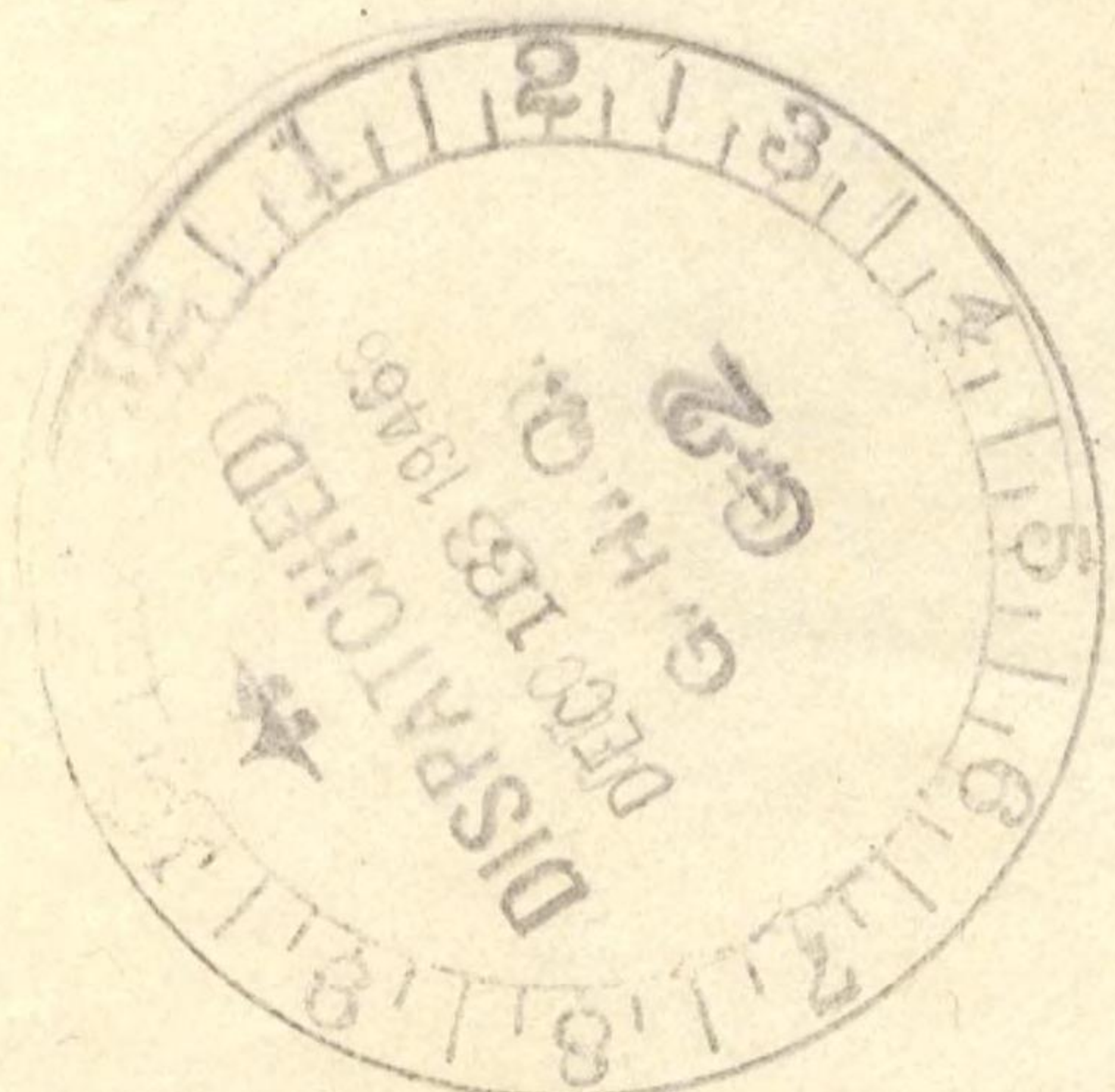

Conditions in Northern Korea

1) The Communist Party:

The Communist Party in Northern Korea has become very active particularly since the proclamation of its policies by the Northern Korea People's Committee.

2) Japanese in Northern Korea:

The Japanese residents in Northern Korea are under the leadership and direction of the Japanese People's Committee organized under the supervision of the Soviet Military Government, and are showing attitudes, at least on the surface, of supporting the policies of the Communist Party.

3) Establishment of the "Corhose" system:

The above named system, similar to the one followed in Russia, has already been established, and Japanese agricultural technicians are solicited to remain in Korea.

4) Soviets issuing passports to enter Japan:

According to reports of refugees from Northern Korea, the Soviet authorities are issuing "passports" to Japanese, and are sending them back to Japan.

Note: While it is difficult to understand just what is meant by the word "passports" in this case, but it is an opinion that the recipients of these "passports" are Soviet agents, and the "passports" guarantee there free exit from and entry into the Soviet controlled area.
