his exemption changed to I-2 which should make an increase in his pay but instead his pay is decreased for this pay period.
